Mumbai: Sun Pharma on Thursday reported a 2% year-on-year (YoY) drop in net profit to ₹2,023 crore in Q1FY24 due to exceptional items worth ₹323 crore. The company reported net profit of ₹2,061 crore during the corresponding quarter of the same period.

Revenue rose 10.7% YoY to ₹11,785 crore in Q1FY24. Excluding exceptional items, net profit for Q1FY24 has grown 13.8% to Rs₹2345 crore. The exceptional items included



New Delhi: Union home minister Amit Shah, during a high-intensity debate that preceded the passage of the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (Amendment) Bill, 2023 in the Lok Sabha on Thursday, said it was necessitated because after the Supreme Court order, the Delhi government had started replacing officers who were crucial to the probe into "corruption charges" against CM Arvind Kejriwal and others and tried to block the functioning of the vigilance department.

"After getting the court order, their concerns should have been about roads and buildings, water supply, sanitation and healthcare. But they were concerned about vigilance. They targeted the vigilance department because there are many sensitive files lying closed. They were the files of the excise scam, the file related to the opinion to be stated in the judiciary, a case in which the Delhi deputy chief minister is in jail, the file related to the chief minister's illegal home building exercise which could land him in trouble," Shah said and cited several cases in which vigilance inquiry against the Kejriwal government were pending.

He asserted that even the SC verdict in question had acknowledged that Parliament was empowered to make laws for the national capital and said there was a consensus in the Constituent Assembly that Delhi should remain a Union Territory. He cited a whole range of stalwarts from the first President Dr Rajendra Prasad and the first Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel and C Rajagopalachari to say that Delhi was always meant to be a Union Territory; although one with special features, rather than a fully fledged state. He also said while Delhi initially used to have an assembly, it was taken away in 1956 and Nehru had justified the decision by citing the "changed circumstances".

The discussion on the bill witnessed fiery speeches from BJP MPs from Delhi who alleged "corruption" and failure in governance against the AAP government. It also saw the suspension of the lone and newly-elected AAP member Sushil Kumar Rinku for the remaining part of the monsoon session after he tore and threw a copy of the bill to-

wards the chair. In the absence of AAP, the cudgels for the party was taken up by its new-found allies who attacked the government for trampling upon the spirit of federalism and encroaching upon the rights of states.

'Parliament has power to enact law, SC's call if it's good or bad'

New Delhi: Jaganmohan Reddy's YSRCP and Naveen Patnaik's BJD on Thursday supported the Delhi services bill in Lok Sabha, as announced by the two outfits earlier, amid protests by the opposition bloc in the House.

The bill seeks creation of the National Capital Civil Services Authority for deciding transfer and posting of civil servants. It will replace the ordinance promulgated by the Centre on May 19. Participating in the debate on the bill, BJD member Pinaki Misra said Parliament had the power to enact a law and let the Supreme Court decide whether it is a good law or bad law.

This law cannot be brought with respect of "full states" such as Odisha, Rajasthan and West Bengal. This can be done only in the case of the National Capital Territory of Delhi which has peculiar and special status,

YSRCP MP P V Midhun Reddy said it is a unique bill and expressed hope that it is not replicated for other states. Delhi government had approached the Supreme Court for staying the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (Amendment) Ordinance, 2023.

However, the Supreme Court last month refused to grant an interim stay on the Centre's ordinance on control over services in Delhi. It referred it to Constitution Bench. The National Capital Civil Services Authority will consist of the Delhi CM, the chief secretary and principal home secretary. The bill empowers the Authority to make recommendations to the Delhi lieutenant governor (LG) regarding transfer and posting of officials and disciplinary matters.

Shah blamed Kerjiwal for the situation of regular conflict between the Centre and the Delhi government, emphasising that while the current scheme of division of powers between the two entities had been in place since 1993, and had worked well despite the fact that control of the Union government and that of NCT of Delhi alternated between BJP and Congress.

"This was because no one had the intention of usurping the other government's power. Neither Congress nor the BJP fought with each other. But in 2015, the situation changed since the party which came to occupy power in Delhi had no intention to serve and was driven by the intent to fight," he said, referring to AAP's dra-

matic ascension to power. home minister dubbed the unity efforts a futile exercise and the hope of holding on to Kejriwal misplaced. "You will not be able to defeat PM Narendra Modi because BJP will again get a majority of its own and Kejriwal will leave you as soon as you have complied with his diktat and voted against the

"People are watching you.

This is not the way you can gain people's trust. I would like to remind you that you all got the people's trust. But the way you governed the nation in 10 years of UPA government, there were Rs 12 lakh crore of scams. You are again clearly supporting the Delhi government's corruption for the sake of the alliance. People are watching your double standards and will take account of it in the election," Shah said, taking a dig at opponents for junking their stand not to let the House conduct business unless the governmentagreed to their condition for a debate on Manipur.

"Where is their concern about Manipur and democracy today? When it came to securing their political interests, they all got united to oppose the bill, forgetting about the issues raised by them earlier. The same people accuse us of not being concerned about Manipur. You all have exposed yourself that you are only worried about your political interests alone," he said.

Shah cited the contradictions between JD(U)-RJD and Congress-CPM-Trinamool to illustrate his point about the unity efforts being an opportunistic exercise.

He maintained the law was in accord with the Constitution which empowered Parliament to enact laws for Union Territories, including the NCT of Delhi. "Article 239AA (3b) of the Constitution clearly states that Parliament has the right to make laws on the Union Territory of Delhi, on any subject of any part of it," he said.

Shah also refuted the argument that the bill was in violation of the SC order of May 11. "Para 86, Para 95 and especially Para 164 of the Supreme Court order they have referred to, clearly state that Parliament, under the provisions laid in Article 239(AA), has complete right to make laws on any subject of the Union

Delhi always meant to be UT, Tiff Over 'Sexual Favours': Man Killed, His Body Dumped In Drain

32-Year-Old Met Suspect At Queer Party, Had Gone Missing 26 Days Ago

New Delhi: The body of a 32year-old man was recovered from a drain in Sector 14B of Dwarka on Wednesday, 26 days after he went missing from south Delhi's Moolchand. Police arrested the alleged murderer and said he had admitted he was annoyed by the constant demand for sexual favours and had shot him dead in a fit of rage.

Chowdhary, Chandan DCP (South), said, "The victim went missing on July 9. On July 14, his father received a ransom call for Rs 20 lakh, which was negotiated to Rs 15 lakh. A case of kidnapping for ransom was registered at Ambedkar Nagar police station.' Chowdhary explained that though a case of kidnapping for ransom was registered, it later became clear that the victim and the accused, Shashank Singh, knew each other.

Singh apparently first ran into the victim at a party around June 20 and the two had met 5-6 times after that. "The victim was looking for a job and Singh was helping him. They decided to meet near Moolchand. On July 9, the two men met there and left for Dwarka in Singh's car," said the DCP. टीचर 12 साल की बच्ची से 22 अपनी स्टूडेंट के साल बड़े आरोपी ने रिश्ते की से छेड़छाड़ करने पवित्रता को भी और उसे धमकाने

के मामले में आरोपी अनदेखा किया है। इस व्यक्ति के खिलाफ आरोपों को हाई कोर्ट ने गंभीर माना। कोर्ट ने कहा कि पीड़ित बच्ची से 22 साल बड़े आरोपी ने 'गुड टच और बैड टच' के बारे में नाबालिंग की अज्ञानता का फायदा उठाते हुए न केवल उसके साथ छेड़छाड़ की, बल्कि उसका टीचर होते हुए अपने रिश्ते की पवित्रता को भी अनदेखा कर दिया।
