Muddy river worries Arunachal locals

ITANAGAR: The water in Arunachal's Siang river has turned muddy, an indication of possible construction activity in upstream China, alarming people in the border state, officials said. According to the officials in Pisahat, the headquarters of East Siang district, the river, which is the state's principal waterway, changed its colour and turned turbid some three days ago. "There is mud flowing in the water, which is unnatural given the fact that the region received no rain in the past few days. We are monitoring the situation with help from officials of the water resources department," East Siang Deputy Commissioner (DC) Tayi Taggu stated.

Woman gets hit by Vande Bharat Express train

ANAND: A 54-year-old woman died after being hit by the semi high-speed Vande Bharat Express train near Anand in Gujarat on Tuesday afternoon, Railway Police said. The victim, identified as Beatrice Archibald Peter, was crossing the track near Anand railway station when the accident took place at 4.37 pm, said a police official here. Peter, a resident of Ahmedabad, was reportedly visiting a relative at Anand, he said. The train was on its way from Gandhinagar Capital to Mumbai Central. It does not halt at Anand railway station. Prime Minister Narendra Modi had on September 30 flagged off the inaugural run of the train from Gandhinagar Capital station. In the last one month, the train has suffered damage on three occasions due to collision with cattle on the tracks.

625 fresh COVID-19 cases in India, no death

NEW DELHI: India saw a single-day rise of 625 fresh COVID-19 cases, the lowest since April 9, 2020, while no death was reported in a span of 24 hours in first such instance since March 2020, the Union health ministry said on Tuesday. The country's infection tally has climbed to 4,46,62,141, while the active cases have declined to 14,021, the ministry data updated at 8 am stated. The death toll has remained at 5,30,509.

Boat capsizes in UP, kills 3

BARABANKI: Three people, including two children, drowned when a boat carrying 20 people capsized in the Sumli river here on Tuesday, police said. The deceased have been identified as Priyanka (5), Himanshu (8) and Ritu Yadav (18), they said. Expressing grief over this accident, Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has directed officials to provide immediate help to the affected families. District Magistrate Avinash Kumar announced financial assistance of Rs 4 lakh each to the next of kin of the deceased from the disaster fund.

Food clash on Eclipse day

Bhubaneswar: Two groups clashed here in Berhampur town on Tuesday over consumption of food on lunar eclipse day which led to the police to intervene to control the situation. A clash took place at Lohia Academy building in Bhubaneswar where a group of people identifying themselves as rationalists organized a community feast and was opposed by a number of people claiming to be traditionalists, the police said. The second group, most of them youths, forcibly entered the Lohia Academy premises when the community feast was going on and attacked the rationalists.

Education is not a business: SC

New Delhi: Education is not a business to earn profit and tuition fees shall always be affordable, the Supreme Court has said while upholding the Andhra Pradesh High Court order quashing the state government's decision to enhance the tuition fee in medical colleges to Rs 24 lakh per annum. A bench of Justices M R Shah and Sudhanshu Dhulia imposed a cost of Rs 5 lakh on the petitioner, Ranayana Medical College, and Andhra Pradesh to be deposited with the court registry within a period of six weeks. "To enhance the fee to Rs 24 lakh per annum i.e., seven times more than the fee fixed earlier was not justifiable at all. Education is not the business to earn profit. The tuition fee shall always be affordable," the bench said.

BJP got 27 years, give us 5, Kejriwal tells Gujaratis

Delhi CM promises free electricity and end to inflation if AAP gets power

KESHOD: Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday said the BJP has ruled in Gujarat for 27 years and people should now give a chance to his Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) for five years.

Holding roadshows in Junagadh district on the last day of his five-day tour, he said he would not ask for votes next time if an AAP government did not fulfil its promises.

"When we form a government in Gujarat, I will take the responsibility of your family as your brother and a member of your family. The first thing needed to be done is to end inflation. Neither the BJP nor Congress talk about inflation," he told a

gathering at Keshod in the district. "The AAP government will pay people's electricity bills, he said, adding that in Delhi and Punjab people get electricity round-the-clock with "zero bills".

