Himachal Votes Today; BJP Relies on Modi Magic, Congress Upbeat

At A Glance

More than 5.5 million in Himachal Pradesh can vote to decide the fate of 412 candidates in fray for the state's 68 assembly seats on Saturday. As in the previous years, the electoral fight in the state -- which has a long history of voting out the incumbent party -- is largely between the ruling BJP and Congress, which has suffered a spate of defeats in recent years. While Cong promises to restore Old Pension Scheme, BJP relies on Modi's call for a double-engine govt

New Delhi: An aggressive BJP campaign to retain power and a strong counter-offensive by an up-beat state unit of Congress that is banking on its promise to restore the Old Pension Scheme, the issues of government jobs and Agniveer have made the Himachal Pradesh elections highly interesting this time. The electorate will cast its vote on Saturday in a single phase election. The previous elections in Himachal Pradesh, which has an assembly of 68 seats, would not create much euphoria as they were held along with Gujarat which hogged all the attention. The tradition in the hill state of voting out the incumbent was another dampener. However, this time both BJP and Congress are fighting this election aggressively and are optimistic about their prospects. Victory in the Mandi Lok Sabha byelection and three assembly seats has come as a shot in the arm for Congress. It is also hopeful of winning as the ruling party has always been booted out since 1985. The passing away of senior Congress leader and former chief minister Virbhadra Singh in July 2021 has left the party leaderless but there are also chances of this creating some sympathy for it, especially in the Shimla, Solan and Sirmaur belt. Congress has promised restoration of the Old Pension Scheme which was discontinued in 2004. It has again gained a lot of traction in the state. Since the hill state does not have much industrialisation, government jobs, especially in the defence forces, are a prime attraction. OPS has become the talking point in this election and Congress has cited the example of Rajasthan and Chhattisgarh where it claims it has implemented the pension scheme. BJP is banking mainly on the popularity of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his call for a "double-engine" government with the same party in power at the Centre and in the state for speedy growth and smooth delivery of central welfare schemes. The voters have also expressed their anger at the rise in prices of essential commodities such as LPG cylinders and mustard oil. This has blunted the promises of women empowerment made in the BJP manifesto. The BJP state leadership has also failed to inspire much confidence in the people of the state. The stakes are high for BJP also as it is the home state of party chief JP Nadda. A high number of rebel candidates this time can upset all calculations of political parties. BJP is the worst affected as 21 party rebels are in the fray this time. While some will cut into the saffron party vote share, a few are strong enough to romp home to victory. In case of a hung assembly BJP may, however, find it easier to win back its rebels if the party is close to pole position. Though the BJP promise of implementing the Uniform Civil Code created much hype, it is not much of an issue for the electorate. Seen as a polarising issue, it did not create a buzz as the minority population is less than 10%. BJP has promised creation of more jobs in the state as new projects have been sanctioned or completed. This includes a pharma park and an AIIMS at Bilaspur. But the youth, a majority of whom prefer to join the defence forces, are not enthused by the Agniveer scheme as it gives a short term employment. Those aspiring to join the army there are looking for a permanent job and pension. The vote difference between BJP (48.8%) and Congress (41.7%) in 2017 stood at around 7%. Though some of the votes will go to rebel candidates and to a small extent AAP - it is a direct contest between the old political rivals. The election results will be announced on December 8.

Senior K'taka Leaders Should Make Way for Youngsters, says BJP MP

New Delhi: After the senior leaders in Gujarat announced to make way for the younger generation, echoes of similar generational shift has started in Karnataka BJP. The state is scheduled for assembly elections in March next year. BJP Rajya Sabha MP from Karnataka, Lahar Singh Siroya, welcomed the decision and said it should become a model for Karnataka in the upcoming assembly elections. "What has happened in Gujarat should serve as a model in Karnataka too. This is a commendable move to strengthen democracy by allowing a smooth generational change. Karnataka assembly polls will be held in a few months from now. Senior leaders in the state should make way for younger people in the larger interest of the state and nation," Siroya wrote on Twitter on Friday. Modi Hails K'taka Double-engine Govt for State's Progress

