Ex-Kerala minister Jaleel moves SC against HC verdict

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: KT Jaleel, the Higher Education Minister in the first Pinarayi Vijayan government (2016-21) who had to quit on April 13 after the Lok Ayukta decision asking him to do so after it ruled that he has no moral right to continue in office as he has misused his powers and indulged in nepotism, has approached the apex court against both the Lok Ayukta and the subsequent Kerala High Court verdict. The only reprieve Jaleel got was that the Lok Ayukta verdict came after the assembly elections were over on April 6 in Kerala.

Killing of 300 stray dogs is gruesome: Animal activists

HYDERABAD: Animal activists of Andhra Pradesh while expressing anger over the alleged killing of 300 dogs with poisonous injections, by panchayat officials in West Godavari district here, demanded justice for the voiceless on Tuesday. The activists said that the laws be made stringent and be implemented strictly. They opined that most of the village panchayat officials are not aware that it is crime to kill stray dogs. Prasad, a senior animal activist who has been serving animals for the last 10 years reacted to the incident by calling it a gruesome act.

Haasan: MNM may consider joining anti-BJP front if invited

COIMBATORE: Makkal Needhi Maiam (MNM) could join the opposition bloc against the ruling BJP at the Centre, if invited, Kamal Haasan said on Tuesday. "Going by the situation and invitation, the party may consider joining it," Haasan told reporters here. He was responding to a question on joining the proposed alliance against the BJP at the Centre. On Mekedatu dam issue, the actor-politician quipped "I have played double roles in films. I can identify those who are playing dual roles in politics."

7 held for killing 38 monkeys in Karnataka's Hassan

HASSAN: The forest department and police have arrested seven persons, including a woman in connection with the killing of 38 monkeys in the Hassan district. The police said on Tuesday that all the arrested persons were monkey catchers and villagers had funded them to catch monkeys. The accused have been identified as Ramu, Yashoda, Manja, Manje Gowda, Iyangari, Srikanth and Ramanuja Iyengar. All of them have been sent to judicial custody. The incident had taken place in the Chowdanahalli village on July 29. Miscreants had stuffed the monkeys in gunny bags and thrown them by the roadside.

Kerala HC stays announcement of KEAM entrance results

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: The Kerala High Court on Tuesday stayed the publication of the results of the Kerala Engineering Architecture Medical (KEAM) entrance examination results till further notice. KEAM is the entrance examination for admission to professional courses in the state. The court's order came as it heard a bunch of petitions filed by the CBSE school managements and students who demanded the final rank list for the KEAM should be based only on the performance in the KEAM examination.

Court summons to top AIADMK leaders over defamation complaint

CHENNAI: Taking on file a defamation complaint from expelled AIADMK spokesperson V Pugalendi, a Special court for hearing cases against MPs and MLAs on Tuesday issued summons to party's top leaders O Panneerselvam and K Palaniswami requiring them to appear before it on August 24. Additional Special Court judge Alizia issued the summons. In his complaint, Pugalendi sought the court to punish the duo for offences under Sections 499 and 500 of the IPC for expelling him from AIADMK's primary membership and accusing him of having indulged in anti-party activities and violated its rules.

Mere harassment won't amount to abetment of suicide, says SC

OUR BUREAU / New Delhi

The Supreme Court has re-defined the abetment of suicide under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), holding that it is not committed by mere harassment without any positive action.

A Bench comprising Justices L Nageswara Rao and Aniruddha Bose dismissed an appeal of the deceased's brother, holding that "mere harassment without any positive action on the part of the accused proximate to the time of occurrence which led to the suicide would not amount to an offence under Section 306 IPC. Abetment by a person is when a person insti-

gating suicide by consuming poison and leaving four suicide notes, noting that his death was the result of a matrimonial dispute in which his wife had gone back to her paternal home. He had blamed his wife and others for pushing him to commit suicide.

In an appeal, brother of the deceased asserted that he was harassed by his wife, due to which he took his own life. Dismissing the petition, the top court said: "In the commission of the said offence, the person who is said to have abetted the suicide must have played an active role by an act of instigating or by doing a certain act to facilitate the suicide."

Housing project corruption case

HC notice to Yedi, son, relatives & former minister

BENGALURU

The Karnataka High Court on Tuesday issued notice to former Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa, his son and BJP state vice president B Y Vijayendra, their family members, former minister ST Somashekar and an IAS officer in a case alleging corruption in a housing project. The single bench of Justice S Sunil Dutt Yadav directed issuing notices to them on a petition filed by an activist T J Abraham, who challenged the special courts order on July 8 this year. The special court had dismissed the case for want of sanction to prosecute Yediyurappa and Somashekar, who were Chief Minister and Minister respectively at the time. The case pertains to allegedly receiving kickbacks from a contractor for a housing project of the Bangalore Development Authority.

