## Business Updates





- Revenue from operations for the quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2023 amounting to Rs 67 cr represents net sales which includes gross sales amounting to Rs 247 cr and sales return amounting to Rs 180 cr for the period. The jewellery business always has a certain amount of sales returns. However, the disproportionately large amount of sale return in Q1 FY 2023-24 are a practical consequence of the court cases and adverse publicity being faced by the company. The company has raised this issue in various legal fora also and sought redressal of its grievances by filing counter claims against the SBI, Union Bank of India (and seven other banks) and Indian Bank to the tune of Rs 10,034 cr, Rs 16,759 cr and Rs 2,956 cr respectively before DRT-III, New Delhi.
- The company's domestic turnover has got reduced mainly on account of disruptions in its operations and consequent liquidity squeeze resulting from ongoing litigation between the company and its Lenders.
- The status of the Company's borrowing accounts continues to remain as non performing with all the banks. This classification by the banks is being contested by the company on account of being illegal and wrong.





- Currently SBI, Indian Bank and IDFC First Bank individually and Union Bank (along with 7 other banks) have moved the DRT, Delhi against the company towards recovery of their dues, which is being contested by the company.
- The majority of the Lenders have also issued notices to the Company under Section 13(2) of the SARFAESI Act 2002 and which are being replied to by the Company and there is no further development in this matter as on date.
- SBI has also approached NCLT Delhi against the Company.
- The Company, in addition to replying suitably to the Banks, has also approached the High Court of Delhi against the SBI stating that there is a non-compliance of the Principle of Natural Justice in as much as the company was not given any opportunity to explain its case after 02<sup>nd</sup> January 2023 and unilateral decision has been taken by the respondent (SBI). High Court of Delhi has accepted the Company's prayer and issued a notice to the respondent, which has been accepted by the learned counsel of the respondent.





- Further Company has also filed a counter claim against the SBI as well as UBI & others and Indian Bank in DRT Delhi seeking damages on account of loss in revenue, decline in market cap, loss of reputation, status and goodwill on account of unilateral action taken by it against the company.
- The company also filed a Commercial Civil Suit before Hon'ble District Judge (Commercial-03), New Delhi District, Patiala House, Delhi against SBI for *inter alia* incorrect classification of the company's account as NPA. The court found merit the case and vide its order dated 05.06.2023, restrained SBI from taking any further coercive action against the company related to classification of its account as NPA. The order was appealed by SBI in High Court. The court vide its order dated 31.07.2023, disposed off the appeal and remanded the matter to Ld. Trial Court below to rehear both the parties and pass a fresh order within 2 weeks giving reasons for granting status quo vide order dated 05.06.2023. After remand from Hon'ble Delhi High Court, matter was again heard by Ld. Trial court which has now been reserved for pronouncement of order.
- As on date, all the matters are sub-judice in various courts/Tribunals.





- Currently all the company showrooms are operational except three in Delhi which remain closed on account of ongoing DRAT orders.
- Though there is no certainty either on the time frame or the end result of this on going judicial process, the company continues to remain confident about a positive outcome of the same and is taking appropriate steps to ensure that its status as a going concern remains intact in spite of the current adversities.
- In addition to providing a suitable response in the legal fora, these steps also include offering of an OTS proposal to the Lenders. An earlier proposal submitted by the Company to its Lenders in Q1 was not found acceptable but the company is now working on offering an alternative proposal to the lenders.
- The Management also remains confident that it will be able to realize its assets and meets its liabilities and commitments in the normal course of business considering the net assets position of the Company irrespective of the final conclusion of decision in the ongoing legal process.
