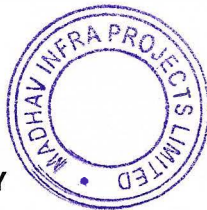

Unity in diversity: Gujarat village's street signs echo country's pluralism

AHMEDABAD: In the quaint village of Virpur, about 90km from the Gandhinagar, a unique and harmonious spirit prevails. As you enter the village, a sign proudly declares: 'Virpur village, a symbol of national integrity'. While many Indian villages and towns have lanes and neighbourhoods named after castes, Virpur stands out as a beacon of unity, with signage that points you towards Haryana Park, Punjab Park, or Arunachal Park. This unconventional naming tradition not only

pays homage to the diverse tapestry of Indian states but also serves as a testament to the values enshrined in the Indian Constitution. Enforced on January 26, 1950, the Constitution guarantees fundamental rights to all citizens, irrespective of their religion, race, caste, sex, or place of birth. This departure from the norm began in 2008 when Faruq Khanusiya was the sarpanch of Virpur. "I saw workers of a regional party of Maharashtra attacking people from Uttar

Pradesh and Bihar allegedly, claiming they were taking away jobs from the locals. It was a heart-rending sight, and I decided to bring about change, starting with my village," says Khanusiya, a BSc graduate who farms for a living. The village, which falls in Himmatnagar taluka, reflects the rich diversity of India, with a population of around 4,000 people from Momin, Dalit, Devipujak, Sarania, Kshatriya, and Brahmin communities.

Kids block road to protest against pollution by cement unit



Ahmedabad: The students of a primary school registered a protest by blocking the road in Mul Dwarka Math village of Kodinar taluka in Gir Somnath district against alleged pollution by a cement company. According to the locals, gypsum and coal is being transported for a cement plant from a jetty of this village as a result, the village is suffering from dust pollution. Talking to media, Kishor Sikotariya, sarpanch of the village said, "We are tired of the continuous dust in the village. There is no place in the village where even the children can study in pollution-free environment. We have represented this issue many a time with the company but they are yet to take any action to curb the pollution. We have also sent our videos to the mamlatdar and Gujarat Pollution Control Board, but with them also dragging their feet, we are forced to organize this protest." A

woman said, "The children remain sick throughout the year because of this dust. They suffer cough and cold and the dusting has become a serious health hazard." The children and villagers had jointly blocked the roads of the cement company to register their protest. However, after intervention of the police the road was cleared after the protest of an hour. "We had sent talati to spot visit and have sent that report to GPCB. Along with that, the representation of school authority and parents have also made it effective," said N G Radadiya, mamlatdar, Kodinar. According to the locals, gypsum and coal is being transported for a cement plant from a jetty of this village as a result, the village is suffering from dust pollution. Security guard, brother arrested for 36L theft from ATM in Gadhada



Ahmedabad: The theft of Rs 36.66 lakh cash from an ATM of a nationalized bank in Gadhada town of Botad district on Jan 20 has turned out to be the handiwork of the security guard who plotted the crime with three others due to acute financial crisis and debt. On Thursday, police arrested the guard Niraj alias Bhano Chavda (34), his brother Sanjay (36), and two aides - Bhavesh Varvadiya (29) and Ravi Parmar (26). In fact, Chavda was the first to inform the bank manager of the theft and later even cooperated with the police during the investigation. However, police strongly suspected it to be an insider's pre-planned job as the machine was broken hours after being loaded with cash. Entire cash was recovered from the farm where Chavda's brother works as a labourer. Police also recovered the digital video recorders (DVRs) of the CCTV which they had stolen. Chavda has been working as the guard of the ATM for eight years and he knows how to start and stop CCTVs. Investigators got more suspicious when the state-run discom Paschim Gujarat Vij Company Ltd (PGVCL)

also got to know that Chavda also worked as an electrician. "In some footage of CCTV installed outside the ATM, the behaviour of Chavda and other accused standing outside looked suspicious. The situation at the time of burglary outside the ATM was different than narrated by Chavda," said Mayurdhwajsinh Jadeja, police inspector of Gadhada. Chavda even searched YouTube to find out ways to break an ATM and he learned some techniques from some videos. He brought a gas cutter and a cylinder from Botad with his friend Bhavesh. that there was no power failure as informed by the bank when asked for CCTV footage of the booth. They

Vadodara: Panipuri vendor mashes potatoes with feet

VADODARA: Food safety officials of the Vadodara Municipal Corporation (VMC) swung into action after a video of a panipuri vendor mashing potatoes using his feet went viral. The video was ascertained to be from the Dandia Bazaar area and action was taken against the vendor on Thursday. The video showed a man who had kept potatoes in a large vessel and was mashing them with his feet. It also showed the man picking

up a potato that fell out on the pavement and adding it to the vessel after washing it with water. While it is not known when the video was recorded, it clearly showed that the Devnarayan Panipuri cart was kept in front of the Bharunath Ice Cream shop in Dandia Bazaar. Officials rushed to the place after receiving the video and ascertained the location and suspended the food business operator registration of the vendor for six months.