"I just have one request to make. You have given them (the BJP) 27 years, give me five years. I am only asking for five years...if I do not work, next time I will not come to ask for a vote," Kejriwal said.

"I am an educated, honest man who knows how to build schools and hospitals. If you want dirty politics and hooliganism, then go to them (the BJP). If you want schools and hospitals, then come to me, I am an engineer; I know how to work," Kejriwal said.

Karnataka Congress on correction mode after its leader says word 'Hindu' is Persian

Karnataka Congress working president Satish Jarkiholi left the party in a soup by claiming that the word 'Hindu' is Persian and has a dirty and unpleasant meaning.

Mr Jarkiholi has admitted that he did make the statement and stands by it. The party termed it "deeply unfortunate" and rejected it "unequivocally". Karnataka Congress president DK Shivakumar on Tuesday said, "Jarkiholi's statement is his personal opinion and not the Congress party's opinion. We will ask for his explanation."

On Tuesday, Jarkiholi claimed many books mentioning the "Persian" roots of the word 'Hindu' and offered to resign if anyone can prove him wrong.

Speaking to the media later, he said he will step down as a legislator if he is proved wrong. The sugar baron gave the party a bitter taste. Reacting to the comments, the

All-India Congress Committee termed it deeply unfortunate and rejected it "unequivocally". "Hinduism is a way of life and a civilisational reality. Congress built our nation to respect every religion, belief and faith. This is the essence of India. The statement attributed to Jarkiholi is deeply unfortunate and deserves to be rejected. We condemn it unequivocally," said AICC general secretary and Karnataka in-charge Randeep Singh Surjewala.

The BJP latched on to the controversy and termed it as an attempt to appease minority voters ahead of the 2023 Assembly election.

Condemning the remark, Chief Minister Basavaraj S Bommai asked: "They make statements with half-knowledge to appease voters and dream to get minority votes. This is anti-national and everyone should condemn it. Is Rahul Gandhi and Mr Siddaramiah's silence endorsing Jarkiholi's statements?"

HC stays order to block Cong Twitter account

BENGALURU: The Karnataka High Court has stayed a lower court's order directing Twitter to block Congress party's account over infringement of copyright.

The 85th additional city civil and sessions judge, Lathakumari, had Monday passed an ex-parte interim order directing Twitter to block the handles of Indian National Congress and its Bharat Jodo Yatra over alleged unauthorised use of music of movie KGF Chapter 2.

Considering the prima facie material available against INC, Congress leaders Supriya Shrinete and Rahul Gandhi for "having infringed the statutory copyright owned and held by the plaintiffs and unauthorised and illegally used the sound records of the film KGF: Chapter 2 by affixing their logo on the videos and further considering the provisions of IT Act, Twitter Inc is directed to remove and take down from its platform the three links till further orders and further block the social media (INC and Bharat Jodo handles) till the next date," the judge had said.

Court defers Gyanvapi judgement to Nov 14

Varanasi: A fast track court on Tuesday postponed till Nov 14, the judgment on a petition seeking permission to allow worship of a Shilving claimed to have been found in the Gyanvapi mosque complex in UP's Varanasi.

As civil judge (senior division) Justice Mahendra Pandey is on leave, the court posted the matter for Nov 14, Assistant District government counsel Sulabh Prakash said. After hearing arguments of both sides, the court on Oct 27 reserved its order on the suit for Nov 8. On May 24, plaintiff Kiran Singh, the general secretary

of the Vishwa Vedic Sanatan Sangh, filed the suit in the Varanasi district court seeking a ban on the entry of Muslims into the Gyanvapi complex, handing over of the complex to the Sanatan Sangh and permission to offer prayers at the Shilving.

On May 25, district court judge AK Vishvesh had ordered the transfer of the suit to a fast-track court. Meanwhile, district judge AK Vishvesh is hearing another case demanding a survey of closed underground places in the Gyanvapi premises. This case will be heard on Nov 11.



I am Janta ka laadla: Kejriwal

NEW DELHI

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday said he was "the darling of the people" and alleged that the BJP was troubled by the love he was getting.