Alleges previous Cong regime used to consider speed as luxury and scale as risk

Bengaluru: Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Friday that speed, aspiration and scale are the strengths of India, taking potshots at the previous Congress-led UPA regime, which, he said, used to consider speed as luxury and scale as risk. "We changed this mindset absolutely," he said, addressing a public gathering in Bengaluru. "Karnataka's double engine government is focusing equally on both physical as well as social infrastructure," he said, alluding to the same political party being in power both at the Centre and in the state, working with the same sense of purpose. Karnataka, the only state in southern India where the BJP is in power, is headed for assembly election in five months amid a tough challenge mounted by the opposition Congress. In Bengaluru, Modi unveiled a 108-foot bronze statue of Kempe Gowda, the builder of Bengaluru, and offered floral tributes to saint Kanakadasa and sage-poet Maharsi Valmiki, all three events politically significant for the BJP. The politically influential Vokkaligas, Kurubas and Valmikis (Scheduled Tribes) communities claim the three iconic personalities as their own and celebrate their legacy.

"The India before 2014 was something altogether different than the present prosperous and technically advanced India," Modi said, referring to the BJP's ascent to power at the Centre eight years ago. "India is heralding a new chapter of infra-development under PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan." In Karnataka, he said, the government has sanctioned about 800,000 pucca houses for the poor and given water connectivity to about three million rural households. Modi showered praise on Bengaluru and its technology professionals, who, he said, turned Make in India, the 5G rollout and the UPI a big success. "India is known all over the world for its startups and Bengaluru plays a vital role in getting India established as a startup hub," he said. Last year, Modi said, Karnataka was a pioneer in attracting foreign direct investments (FDI). Investments were not limited to just the information technology (IT) sector but covered sectors from biotechnology to defence manufacturing. "In the past three years, when the world was affected by Covid-19, Karnataka managed to attract Rs 4 lakh crore of investment. It remained the top FDI destination last year," he said. Earlier, the PM also inaugurated a second state-of-the-art terminal at the Fairfax Group-controlled Kempegowda International and flagged off Vande Bharat Express and Bharat Gaurav Kashi Darshan Train at the railway station in Bengaluru.

Discontent Among Those Denied Tickets; Four Quit BJP in Gujarat

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Gandhinagar: The announcement of BJP's first list of 160 candidates has increased the disquiet in the party. Two BJP MLAs of the outgoing Gujarat assembly and two former MLAs have announced their decision to contest the forthcoming polls after they were denied tickets by their party to recontest. Waghdia MLA Madhu Shrivastava, known for his strong-arm tactics, has said that he would contest as an independent or candidate of another party after he was denied a renomination. BJP has fielded district president Ashwin Patel for the seat. Shrivastava had begun his career as an independent, in 1995, but thereafter joined the BJP. Shrivastava has often courted controversy with his brusque remarks. In Matar, two-term MLA Kesrinsinh Solanki quit BJP and joined the Aam Aadmi Party, after he was not included in the BJP list of contenders. Solanki has faced several allegations, including 'instigating policemen' to beat up people. In Padra, BJP's 2012 MLA and Baroda Dairy Chairman Dinesh Patel announced his candidature as an Independent after BJP nominated Chaitanyasinh Zala for the seat. Patel had switched from the Congress to BJP, in a similar fashion, in 2007. He has been a contestant since 1998. Patel had alleged that Zala, a municipal corporator from Padra, had sabotaged his chances of winning in 2017. Former Bayad MLA and Alpesh Thakore associate Dhawal Zala too is reportedly peeved after he was denied a seat. BJP, meanwhile, is trying to find a safe seat for Thakore, who would face a stiff contest in Radhanpur. There are plans to field him in Gandhinagar, much to the chagrin of local BJP workers. Discontent is also brewing among the Chudala Kali community in Saurashtra, as BJP is yet to name any candidate from the community. Former BJP MP Devi Fatepara did not mind his words while lashing out at the party. He said the 'community has been wronged' by the party. Panchmahal district panchayat vice president Kathy Pagi too quit the party after BJP renominated outgoing MLA Jetha Bharwad.

