# Five from Goa's Salgaocar Family Under ED Lens

Mumbai: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) is probing some members of the Goa-based Salgaocar family for alleged violation of foreign exchange rules, sources aware of the investigations told ET.

Five family members are being investigated under the provisions of Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA) for transactions exceeding ₹2,000 crore, official sources said.

"The probe is at an advanced stage and the statements of a few linked to the case have also been recorded. Those under investiga-

tion have been asked to join the probe," said a person familiar with the agency's findings.

Sources said the probe began

after the International Consortium of Investigative Journalists published the 'Pandora Papers', which revealed alleged overseas beneficiary accounts of several resident Indians in low-tax territories.

Besides the Enforcement Directorate, the income-tax department is also probing the Salgaocar family members under the Black Money

(Undisclosed Foreign Income and Assets) Act.

The income-tax department has sent five notices to members of the family, and each of the five members has been asked to pay ₹490 crore in dues, said another official privy to the developments. Members of the Salgaocar family could not be reached for their comment.

According to the 'Pandora Papers', a now-deceased member of the family had allegedly set up several firms — Crown Bright Trading; General Harvest International; Ling Tao Trading; Nickon Enterprises; Sing Ling Tao Resources; and Horizon Villa Investments — in the tax haven of British Virgin Islands.

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## Eicher Posts Record Profits, Ready to Roll Out First E-bike

New Delhi: Mid-weight motorcycle maker Royal Enfield is looking at introducing its first electric vehicle in the next two years and will install production capacity of 150,000 units to roll out electric two-wheelers, which will be commissioned gradually in a modular fashion.

The company said it has recruited a commercial team to assess market requirements for its first electric motorcycle. Siddhartha Lal, managing director, Eicher Motors, said, "We are testing the prototype and will bring in a disruptive product. We have put together a team to look into the commercial side of this business. Our product is two years out."

The company beat street estimates to report its highest-ever net profit at ₹918 crore for the first quarter ended June 30. Total revenue from operations for the quarter under review stood at ₹3,986 crore, up 17.3% as compared to ₹3,397 crore in the corresponding quarter of FY23. Ebitda stood at ₹1,021 crore, up 22.8% as compared to ₹831 crore in the same quarter of the previous financial year. "Q1 has been significant for Eicher Motors as both Royal Enfield and VECV have registered their best ever first quarter performance, and have recorded tremendous growth", Lal informed.

## Sun Pharma Profit Drops to ₹2,023 cr

Mumbai: Sun Pharma on Thursday reported a 2% year-on-year (YoY) drop in net profit to ₹2,023 crore in Q1FY24 due to exceptional items worth ₹323 crore. The company reported net profit of ₹2,061 crore during the corresponding quarter of the same period.

Revenue rose 10.7% YoY to ₹11,785 crore in Q1FY24. Excluding exceptional items, net profit for Q1FY24 has grown 13.8% to ₹2,345 crore. The exceptional items included ₹149 crore impairment charge of an acquired intangible asset under development, ₹123 crore loss foreign exchange loss pertaining to Ranbaxy Nigeria due to devaluation of local currency there against US dollar and \$6.2 million planned relocation of Achee operations from California to New York.

The earnings for interest, tax, depreciation and amortisation (Ebitda) rose 15.5% to ₹3,332 crore in Q1, and Ebitda margins expanded 110 basis points YoY to 27.9%. India formulation sales rose 5.1% YoY to ₹3,560 crore in Q1FY24.