Brothers cheat 12 with gold designs

Rajkot: Two jeweller brothers have been booked for cheating 12 people in Bhesan taluka. They were accused of stealing 543 gram of gold ornaments worth Rs 62 lakh and fleeing after locking up their shop by Jan 15. A complaint about the cheating has been registered with Bhesan police station by Kaushik Patel against Shailesh Samta and Nilesh Samta, who runs a jewellery shop in Junagadh district. The complaint alleged that Samta brothers had lured people to give in for new design jewellery in exchange of old design jewellery after four to five months' use. Unidentified people burglarized a house in Coimbatore district, stealing 22 sovereigns of gold ornaments including a haram, earrings, chains, a necklace, and rings. The owner, M Suresh Kumar, had locked the house and went to his relatives' house with his family members. Police registered a case and are investigating the incident. A gang from a different state had robbed a jewellery shop in Jaipur in 2013, holding the staff captive.

SMC to make 2 roads iconic through PPP

Surat: City civic body to redevelop two major roads as iconic roads in public private partnership model. The road from Airport towards Dumas will be developed at the cost of Rs 53.24 crore, while Udhna-Magdalla road will be redeveloped at the cost of Rs 58.17 crore. In the project, the 2.1km road from Airport entry gate to Kuwada junction will be redeveloped by Surat Municipal Corporation. The road is 60-metre-wide and around 40,000 sq mt area on the road side will be developed. As part of the project, the SMC will develop the basic infrastructure at the cost of Rs 12.37 crore while Rs 40.87 crore will be spent by a private party. Currently, the road from Magdalla crossroad to Airport entry gate has already been redeveloped as an iconic road with recreational spaces on both sides of the road, walkways and service road. The project was carried out in PPP mode. The other road, a 7.7km stretch from Sosyo Circle to Y Junction, will be redeveloped. On the 60-metre-wide road, around 1.12 lakh sq mt space will be developed. SMC will develop basic infrastructure at the cost of Rs 17.3 crore while private parties will spend Rs 40.87 crore. As part of the redevelopment work, apart from road construction and widening, the SMC will lay paver blocks on pathways, construct railing, install innovative benches, light poles and develop toilet blocks. Maintenance and shifting of amenities will also be carried out by the SMC. Trichy city is preparing to host a part of the Khelo India Youth Games (KIYG) 2024. The state highways department has redeveloped five major roads around Anna sports stadium in Khajamalaj for the event. The rehabilitation drive included patchwork, repainting of pedestrian pavements, and removal of silt on the roads.

Surat man tortured in police custody succumbs in Ahmedabad



RAJKOT: A 43-year-old man Harshil Jadav who was allegedly subjected to custodial torture by a police sub-inspector (PSI) of Junagadh B Division police station succumbed to his injuries during a treatment in Ahmedabad Civil Hospital on Wednesday. The Junagadh police on Tuesday booked PSI M K Makwana on charges of attempt to murder after receiving a summary of the medico-legal case (MLC) from Ahmedabad Civil Hospital where Jadav was under treatment. Police said they will include the section on

murder once the paperwork is done. The Junagadh police were informed by Ahmedabad Civil Hospital at 11.45am on Wednesday about the death of Jadav. Talking to TOI, Harshad Mehta superintendent of police, Junagadh district said, "The investigation officer has been sent to Ahmedabad to record the statements and do the inquest. We have also asked for Jadav's medical reports and postmortem reports. After collecting the evidence we will add the section of murder in the complaint against Makwana." PSI Makwana was suspended on Tuesday after the police complaint was filed. He is likely to be arrested soon. The victim Jadav, a resident of Surat, who was arrested in a cheating case, suffered severe injuries al-

legedly due to thrashing in police custody. He was admitted to the ICU of Ahmedabad Civil Hospital on Jan 16. The medical reports stated that Jadav's ligament of the leg and foot was severely damaged. He also suffered a fracture in the leg and blood clotting besides other complications. According to case details, Jadav was accused of cheating a rickshaw driver from Junagadh Hashim Sida of Rs 1.2 lakh. Jadav was arrested by the Junagadh police and produced before the court that remanded him in police custody from Jan 10 to 12. In his complaint lodged on Tuesday, Jadav's brother Brijesh alleged that Makwana demanded Rs 5 lakh for not torturing his brother during the custody period.