Cong, NCP Forge Pre-poll Alliance in Gujarat

Gandhinagar: After Gandhinagar: After declaring its second list of 46 candidates late on Thursday night, Gujarat Congress on Friday announced a pre-poll tie-up with Nationalist Congress Party. Congress will share three seats of Umreth in Anand District, Devgarh Baria in Dahod district and Naroda in Ahmedabad with NCP. Interestingly, Congress had sent out a tough signal to NCP by fielding its own candidate in Kutiyana in Saurashtra where NCP candidate Kandhal Jadeja is a sitting MLA. Kandhal's siding with BJP during 2017 Rajya Sabha polls had riled Congress. This time Congress went ahead to field its own candidate even before finalising the seat-sharing. Speaking to ET, a senior Congress member had earlier said while NCP and Congress are natural allies, Kandhal's transgression could not be tolerated. Meanwhile, the party also announced its third list of six candidates taking the total list of candidates announced to 95. The party also changed its Gandevi candidate Shankar Patel and replaced him with Ashok Patel. The party has repeated 21 sitting MLAs so far. Notably, the party fielded Indranil Rajyaguru from Rajkot East seat. Rajyaguru had returned to Congress recently after AAP announced Sudan Gadhvi as its Chief Ministerial candidate. Senior leaders such as Paresh Dhana, Punjab Vansh, Lalit Kagathara, Lalit Vasoya, Pratap Dudhat, Amrinder Der have been renominated from their respective seats.

Aaditya Joins Bharat Jodo Yatra, Walks Arm in Arm With Rahul Gandhi

Mumbai: Aaditya Thackeray, grandson of the late Shiv Sena supreme and Hindutva ideologue Bal Thackeray, on Friday walked shoulder to shoulder and hand in hand with Congress leader Rahul Gandhi during the Bharat Jodo Yatra in Hingoli. Aaditya was accompanied by Maharashtra legislative council leader Ambadas Danve and Sena leader Sachin Ahir. A number of Sena grassroots functionaries too joined the yatra, shouting slogans like "Pannas Khokhe Ek Dum Ok", a reference to Shiv Sena's allegation that CM Eknath Shinde and 40 Shiv Sena MLAs had brought down the MVA government after being paid 50 lakh each. The Shinde camp has denied the allegation and said they would be suing those making such charges. The participation of Thackeray junior in a Congress rally is remarkable, considering the Shiv Sena has been proudly owning its role in the demolition of Babri Masjid, while the Congress has been projecting itself as a progressive party. "Indira Gandhi had good equations with Balasaheb. We have good friendships between Congress and Shiv Sena leaders. Balasaheb had supported Pratibha Patil and Pranab Mukherjee (during the Presidential polls). We have come together (for saving) democracy and the constitution," he said. NCP Leader Awhad, 11 Others Arrested for Disrupting Show of Movie on Shivaji

Mumbai: A senior NCP leader Jitendra Awhad was arrested on Friday by the Thane police for rioting after he and his supporters allegedly disrupted a screening of the Marathi movie Har Har Mahadev that has turned political parties up against each other. Awhad is considered very close to NCP chief Sharad Pawar and the party has reacted to the arrest by calling it an 'abuse of power' by the state government. Awhad was arrested on Friday afternoon after he was called in for questioning by the Thane police for an incident on November 7 when Awhad and his supporters barged into Viviana Mall in Thane that was screening the movie. The film, based on the life of Maratha warrior king Shivaji, has turned controversial as descendants of Shivaji, including a BJP MLA, have alleged distortion of history. Awhad, along with his supporters, have also been charged with beating up some of the movie goers who were watching the movie in the multiplex. Awhad and 11 others have been booked by the police for rioting and unlawful assembly. During his arrest Awhad tweeted: "Today at around 1pm the Vartak Nagar police called me and asked me to come to the police to accept a notice (regarding the Viviana Mall incident). When I went to the police station, the police engaged me in a conversation and after a while the Deputy Commissioner of Police came and I realised something was up through his expressions. मूडीज ने वृद्धि दर अनुमान घटाया

वैश्विक रेटिंग एजेंसी मूडीज ने वर्ष 2022 के लिए भारत की आर्थिक वृद्धि दर के अनुमान को घटाकर 7 फीसदी कर दिया है। मूडीज ने कहा कि वैश्विक नरमी और घरेलू स्तर पर उच्च ब्याज दर आर्थिक गति को प्रभावित करेगी। यह दूसरा मौका है जब मूडीज इन्वेस्टर सर्विसेज ने 2022 के लिए भारत के सकल घरेलू उत्पाद की वृद्धि दर के अनुमान को कम किया है। इससे पहले, सितंबर में उसने आर्थिक वृद्धि दर के अनुमान को घटाकर 7.7 फीसदी कर दिया था। जबकि मई में इसके 8.8 फीसदी रहने की संभावना जताई गई थी। मूडीज का अनुमान है कि वृद्धि दर 2023 में घटकर 4.8 फीसदी और 2024 में बढ़कर 6.4 फीसदी रहेगी।

