## Sub: Scrutinizer report for the Meeting of Unsecured Creditors of the Company

## Dear Sir,

I, Tapan Shah, Practicing Company Secretary, has been appointed by the Hon'ble National Company Law Tribunal, Ahmedabad Bench ('NCLT' or 'Tribunal'), by its Order dated 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 (the 'Order') to act as a Scrutinizer for the purpose of scrutinizing the votes cast by the Unsecured Creditors of S P S Processors Private Limited ('the Applicant Transferor Company') by remote e-voing process and through hallot paper at the venue of the meeting, in a fair and transparent mainer. In pursuance of the directions issued vide the said Order of NCLT and in terms of the Notice dated 9<sup>th</sup> June,2022 ('Notice') convening the meeting, a meeting of the Unsecured creditors was held on Thureday, July 21, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. at The ATMA Auditorium, Opp. Old Reserve Bank of India Building, Ashram Road, Ahmedabad 380009 in the state of Gujarat to consider and approve, if though appropriate, with or without modification, the proposed Scheme of Amalgamation of S P S Processors Private Limited ('Bodal' or the 'Transferee Company') with Bodal Chemicals Limited ('Bodal' or the 'Transferee Company') and their respective shareholders and creditors ('Scheme').

I do hereby submit my report with regards to the result of voting through remote e-voting process and voting through ballot paper during the Meeting in respect of unsecured creditors, as under:

 On the basis of the documents provided by the Company and affidavit filed with NCLT, the Company has completed dispatch of the Notice by email to unsecured creditors who had registered their email-IDs with the Company on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2022 and by courier to other Unsecured Creditors, between 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 to 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2022.





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- The Company has also placed the Notice of the meeting on the Website of the Company as well as website of the Stock Exchanges i.e. BSE Limited and National Stock Exchange of India Limited and E-voting Agency i.e. CDSL.
- 3. The Company has given the newspaper advertisement for the Notice convening the meeting in;
  - A. Indian Express Newspaper, Ahmedabad edition in the English language on 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2022
  - B. Sandesh Newspaper, Ahmedabad edition in the Guajarati language on 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2022
- 4. The Unsecured Creditors in the books of account of the Company as on the "Cut off" date, i.e. 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 were entitled to vote through remote e-voting and voting through ballot paper at the meeting, on the resolution as mentioned in the Notice of Meeting of the Company.
- In terms of the aforesaid Notice, remote E-voting was open from 9.00 a.m. on Monday, 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 to 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 and unsecured creditors were required to cast their votes electronically conveying their assent or Dissent in respect of the Resolution on remote e-voting platform provided by Central Depository Services Limited (CDSL).
- 6. As required in the Rules, I have unblocked the votes cast through remote e-voting on Thursday, the 21<sup>st</sup> Day of July, 2022 around 3.17 p.m. after the completion of physical meeting at the venue, as mentioned in the notice, in the presence of two witnesses, namely, Mr. Abhishek Thakur and Mr. Babulal Vagjela, who are not in employment of the Company.
- Thereafter, the details containing, inter-alia, list of unsecured creditors, who voted "For" and "Against", were download from the e-voting website of Central Depository Services limited (<u>www.evotingindia.com</u>).
- 8. Voting through ballot paper at the meeting, on the resolution as mentioned in the Notice of Meeting of the Company was considered after scrutinizing all the Ballot papers, received during the meeting.





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- Based on the data made available to me by the e-voting agency, viz CDSL engaged by the Company, no unsecured creditors, have casted their votes on the remote e-voting platform.
- 10. At the meeting, votes were cast by physical ballot papers, which were considered for deriving the results of the resolution. Total 18 unsecured creditors representing the value of debt at Rs. 157,62,92,635 have cast their votes through ballot papers. This amounted to 96.42 % of the total value of debt of the company i.e. Rs. 163,48,49,599/- as on the cut off date i.e. 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. The detailed analysis of the physical ballot papers results for the resolution as contained in the said Notice is attached herewith as an **Annexure A**.
- 11. The Attendance Register and authorization letters received, relevant records relating to electronic voting and physical ballot papers shall remain in my safe custody until the Chairman considers, approves and signs the Minutes of the aforesaid Meeting and thereafter the same will be handed over to the Company Secretary of the Company.