Kejriwal and the Aam Aadmi Party have come in for fierce criticism ahead of elections to the Municipal Corporation of Delhi and the Gujarat Assembly with BJP leaders calling it "the most corrupt party".

"Before Punjab (Assembly) elections, PM (Narendra Modi) said Kejriwal is a terrorist. Home Minister (Amit Shah) set up an inquiry. What happened to it? Now, before the Gujarat and the MCD polls, they are saying Kejriwal is corrupt. If Kejriwal is a terrorist or is corrupt, arrest him, no?" Kejriwal said in a tweet in Hindi. "Kejriwal is neither a terrorist nor corrupt. Kejriwal is 'janta ka laadla' (darling of the people). The BJP has a problem with him." The 250-ward Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) goes to polls on December 4 while counting will take place on December 7.

The BJP, which has governed the civic bodies in Delhi since 2007, is pitted against a resurgent Aam Aadmi Party and the Congress.

The victim, identified as Beatrice Archibald Peter, was crossing the track near Anand railway station when the accident took place at 4.37 pm, said a police official here. Peter, a resident of Ahmedabad, was reportedly visiting a relative at Anand, he said. The train was on its way from Gandhinagar Capital to Mumbai Central. It does not halt at Anand railway station. Prime Minister Narendra Modi had on September 30 flagged off the inaugural run of the train from Gandhinagar Capital station. In the last one month, the train has suffered damage on three occasions due to collision with cattle on the tracks.

625 fresh COVID-19 cases in India, no death

NEW DELHI: India saw a single-day rise of 625 fresh COVID-19 cases, the lowest since April 9, 2020, while no death was reported in a span of 24 hours in first such instance since March 2020, the Union health ministry said on Tuesday. The country's infection tally has climbed to 4,46,62,141, while the active cases have declined to 14,021, the ministry data updated at 8 am stated. The death toll has remained at 5,30,509.

Boat capsizes in UP, kills 3

BARABANKI: Three people, including two children, drowned when a boat carrying 20 people capsized in the Sumli river here on Tuesday, police said. The deceased have been identified as Priyanka (5), Himanshu (8) and Ritu Yadav (18), they said. Expressing grief over this accident, Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has directed officials to provide immediate help to the affected families. District Magistrate Avinash Kumar announced financial assistance of Rs 4 lakh each to the next of kin of the deceased from the disaster fund.

Food clash on Eclipse day

Bhubaneswar: Two groups clashed here and in Berhampur town on Tuesday over consumption of food on lunar eclipse day which led to the police to intervene to control the situation. A clash took place at Lohia Academy building in Bhubaneswar where a group of people identifying themselves as rationalists organized a community feast and was opposed by a number of people claiming to be traditionalists, the police said. The second group, most of them youths, forcibly entered the Lohia Academy premises when the community feast was going on and attacked the rationalists.

Education is not a business: SC

New Delhi: Education is not a business to earn profit and tuition fees shall always be affordable, the Supreme Court has said while upholding the Andhra Pradesh High Court order quashing the state government's decision to enhance the tuition fee in medical colleges to Rs 24 lakh per annum. A bench of Justices M R Shah and Sudhanshu Dhulia imposed a cost of Rs 5 lakh on the petitioner, Narayana Medical College, and Andhra Pradesh to be deposited with the court registry within a period of six weeks. "To enhance the fee to Rs 24 lakh per annum i.e., seven times more than the fee fixed earlier was not justifiable at all. Education is not the business to earn profit. The tuition fee shall always be affordable," the bench said.