डीसीएक्स सिस्टम्स का शेयर 48 फीसदी चढ़ा

अमेरिका में मुद्रास्फीति की रफ्तार थमने से भारत सहित दुनिया भर के बाजारों में तेजी

अमेरिका में उपभोक्ता मूल्य सूचकांक आधारित मुद्रास्फीति उम्मीद से ज्यादा कम होने से भारत सहित दुनिया भर के शेयर बाजारों में आज जोरदार तेजी देखी गई। बेंचमार्क संसेक्स सर्वकालिक रिपोर्ट ऊंचाई पर पहुंच गया। निवेशकों ने मुद्रास्फीति घटने और फेडरल रिजर्व के रुख में नरमी की उम्मीद में शेयर बाजार में लिवाली की जिससे दुनिया भर के बाजारों में तेजी आई।

अमेरिका में अक्टूबर महीने की मुद्रास्फीति घटकर 7.7 फीसदी रह गई जो जनवरी के बाद का निचला स्तर है। मुद्रास्फीति घटने से अमेरिकी डॉलर भी नरम हुआ और वॉल स्ट्रीट में 2020 के बाद एक दिन में सबसे बड़ी तेजी दर्ज की गई। एस&P 500 सूचकांक गुरुवार को 5.5 फीसदी बढ़त पर बंद हुआ और नैस्डैक भी 7.4 फीसदी लाभ में रहा। अमेरिकी बाजार से संकेत लेते हुए संसेक्स भी 700 अंक ऊपर खुला और कारोबार की समाप्ति पर 1,181 अंक की तेजी के साथ 61,795 के सर्वकालिक उच्च स्तर पर बंद हुआ। इससे पहले यह 18 अक्टूबर, 2021 को यह 61,766 के उच्चतम स्तर पर बंद हुआ था। निफ्टी भी 322 अंक के लाभ

के साथ 18,350 पर बंद हुआ। हालांकि यह अपने सर्वकालिक उच्चतम स्तर 18,477 से 127 अंक नीचे है। ऐक्सिस सिक्योरिटीज में मुख्य निवेश अधिकारी नवीन कुलकर्णी ने कहा, 'बाजार पिछले कुछ समय से सतर्कता दिखा रहा था और निवेशक अमेरिका में अक्टूबर महीने की मुद्रास्फीति के आंकड़े का इंतजार कर रहे थे। मुद्रास्फीति में उम्मीद से ज्यादा नरमी आने से शेयर बाजार में जोरदार तेजी आई। इससे संकेत मिलता है कि अमेरिका में मुद्रास्फीति अब और कम होगी तथा फेडरल रिजर्व भी मौद्रिक नीति पर अपना रुख नरम कर

रुपये में बड़ी उछाल

डॉलर के मुकाबले रुपये में शुक्रवार को जोरदार बढ़ोतरी हुई और उसने चार साल में एक दिन की सबसे बड़ी उछाल दर्ज की। शुक्रवार को रुपया 80.81 पर बंद हुआ जो एक दिन पहले के मुकाबले 100 पैसे मजबूत है। यह 21 सितंबर, 2022 के बाद सबसे मजबूत स्तर है। इस साल रुपये में अब तक 8 फीसदी की नरमी आ चुकी है।

'अमेरिका में मुद्रास्फीति के आंकड़े उम्मीद से बेहतर रहने से दुनिया भर के शेयर बाजारों में तेजी आई है। इससे आसन्न मंदी की आशंका में 60 से 40 फीसदी की कमी आई है। अमेरिका से लंबे समय बाद अच्छी खबर आई है जिसने निवेशकों का हौसला बढ़ाया है। विदेशी पोर्टफोलियो निवेशकों ने देसी शेयर बाजार में करीब 4,000 करोड़ रुपये के शेयर खरीदे। इस महीने विदेशी निवेशकों ने करीब 20,000 करोड़ रुपये की लिवाली की है। बीएसई आईटी सूचकांक में सबसे ज्यादा 3.7 फीसदी की तेजी दर्ज की गई।