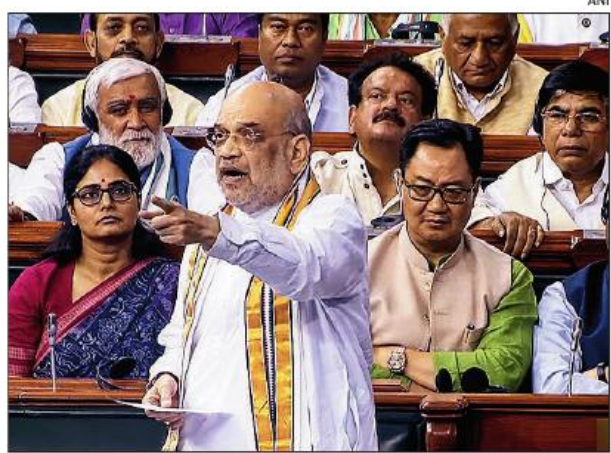

# Delhi always meant to be UT, says Shah, cites Nehru & Patel

New Delhi: Union home minister Amit Shah, during a high-intensity debate that preceded the passage of the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (Amendment) Bill, 2023 in the Lok Sabha on Thursday, said it was necessitated because after the Supreme Court order, the Delhi government had started replacing officers who were crucial to the probe into "corruption charges" against CM Arvind Kejriwal and others and tried to block the functioning of the vigilance department.



Amit Shah blamed Arvind Kejriwal for regular conflicts between the Centre and the Delhi government, emphasising that the current scheme of division of powers between the two entities had been in place since 1993, and had worked well despite the fact that control of the Union government and that of Delhi alternated between BJP and Congress

"After getting the court order, their concerns should have been about roads and buildings, water supply, sanitation and healthcare. But they were concerned about vigilance. They targeted the vigilance department because there are many sensitive files lying closed. They were the files of the excise scam, the file related to the opinion to be stated in the judiciary, a case in which the Delhi deputy chief minister is in jail, the file related to the chief minister's illegal home building exercise which could land him in trouble," Shah said and cited several cases in which vigilance inquiry against the Kejriwal government were pending.

The animosity between BJP and JD(U) also came to the fore with their leaders Rajiv Ranjan (Lalan Singh) and Union minister Ashwini Choubey exchanging heated barbs. Shah blamed Kejriwal for the situation of regular conflict between the Centre and the Delhi government, emphasising that while the current scheme of division of powers between the two entities had been in place since 1993, and had worked well despite the fact that control of the Union government and that of NCT of Delhi alternated between BJP and Congress.

He asserted that even the SC verdict in question had acknowledged that Parliament was empowered to make laws for the national capital and said there was a consensus in the Constituent Assembly that Delhi should remain a Union Territory. He cited a whole range of stalwarts — from the first President Dr Rajendra Prasad and the first Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel and C Rajagopalachari to say that Delhi was always meant to be a Union Territory; although one with special features, rather than a fully fledged state. He also said while Delhi initially used to have an assembly, it was taken away in 1956 and Nehru had justified the decision by citing the "changed circumstances".

The discussion on the bill witnessed fiery speeches from BJP MPs from Delhi who alleged "corruption" and failure in governance against the AAP government. It also saw the suspension of the lone and newly-elected AAP member Sushil Kumar Rinku for the remaining part of the monsoon session after he tore and threw a copy of the bill towards the chair.

"This was because no one had the intention of usurping the other government's power. Neither Congress nor the BJP fought with each other. But in 2015, the situation changed since the party which came to occupy power in Delhi had no intention to serve and was driven by the intent to fight," he said, referring to AAP's dramatic ascension to power.

In the absence of AAP, the cudgels for the party was taken up by its new-found allies who attacked the government for trampling upon the spirit of federalism and encroaching upon the rights of states.

The home minister dubbed the unity efforts a futile exercise and the hope of holding on to Kejriwal misplaced. "You will not be able to defeat PM Narendra Modi because BJP will again get a majority of its own and Kejriwal will leave you as soon as you have complied with his diktat and voted against the bill," he said.

# 'Parliament has power to enact law, SC's call if it's good or bad'

New Delhi: Jaganmohan Reddy's YSRCP and Naveen Patnaik's BJD on Thursday supported the Delhi services bill in Lok Sabha, as announced by the two outfits earlier, amid protests by the opposition bloc in the House.

"People are watching you."