ROW OVER 'HINDU IS PERSIAN' STATEMENT

I AM NOT SORRY: CONG LEADER

Despite his statement that the word 'Hindu' is Persian and it has a 'dirty' meaning, drawing widespread criticism, Karnataka Congress Working President Satish Jarkiholi on Tuesday sought to defend himself saying he was only referring to what has been written and published. Ruling out any apology, the former Minister said he wants a debate on the issue and if proved wrong, he would resign as a legislator. "What I have said, 90 percent of people have probably not heard it completely. Just because there is a reference to the word Hindu and as I have said that it has a very dirty meaning, it has been interpreted however they want, there is nothing new in this, and such things have happened many times in the past," Jarkiholi said. Speaking to reporters here, he

reiterated that the word Hindu comes from Persian and there is evidence for it, and said that it has a dirty meaning, referring to a dictionary published in 1963. "What I have said is not my own, and I have said that let there be a debate, that's my intention, but people interpret it however they want, I can't do much about it. I'm ready for discussion with evidence...if someone proves me wrong, I will resign as MLA," he added. Questioning as to why he should apologise, the Yamakanardi legislator said whatever he has said are not his statements but what has been written and published. "In fact those pointing fingers at me should have seen and rectified it, I have done what they should have done, they should be thankful to me," he said adding that he is being unnecessarily targeted by a system including "Manuwadis".

K'taka CM unhappy

Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai on Tuesday condemned the statement of KPCC working president Satish Jarkiholi that the term 'Hindu' is of Persian origin and its meaning is 'dirty and insulting'. Talking to reporters at the Udupi helipad before his departure after engagements in the city, Bommai said the Congress party should apologise for Jarkiholi's statement. Noting that Jarkiholi's remark should be condemned by all, he wondered why Congress leaders including Rahul Gandhi and Siddaramaiah are silent on the statement. He wanted to know whether the Congress approved the statement. The Chief Minister said Jarkiholi's remark was not incidental and it was made with a purpose to lure votes of minority communities. He is under the illusion that Congress will gain minority votes by insulting the Hindu religion, Bommai said.

Former State Finance Minister and Left leader T M Thomas Isaac, CITU leader Anathalavattom Anandan, Left leader and MP John Brittas were among others who participated in the protest march.

An agitated Kerala Governor had on Monday bluntly told journalists representing Kairali News and MediaOne television channels to "get out" of a press conference here and asserted that he would not talk to them. The KUWJ said it "decries all attempts on part of Kerala Raj Bhavan to interfere in the free and independent functioning of journalists and the selective denial of journalistic access." In a letter addressed to the Governor, KUWJ asked Khan to "rethink" prejudices against some media houses and ensure that the right to practice freedom of profession is enjoyed by all journalists.

HC sets aside order blocking INC Twitter handles

BENGALURU

A division bench of the High Court of Karnataka has set aside an order of a designated economic court that ordered blocking of @INCIndia and @BharatJodo Twitter handles calling it "punitive action." The order is subject to the Congress party removing the offending content before noon on Wednesday. The Congress agreed to remove the 45-second clip that used the copyrighted song before noon on Wednesday from all its social media accounts.

The HC ordered the party to provide screenshots of the Twitter handle and the other social media accounts before the contentious material was removed. The HC ordered, "We are of the opinion that prayer deserves to be allowed to set aside impugned order, subject to appellant taking down offending material." The lower court had given the order on Monday in a suit filed by MRT Studios which claimed 45 seconds of its copyrighted music from 'KGF Chapter 2' movie was used in a 'Bharat Jodo' song by the Congress party.



I am Janta ka laadla: Kejriwal

NEW DELHI

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday said he was "the darling of the people" and alleged that the BJP was troubled by the love he was getting. Kejriwal and the Aam Aadmi Party have come in for fierce criticism ahead of elections to the Municipal Corporation of Delhi and the Gujarat Assembly with BJP leaders calling it "the most corrupt party". "Before Punjab (Assembly) elections, PM (Narendra Modi) said Kejriwal is a terrorist. Home Minister (Amit Shah) set up an inquiry. What happened to it? Now, before the Gujarat and the MCD polls, they are saying Kejriwal is corrupt. If Kejriwal is a terrorist or is corrupt, arrest him, no?" Kejriwal said in a tweet in Hindi. "Kejriwal is neither a terrorist nor corrupt. Kejriwal is 'janta ka laadla' (darling of the people). The BJP has a problem with him." The 250-ward Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) goes to polls on December 4 while counting will take place on December 7. The BJP, which has governed the civic bodies in Delhi since 2007, is pitted against a resurgent Aam Aadmi Party and the Congress.