LS passes Essential Defence Services Bill amid Oppn protests

NEW DELHI

Lok Sabha on Tuesday passed a bill that seeks to prohibit any agitation and strike by anyone engaged in essential defence services.

Amid protests by some opposition members on the intent of the bill, Minister of State for Defence Ajay Bhatt, who piloted the measure, informed the House that the "biggest thing" is that "we have taken a decision to add a sunset clause in this (bill)". A sunset clause gives an expiry date to a law. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh said he wants to assure the House that after

the parliamentary nod and presidential assent, the Act will become effective only when it is invoked. It may so happen that there is no need to invoke this Act, he said, adding that the law "will be effective for only a year". The Essential Defence Services Bill, 2021 seeks to replace an ordinance issued in June. As the minister was speaking, opposition members continued their protests over Pegasus snooping row and farmers' issues. N K Premachandran (RSP) was of the view that such an important Bill should not be passed amid the din.

OFFICIAL WORK: Pawar says amid speculation over meeting with Shah

NCP supremo Sharad Pawar on Tuesday met Union Home and Cooperation Minister Amit Shah in New Delhi, sparking off speculations. Pawar himself sought to clear the air, terming it an official meet. "Had a brief meeting with Union Co-operation Minister Shri Amit Shah in New Delhi today along with Shri Jaiprakash Dandekar, President of NCFCSF (National Federation of Cooperative Sugar Factories Ltd) & Prakash Naiknavre to discuss issues faced by the sugar co-operative sector," he said. The meeting gained sig-



nificance as it came on the same day as Pawar's daughter Supriya Sule attended the breakfast meeting of opposition leaders hosted by Congress leader Rahul Gandhi. The Congress and the Shiv Sena, who are the Nationalist Congress Party's allies in the Maharashtra, however, dismissed any political significance of the meeting.

Shivkumar meets Gehlot, raises speculation over Cabine rejig

Amid proposed Cabinet rejig in Rajasthan and the recent political change in Karnataka DK Shivkumar, the PCC president of Karnataka was in Jaipur on Tuesday to meet Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot. His visit has given rise to many speculations although he said that his visit has no political connection. DK Shivkumar reached Jaipur on Tuesday afternoon and left for CM house from the airport. He said

that he has not come as a messenger of anyone and this visit has no political connection to the politics of Karnataka or Rajasthan or anywhere else. He is on a personal visit to meet Gehlot. Shivkumar stayed at CM house in Jaipur for around two hours and left for Delhi in the evening. Although he denied, sources say that his visit was in connection to the politics of Karnataka where BJP has just replaced its CM and he had discussed the situation with Gehlot who is now one of the most senior leaders of the party. It is to note that Kumari Sailja, the PCC president of Haryana had also on a sudden and unannounced visit to Jaipur on Sunday night. She had a brief meeting with Gehlot and left for Delhi early morning on Monday. The visits of PCC presidents of two different states in just two days have become a matter of discussion in the political circles in Rajasthan.

Govt raises TMC MP's 'papri chat' remark in RS

Ex-Kerala minister Jaleel moves SC against HC verdict

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: KT Jaleel, the Higher Education Minister in the first Pinarayi Vijayan government (2016-21) who had to quit on April 13 after the Lok Ayukta decision asking him to do so after it ruled that he has no moral right to continue in office as he has misused his powers and indulged in nepotism, has approached the apex court against both the Lok Ayukta and the subsequent Kerala High Court verdict. The only reprieve Jaleel got was that the Lok Ayukta verdict came after the assembly elections were over on April 6 in Kerala.

Killing of 300 stray dogs is gruesome: Animal activists

HYDERABAD: Animal activists of Andhra Pradesh while expressing anger over the alleged killing of 300 dogs with poisonous injections, by panchayat officials in West Godavari district here, demanded justice for the voiceless on Tuesday. The activists said that the laws be made stringent and be implemented strictly. They opined that most of the village panchayat officials are not aware that it is crime to kill stray dogs. Prasad, a senior animal activist who has been serving animals for the last 10 years reacted to the incident by calling it a gruesome act.