भारत-अमेरिका का सहयोग पर जोर

वित्त मंत्री निर्मला सीतारमण और अमेरिका की वित्त मंत्री जेनेट येलन ने संयुक्त रूप से आज कहा कि यूरोप में युद्ध की वजह से ऊर्जा और खाद्य पदार्थों की कीमतों में बढ़ोतरी की वजह से दोनों देशों की सबसे बड़ी चुनौती मुद्रास्फीति है। दोनों ने वैश्विक बाधाओं और भू-राजनीतिक अनिश्चितता के मद्देनजर भारत और अमेरिका के बीच और सहयोग बढ़ाने की जरूरत बताई। येलन ने कहा, 'वर्तमान हालात में वैश्विक आर्थिक परिदृश्य बेहद चुनौतीपूर्ण है। ऊंची मुद्रास्फीति कई विकसित देशों और विकासशील देशों के समक्ष चुनौती खड़ी कर रही है और केंद्रीय बैंक इससे निपटने के लिए हरसंभव प्रयास कर रहे हैं।' उन्होंने कहा कि अमेरिका के लिए भारत महत्वपूर्ण भागीदार है और साझा वैश्विक प्राथमिकताओं को हासिल करने को लेकर अमेरिका जी-20 में भारत की अध्यक्षता का समर्थन करने के लिए उत्सुक है। येलन भारत-अमेरिका आर्थिक एवं वित्तीय साझेदारी मंच की 9वीं बैठक में शिकरत करने के लिए

भारत दौर पर है। उन्होंने सीतारमण के साथ उद्योग जगत के प्रमुखों से भी मुलाकात की। सीतारमण ने कहा, 'जहां तक भारत में मुद्रास्फीति की बात है तो यह मुख्य रूप से बाहरी कारकों की वजह से है। सबसे बड़ी चुनौती यह है कि भारत अपनी जरूरत का 85 फीसदी कच्चा तेल आयात करता है और वैश्विक बाजार में इसकी कीमतों में उतार चढ़ाव का असर भारत पर पड़ रहा है। इसलिए हम इस पर करीबी नजर रख रहे हैं।' संयुक्त बयान में कहा गया कि यूरोप में युद्ध और जिनसे पर इसके दाम का असर भी खाद्य पदार्थों की कीमतों पर पड़ रहा है। (शेष पृष्ठ 4 पर)

उद्योगों का उत्पादन 3.1 फीसदी बढ़ा

विनिर्माण, खनन और बिजली क्षेत्रों के बेहतर प्रदर्शन के कारण सितंबर में भारत का औद्योगिक उत्पादन पिछले साल की समान अवधि की तुलना में 3.1 फीसदी बढ़ा है। शुक्रवार को जारी आधिकारिक आंकड़ों में यह जानकारी दी गई। औद्योगिक उत्पादन सूचकांक (आईआईपी) सितंबर 2021 में 4.4 फीसदी बढ़ा था जबकि अगस्त 2022 में यह 0.7 फीसदी घट गया था। सांख्यिकी एवं कार्यक्रम कार्यान्वयन मंत्रालय द्वारा जारी आईआईपी आंकड़ों के अनुसार विनिर्माण क्षेत्र का उत्पादन सितंबर, 2022 में 1.8 प्रतिशत बढ़ा। एक साल पहले की इसी अवधि में यह आंकड़ा 4.3 प्रतिशत था। समीक्षाधीन अवधि में खनन उत्पादन 4.6 फीसदी और बिजली उत्पादन 11.6 फीसदी बढ़ा।

