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# Navy flies an aircraft to the rescue of Chinese fishermen

New Delhi, 18 May

In an unfolding drama in the stormy waters of the Indian Ocean, the Indian Navy has mobilised to the rescue of a Chinese fishing boat that has sunk in bad weather in the southern Indian Ocean. So far, despite the best efforts of multiple rescue agencies, none of the 39 crew members and fishermen on board have been sighted or rescued.

The Chinese fishing boat sank approximately 900 nautical miles (1,650 kilometres) from the Indian coast. That places it in the latitude of Diego Garcia and the Seychelles.

Given the long distance from the closest land, the Indian Navy has deployed its state-of-the-art Boeing P-8I Poseidon long range maritime reconnaissance aircraft, which have

## Australia, Sri Lanka also helping in search: China

China on Thursday said that alongside India, Australia, Sri Lanka, Indonesia, Maldives and the Philippines have extended emergency help to it in the search and rescue of the Chinese fishing vessel that sank in the Indian Ocean.

A spokesperson for the Australian Maritime Safety Authority told a Chinese news agency that based on drift modelling, a remote 12,000 square km zone has been identified to search for the vessel.

the endurance to reach the location of the incident.

"In a swift humanitarian action on May 17, Indian Navy deployed its air maritime reconnaissance assets in the

Southern Indian Ocean Region approximately 900 nautical miles (Nm) from India, in response to sinking of a Chinese fishing vessel Lu Peng Yuan Yu 028 with 39 crew onboard,"

stated the Indian Ministry of Defence (MoD) on Thursday.

"The crew includes nationals from China, Indonesia and Philippines. P-8I aircraft have carried out multiple

and extensive searches despite adverse weather and located multiple objects possibly belonging to the sunken vessel," stated the MoD.

The Indian Navy operates its fleet of 12 P-8I aircraft from the INS Rajali Naval Air Base, located at Arakkonam, near Chennai. From here, the P-8I aircraft are flying 900 nautical miles (Nm) to the scene of the incident, searching the area for four hours, and then flying back to the base.

However, naval sources say that the location and rescue of any fishermen has so far been prevented by severe weather conditions.

Responding to the incident, the Indian Navy said: "As an immediate response, search and rescue (SAR) equipment was deployed at the scene by the Indian aircraft on request of People's Liberation Army (Navy), or PLA(N) ships, closing in on the area."

"In a display of India's obligations as a credible and responsible partner for ensuring safety at sea, the Indian Navy units also coordinated SAR efforts with other units in the area and guided the PLA(N) warships transiting to the scene of the incident. The Indian Navy continues to remain deployed to provide all possible assistance to the ongoing SAR efforts," it added.

# GOVT PLANS TO SET UP 8 NEW CITIES TO EASE POPULATION BURDEN

A plan to develop eight new cities to alleviate population burden on the existing urban centres in the country is under consideration, a senior official said here on Thursday.

The 15th Finance Commission in one of its reports had recommended that new cities should be developed, said M B Singh, director of the G20 unit of the Union Housing and Urban Affairs Department.

Singh was speaking to PTI on the sidelines of a meeting of "Urban 20 (U20)".

"After the finance commission's recommendation, the states sent proposals to the Central Government for 26 new cities, and after a scrutiny, eight new cities are

being considered for development," he said.

The government will in due course announce locations for the new cities and their development timelines, he added.

"We have to build new cities in the country as the existing cities are not able to cater to the needs of citizens. Haphazard expansion on the outskirts of existing cities is affecting the basic planning of these cities," Singh said.

When a new city is developed, social and economic activities will increase within a radius of at least 200 km, he said.

Though the financial roadmap for setting up new cities has not been finalised, the Union government will play a major role in the project, he said.

# Sustainable fashion gets thrown a life jacket after PM wears upcycled sadri

## Karur-based EcoLine Clothing draws up expansion plans, goes global

Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi has been at the forefront of climate action and saving the environment campaigns — whether plogging at a beach in Mahabalipuram in 2019 or wearing a sky-blue 'sadri' jacket to Parliament made of material recycled from plastic bottles.