The bill seeks creation of the National Capital Civil Services Authority for deciding transfer and posting of civil servants. It will replace the ordinance promulgated by the Centre on May 19. Participating in the debate on the bill, BJD member Pinaki Misra said Parliament had the power to enact a law and let the Supreme Court decide whether it is a good law or bad law.

"This was because no one had the intention of usurping the other government's power. Neither Congress nor the BJP fought with each other. But in 2015, the situation changed since the party which came to occupy power in Delhi had no intention to serve and was driven by the intent to fight," he said, referring to AAP's dramatic ascension to power.

This law cannot be brought with respect of "full states" such as Odisha, Rajasthan and West Bengal. This can be done only in the case of the National Capital Territory of Delhi which has peculiar and special status, he said.

YSRCP MP P V Midhun Reddy said it is a unique bill and expressed hope that it is not replicated for other states. Delhi government had approached the Supreme Court for staying the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (Amendment) Ordinance, 2023.

However, the Supreme Court last month refused to grant an interim stay on the Centre's ordinance on control over services in Delhi. It referred it to Constitution Bench. The National Capital Civil Services Authority will consist of the Delhi CM, the chief secretary and principal home secretary. The bill empowers the Authority to make recommendations to the Delhi lieutenant governor (LG) regarding transfer and posting of officials and disciplinary matters.

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# Tiff Over 'Sexual Favours': Man Killed, His Body Dumped In Drain

## 32-Year-Old Met Suspect At Queer Party, Had Gone Missing 26 Days Ago

New Delhi: The body of a 32-year-old man was recovered from a drain in Sector 14B of Dwarka on Wednesday, 26 days after he went missing from south Delhi's Moolchand. Police arrested the alleged murderer and said he had admitted he was annoyed by the constant demand for sexual favours and had shot him dead in a fit of rage.

Chandan Chowdhary DCP (South), said, "The victim went missing on July 9. On July 14, his father received a ransom call for Rs 20 lakh, which was negotiated to Rs 15 lakh. A case of kidnapping for ransom was registered at Ambedkar Nagar police station." Chowdhary explained that though a case of kidnapping for ransom was registered, it later became clear that the victim and the accused, Shashank Singh, knew each other. Singh apparently first ran into the victim at a party around June 20 and the two had met 5-6 times after that. "The victim was looking for a job and Singh was helping him. They decided to meet near Moolchand. On July 9, the two men met there and left for Dwarka in Singh's car," said the DCP. A police statement said Singh had killed the victim because of a disagreement over sexual favours. Chowdhary said, "So far it is

not clear who was pressuring whom for sexual favours."

A team from Greater Kailash police station led by inspector Ajit Kumar, ASI Kamlesh and head constable Sunil scanned CCTV footage and

spotted the duo near a mall in Dwarka buying pizza, the payment of which was done by the victim. The investigators said they also took beer and then proceeded towards a lonely place in Sector 14. There,

they drank the beer and then had an argument following which Singh shot his friend dead. He then packed the body in a suitcase and dumped it in the main drain at Sector 14B. The accused had purcha-

sed the pistol from a friend in Bihar, said the cops.

An officer privy to the investigation revealed, "Singh cleaned his car and dumped the blood-stained items in the Yamuna. On July 12, he dumped his pistol in the river. Since he had studied mass communication, he was aware that the missing person's details would be uploaded on the police website. Once he had the details, in order to mislead police, he purchased a SIM card on July 13 and phoned the victim's father demanding a ransom. He made several such calls but when the family asked him for proof about the kidnapping, he disconnected the call."

Apart from the footage at the Dwarka mall, police also discovered that Singh had withdrawn Rs 27,000 from an ATM in Noida after the murder. While Singh wore a helmet while withdrawing the money, the ATM footage showed Singh arriving on a scooter. The backtracking of footage led the police to Sunlight Colony where Singh was finally taken into custody on Wednesday morning. He confessed to his crime, and police recovered 14 mobile phones with SIMs bought on fake IDs, the scooter and the car used in the crime.

The victim's family alleged that police did not respond to the kidnapping in time, leading to his death, an accusation the cops refuted.