प्रत्यक्ष कर संग्रह 31 फीसदी बढ़ा

चालू वित्त वर्ष में अभी तक सकल प्रत्यक्ष कर संग्रह 31 फीसदी बढ़कर 10.54 लाख करोड़ रुपये रहा। वित्त मंत्रालय ने शुक्रवार को बताया कि व्यक्तिगत आयकर संग्रह बेहतर रहने से सकल प्रत्यक्ष कर संग्रह में इजाफा हुआ है। शुद्ध प्रत्यक्ष कर संग्रह 8.71 लाख करोड़ रुपये रहा, जो पूरे वित्त वर्ष के बजट लक्ष्य का 61.31 फीसदी है। चालू वित्त वर्ष में 1 अप्रैल से 10 नवंबर तक 1.83 लाख करोड़ रुपये के रिफंड जारी किए गए हैं। इस वित्त वर्ष में 10 नवंबर तक सकल प्रत्यक्ष कर संग्रह 10.54 लाख करोड़ रुपये रहा जो पिछले साल की समान अवधि के मुकाबले 39.69 फीसदी अधिक है। सकल कॉरपोरेट कर में 22.03 फीसदी और व्यक्तिगत आयकर संग्रह में 40.64 फीसदी की बढ़ोतरी हुई है।

जी-20 में डिजिटल पर रहेगा बल

केंद्र सरकार अगले साल यहां आयोजित होने वाले जी-20 शिखर सम्मेलन में वैश्विक डिजिटल सार्वजनिक साधनों पर केंद्रित एक अलग इकाई रखने की योजना बना रही है। बिजनेस स्टैंडर्ड को पता चला है कि इसके तहत अन्य देशों को इंडिया स्टैक की विशेषज्ञता एवं आर्किटेक्चर की पेशकश की जाएगी।

भारत द्वारा पेश की गई दो सबसे बड़ी डिजिटल सार्वजनिक साधनों में ओपन सोर्स आर्किटेक्चर ऑफ आधार और यूनिफाइड पेमेंट इंटरफेस (यूपीआई) शामिल हैं। सरकार देश भर में भुगतान, प्रत्यक्ष लाभ हस्तांतरण और कल्याणकारी योजनाओं के तहत हस्तांतरण में डिजिटलीकरण को बढ़ावा देने के बाद वैश्विक स्तर पर क्यूआर-आधारित सत्यापन एवं भुगतान सेवाओं का विस्तार करने की कोशिश कर रही है।

सूत्रों ने कहा कि जी-20 शिखर सम्मेलन के दौरान डिजिटल सार्वजनिक साधनों पर केंद्रित एक अलग इकाई होने से इंडिया स्टैक के प्रौद्योगिकी समाधान को लागू करने के फायदों के बारे में जागरूकता फैलाने में भी मदद मिलेगी। इंडिया स्टैक में सरकार समर्थित सेवाओं जैसे आधार, यूनिफाइड पेमेंट इंटरफेस (यूपीआई), ई-साइन, डिजिटल आदि के ओपन सोर्स सॉफ्टवेयर ऐप्लिकेशन प्रोग्रामिंग इंटरफेस (एपीआई) शामिल हैं। ओपन-सोर्स मॉडल ने बड़े पैमाने पर कंप्यूटर भाषाओं के अलावा आर्किटेक्चर, एपीआई,

और सस्ती है। इसने अफ्रीका, एशिया और दक्षिण अमेरिका के विकासशील देशों में काफी दिलचस्पी पैदा की है। ओपन नेटवर्क का उपयोग करने के पीछे विचार यह है कि डिजिटल परिवेश के सभी सदस्यों के लिए समान अवसर उपलब्ध कराए जा सकें। ऐसे में ऐप्लिकेशन डेवलपर इन्फ्रास्ट्रक्चर, मॉड्यूरिटी और ऐक्सिस के बारे में चिंता करने के बजाय बेहतर उपभोक्ता अनुभव और उत्पादों के निर्माण पर ध्यान केंद्रित कर सकते हैं।

अधिकारी ने कहा, 'कोई भी देश अपने यहां आईटी प्रणालियों की परिपक्वता स्तर और रुचि के आधार पर इंडिया स्टैक के विभिन्न तत्वों को अपना सकते हैं।' यह खबर ऐसे समय आई है जब कुछ ही दिन पहले वाशिंगटन में वित्त मंत्री निर्मला सीतारमण ने कहा था कि डिजिटल सार्वजनिक वस्तुओं और ऐप्लिकेशन प्रोग्रामिंग इंटरफेस के लिए भारत का ओपन-सोर्स नेटवर्क उन देशों के लिए उपलब्ध था जिन्हें इसकी आवश्यकता थी। सितंबर 2022 तक कुल मासिक यूपीआई लेनदेन की संख्या बढ़कर 7.30 अरब हो गई जिनका कुल मूल्य 12,11,582 करोड़ रुपये है।