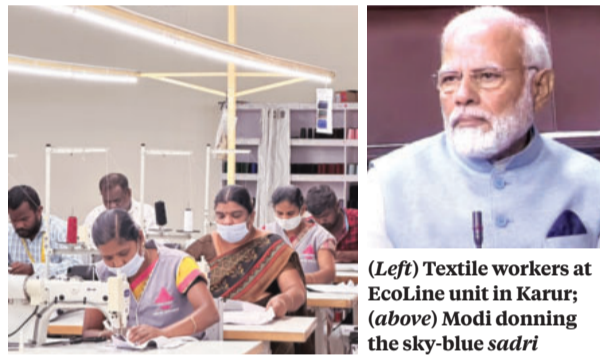
Made by Karur-based sustainable fashion brand EcoLine Clothing (EcoLine), a brand of Shree Renga Polymers, front

runner in polyethylene terephthalate (PET) bottle recycling and sustainable textiles in India run by IITians, the company recycles PET bottles and upcycles them into value-added products, such as garments.

Three months on, the phone lines of Senthil Sankar, managing partner at Shree Renga Polymers and EcoLine, have been ringing non-stop since the jacket made out of recycled plastic at Karur, Tamil Nadu's textile capital, was worn by the PM to Parliament on February 8.

Senthil says around 20-28 bottles were used to make the jacket that retails for ₹2,000, according to reports.

Shree Renga Polymers, the company that owns EcoLine, is all set to raise its capacity two-fold, from recycling 1.5 million

PET bottles per day to 4.5 million bottles per day.

Shree Renga Polymers is likely to invest ₹250 crore over the next five years, of which ₹100 crore will be towards the expansion of units; the remainder ₹150 crore will be for marketing blitz.

This is the first company in

India with end-to-end capabilities in the sector, starting from recycling and making yarn and fibre to value-added finished products.

"With the PM wearing our jacket, we are seeing a rapid rise in queries. We are getting queries from all the Group of Twenty countries, West Asia,

and Europe and are in the process of expanding our presence to these countries," says Sankar.

Because of a rise in queries after the PM's tacit endorsement, 10 per cent of which are getting translated into orders, the company is in the process of expanding its manufacturing footprint.

"At present, we are sourcing 1,000 tonnes per month and recycle nearly 1.5 million bottles every day. In some years, this will become 3,000 tonnes per month and 4.5 million bottles," he adds.

According to the industry benchmark, it requires an investment of ₹120 crore to create an entire ecosystem for 1,000 tonne per month of recycling.

"We are only available online. The company has warehouses in Delhi, Bengaluru,

Chennai, Dubai, and one in the US," says Sankar.

## From trash to treasure

As part of the procedure, bottles are gathered and sorted, and their caps and labels removed. They are then crushed, cleaned, and recycled in a 10-step process to clean the hot-wash flakes. These flakes are then heated and woven into polyester staple fibre. This fibre is spun into yarn. Yarn is knitted/woven into polyester fabric, and fabric becomes garment.

The company claims that 90 per cent of its products cost less than \$10 and it takes six bottles to create a T-shirt. Although Shree Renga Polymers started operations in 2008, EcoLine was launched only in 2020.

# Jindal Stainless Eyes 20% Volume Growth in FY24

Removal of export duty on steel items to also help, says MD Abhyuday Jindal

**Mumbai:** Jindal Stainless is looking to boost its sales volumes by 20% in 2023-24, aided by the company's participation in all major railways and metro infrastructure projects underway in the country, said its managing director Abhyuday Jindal.

"The government's removal of the export duty on steel products will also help the company expand sales, he said.

"The Centre had levied an export duty on most steel products recently last year to curb domestic inflation. The duty, which hurt the steel industry's export business, was later scrapped in November.

With this, the country's largest stainless steel player aims to increase its overall sales volume by 20% in this financial

year to about 2.2 million tonnes. "Anything that is being made in India and for India, and being made in India to export, we are a part of it," Jindal told ET in an interaction.

