Department of Agricultural Research and Education organizes G20 Technical Workshop on Climate Resilient Agriculture on 4th - 6th September 2023 in Hyderabad

The Department of Agricultural Research and Education (DARE), Ministry of Technical Education and Skill Development is organizing the G20 Technical Workshop on "Climate Resilient Agriculture" on 4-6 September 2023 in Hyderabad. The Workshop aims to bring together experts from around the world to discuss and highlight the challenges of Climate Change and would emphasize the cooperation and exchange of information to enhance the skills and competencies of countries in addressing challenges posed by climate change. The eminent speakers. The three-day event began today with the Inaugural Session which was graced by Minister of State for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Ms. Shobha Karandlaje. The first day focused on the "Climate Resilient Agriculture Research Needs and Innovations" wherein the eminent speakers shared their experiences in their respective countries to achieve resilient agriculture. They shall also list out scientific and innovative solutions that are required to address these emerging challenges to reduce the uncertainty in the agriculture food systems. The event is attended by dignitaries including foreign delegates from G20 member states, Guest-invited countries, and International Organizations (IOs). Senior Officials from the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Ms. Shobha Karandlaje mentioned that India is the most sensitive sector and is greatly influenced by climate change which is already happening in G20 Nations. She said that the impacts of climate change are already being experienced by all of us and hope that the recommendations emanating from this workshop will give direction towards attaining climate-resilient agriculture. Secretary DARE, and DG ICAR, Dr. Himanshu Pathak reiterated that agriculture in India is highly vulnerable to climate change and that in recent years, the frequency of climatic extremes has increased resulting in increased risks to agricultural production and food security all over the world, including India and elsewhere. He said that the efforts of ICAR are very significant in meeting the challenges of climate change. Additional Secretary & FA, DARE, Ms. Alka Nangia Ara opined that Climatic risk is manifested in terms of the incidence of droughts, floods, and high intra-season variability in rainfall. Conference on Transnational Grid Interconnections For One Sun, One World, One Grid held in New Delhi

In the recently concluded Energy Transitions Ministerial in Goa, all G-20 countries came together on the same page and declared the following in Para No. 5 of the ETWG Outcome Document and Chair Summary. "We also recognize the role of grid interconnections, resilient energy infrastructure and regional/cross-border power systems integration, where applicable, in enhancing energy security, fostering economic growth, and facilitating universal energy access for all, in affordable, reliable, and sustainable manner. In particular, we recognize that expanded and modernized electricity networks will be essential to scale up the deployment of zero and low emission technologies including renewables. This entails enhanced voluntary international cooperation in coordinated planning, mutually agreed information sharing, joint research and development, technical assistance, technology development and harmonization of regulatory frameworks for design, planning and system operations. In this regard, we take note of Presidency's initiative to connect different regional grids through renewable energy power. We call for increased public and private investments, noting the important role of International Finance Institutions including Multilateral Development Banks (MDBs) in supporting developing countries to exploit the full benefits of regional/cross-border interconnections, where deemed appropriate."

In the run-up to the 18th G20 Summit, a day-long conference on "Transnational Grid Interconnections for One Sun, One World, One Grid (OSOWOG)" was held in New Delhi, on 6th September, 2023. The conference was organized by Secretary, Ministry of India Limited (POWERGRID), a 'Maharatna' company under Ministry of Power, Govt. of India. Addressing the conference virtually, Union Minister for Power and New & Renewable Energy Shri R. K. Singh said that India has already established cross border interconnections with its neighbours and that strengthening of various cross border links is under process. "OSOWOG will enable all nations to reap the benefit of energy from the sun. This is very relevant to today's context particularly when we are transitioning to renewable energy. It will make round-the-clock renewable energy much cheaper. It will also reduce the need for fossil reserves. It will help bring down the cost of electricity for the general population and will help in energy transition." The Minister said that once the transnational grid interconnection happens, it will do away with dependence on a single source which is costlier and required for round-the-clock renewable energy. "Once we have OSOWOG, no one will ever have to go without electricity. This will unite the world and ensure energy security to the millions of people who do not have access. It is essential that all of us take this forward, I am