Haasan: MNM may consider joining anti-BJP front if invited

COIMBATORE: Makkal Needhi Maiam (MNM) could join the opposition bloc against the ruling BJP at the Centre, if invited, Kamal Haasan said on Tuesday. "Going by the situation and invitation, the party may consider joining it," Haasan told reporters here. He was responding to a question on joining the proposed alliance against the BJP at the Centre. On Mekedatu dam issue, the actor-politician quipped "I have played double roles in films. I can identify those who are playing dual roles in politics."

7 held for killing 38 monkeys in Karnataka's Hassan

HASSAN: The forest department and police have arrested seven persons, including a woman in connection with the killing of 38 monkeys in the Hassan district. The police said on Tuesday that all the arrested persons were monkey catchers and villagers had funded them to catch monkeys. The accused have been identified as Ramu, Yashoda, Manja, Manje Gowda, Iyangari, Srikanth and Ramunaja Iyengar. All of them have been sent to judicial custody. The incident had taken place in the Chowdanahalli village on July 29. Miscreants had stuffed the monkeys in gunny bags and thrown them by the roadside.

Kerala HC stays announcement of KEAM entrance results

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: The Kerala High Court on Tuesday stayed the publication of the results of the Kerala Engineering Architecture Medical (KEAM) entrance examination results till further notice. KEAM is the entrance examination for admission to professional courses in the state. The court's order came as it heard a bunch of petitions filed by the CBSE school managements and students who demanded the final rank list for the KEAM should be based only on the performance in the KEAM examination.

Court summons to top AIADMK leaders over defamation complaint

CHENNAI: Taking on file a defamation complaint from expelled AIADMK spokesperson V Pugalendi, a Special court for hearing cases against MPs and MLAs on Tuesday issued summons to party's top leaders O Panneerselvam and K Palaniswami requiring them to appear before it on August 24. Additional Special Court judge Alizia issued the summons. In his complaint, Pugalendi sought the court to punish the duo for offences under Sections 499 and 500 of the IPC for expelling him from AIADMK's primary membership and accusing him of having indulged in anti-party activities and violated its rules.

Mere harassment won't amount to abetment of suicide, says SC

OUR BUREAU / New Delhi

The Supreme Court has re-defined the abetment of suicide under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), holding that it is not committed by mere harassment without any positive action.

A Bench comprising Justices L Nageswara Rao and Aniruddha Bose dismissed an appeal of the deceased's brother, holding that "mere harassment without any positive action on the part of the accused proximate to the time of occurrence which led to the suicide would not amount to an offence under Section 306 IPC. Abetment by a person is when a person insti-

gates another to do something."

In an appeal, brother of the deceased asserted that he was harassed by his wife, due to which he took his own life. Dismissing the petition, the top court said: "In the commission of the said offence, the person who is said to have abetted the suicide must have played an active role by an act of instigating or by doing a certain act to facilitate the suicide."

Housing project corruption case: HC notice to Yedi, son, relatives & former minister

The Karnataka High Court on Tuesday issued notice to former Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa, his son and BJP state vice president B Y Vijayendra, their family members, former minister ST Somashekar and an IAS officer in a case alleging corruption in a housing project.

The single bench of Justice S Sunil Dutt Yadav directed issuing notices to them on a petition filed by an activist T J Abraham, who challenged the special courts order on July 8 this year.

The special court had dismissed the case for want of sanction to prosecute Yediyurappa and Somashekar, who were Chief Minister and Minister respectively at the time.

The case pertains to allegedly receiving kickbacks from a contractor for a housing project of the Bangalore Development Authority.

LS passes Essential Defence Services Bill amid Oppn protests

NEW DELHI

Lok Sabha on Tuesday passed a bill that seeks to prohibit any agitation and strike by anyone engaged in essential defence services.

Amid protests by some opposition members on the intent of the bill, Minister of State for Defence Ajay Bhatt, who piloted the measure, informed the House that the "biggest thing" is that "we have taken a decision to add a sunset clause in this (bill)".

A sunset clause gives an expiry date to a law.

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh said he wants to assure the House that after

the parliamentary nod and presidential assent, the Act will become effective only when it is invoked.

It may so happen that there is no need to invoke this Act, he said, adding that the law "will be effective for only a year".

The Essential Defence Services Bill, 2021 seeks to replace an ordinance issued in June.

As the minister was speaking, opposition members continued their protests over Pegasus snooping row and farmers' issues. N K Premachandran (RSP) was of the view that such an important Bill should not be passed amid the din.

OFFICIAL WORK: Pawar says amid speculation over meeting with Shah