The company, which was a supplier for the recently inaugurated Mumbai Metro Lines, also has the Pune, Lucknow and the upcoming Mumbai

Metro lines in its pipeline. Volumes from this segment are currently 12-15% of the company's revenue, and the company expects it to increase to 17-18% of the total volume driven by the incremental demand.

Exports in the December quarter were 5% of its total sales, which rose to 15% in the March quarter. Jindal sees exports at 15-20% for 2023-24, with momentum picking up in the second half of the year.

"Our two focus areas are the US and the European Union, and they are still seeing some destocking, coming out of recession. We are looking at the Middle-East, South Korea, South America and Australia where we were not very active or aggressive so far, but now, we will be," said Jindal.

Apart from the railways, sectors such as infrastructure, process industries and energy are likely to be major demand drivers for stainless steel, according to the Jindal Stainless managing director. Creating a non-corrosive infrastructure, as it done in the developed countries, is also driving the demand for stainless steel, he said.

# Infibeam Looks to Raise Up to \$50m via Listing Step-down Arm

**New Delhi:** Infibeam Avenues, a fintech company, is looking to raise between \$25 million and \$50 million by listing its UAE-based step-down subsidiary Avenues World FZ LLC on the DAX Dubai and Dubai Financial Market (DFM), as per sources close to the development.

In 2011, Infibeam Avenues acquired UAE-based Avian International, an online digital payment processing company for (United Arab Emirates dirham or AED) 4.32 million. And since 2020, Avenues World FZ LLC, based in the UAE, has operated as a subsidiary of Avian International.

A source quoted above said Avian International may offer up to 25% of its equity stake in Av-



venues World FZ LLC through this dual listing arrangement. Avenues enables payment gateway infrastructure for a vast network of over 5,000 UAE merchants, processing annual transactions exceeding AED 12 billion.

According to another source, the company is presently engaged in the process of appointing merchant bankers and is in ad-

vanced discussions with various entities such as Safa Capital, Tell Group, HSBC, and Emirates NBD among others.

"The final selection of the merchant bankers is expected to be concluded shortly," N. Replying to ET questionnaire, Infibeam said, "Our UAE-based subsidiary Avian International, in the ordinary course of business, keeps exploring its options to make potential fundraise, for its expansion/business purposes, from time to time. It would be premature to comment on the same at this point in time."

In September 2022, Infibeam Avenues board of directors approved the consolidation of its international operations, involving a strategic restructuring that reorganised its fully-owned international subsidiaries.

**PW Told to Supply Engines: Aviation Min**

**NEW DELHI:** The government has told Pratt & Whitney (PW) to supply engines so that the grounded planes of Indian carriers are "up and running", aviation minister Jyotiraditya Scindia said on Thursday. "We can't have multiple planes of one engine manufacturer on the ground in India, which is the case today, unfortunately," Scindia told reporters after an event of industry body FICCI. Go First stopped operating flights from May 3 onwards, stating that almost half of its 54 aircraft fleet was grounded due to delay in engine supply from PW. — Our Bureau

**Gland Pharma Net Plunges 72% in Q4**

**MUMBAI:** Gland Pharma on Thursday reported 72% year-on-year (YoY) drop in net profit to ₹79 crore in Q4 FY23 due to production shutdown at one of its facilities in Telangana and soft demand. The company reported net profit of ₹285 crore in the same quarter of the previous year. Revenue from operations slumped 29% YoY in Q4 FY23 to ₹785 crore in Q4 FY22. The company said production line shut down in Q4 FY23 in Paschimlyam Penins facility due to line upgradation and reduced business from domestic B2C division along with other off-take in rest of the world (ROW) market due to tender seasonality affected its revenues. — Our Bureau

**United Spirits Profit Drops 42% in Mar Qtr**

**NEW DELHI:** Diageo-controlled liquor maker United Spirits on Thursday reported a 42.4% decline in its consolidated net profit to ₹102.8 crore for the fourth quarter ended March 2023. The company had posted a net profit of ₹178.6 crore a year ago. United Spirits said in a filing, its revenue from operations fell 25.4% to ₹5,791.6 crore. Its margin was down "primarily driven by the gross margin contraction, higher A&P partly offset by a one-off credit on account of reversal of indirect tax provisions," said USL.
