Murder case: MP cites mom's health, skips CBI questioning

HIGH drama unfolded on Friday, the day Kadapa MP YS Avinash Reddy was scheduled to appear before the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) for questioning in the YS Vivekananda murder case. However, Avinash Reddy informed the agency that his mother had been admitted to a hospital in Pulivendula, reportedly suffering from a heart stroke, and he needed to attend to her immediately. Shortly before his planned appearance, Avinash Reddy's lawyers submitted a formal request to the CBI, explaining his absence due to his mother's ill-

ness. Meanwhile, the CBI officials decided to follow the MP's convoy, leading to speculation about whether the agency intended to arrest Avinash Reddy during his journey. Agency sources revealed that the officials attempted to contact the MP and requested him to halt his vehicle. However, Avinash Reddy expressed his desire to visit his mother first before appearing before the CBI. En route to Pulivendula, Avinash Reddy received information from doctors that his mother was being transferred to Hyderabad. Spotting the ambulance along the way, the MP changed vehicles and accompanied his ailing



Man kills father over second marriage, held

A 22-year-old man was arrested after he allegedly killed his father at Periyakottai village in Sivaganga in the late hours of Thursday. Sources said the deceased, Adaikalam (45) was having an extra marital affair when he was working in Tiruppur district few years ago. "He married her after abandoning his family and brought her to Periyakottai. His son, Murugesan, used to fight with him everyday. After a scuffle broke out on Thursday, Murugesan smashed his father's head with a stone. Adaikalam died at the spot. The body has been sent for postmortem," added sources.

CM Stalin inaugurates 16 new substations worth ₹2,003 cr

Chennai: Chief Minister MK Stalin inaugurated 16 new electricity substations and 67 upgraded transformers at a cost of ₹2,003 crore through video conference in Chennai on Friday. According to a release issued by the public relation department, these facilities are introduced considering the power demand in the state and supplying power round the clock to people. A couple of 400kV substations in Chennai and Thoothukudi, 110kV substations in Ariyarur, Chengalpattu, Krishnagiri, Madurai, the Nilgiris, Salem, Tiruvallur and 33/11kV substations were built, the release added. Kerala govt gives clean chit to AI-camera project

T'Puram: A government probe into the AI-camera project for traffic enforcement has given a clean chit to Keltron, a public sector unit that acted as a project management consultant. The report by former industries secretary A P M Muhammed Hanish made it clear that the allegations related to the project were baseless, said Industries Minister P Rajeev. "Keltron gave the tender in a transparent manner by following the guidelines of the Central Vigilance Commission. HE had also held the post of RG of Madras High Court. K Rajasekar, enrolled in 1998, practised civil, criminal and constitutional law before being selected for judicial service. He had served as principal district judge in Tirunelveli and member-secretary of Tamil Nadu State Legal Services Authority. During his stint as Registrar, IT-cum-Statistics, he had rendered commendable service in the modernisation of judiciary and establishing e-courts.

While proposing Sathivel's name, the Collegium resolution said opinion of consultee judges in the Supreme Court indicates that the judicial officer is fit and suitable for appointment as judge of the HC. Additionally, the collegium while recommending K Rajasekar's name has said that his name should be notified after the appointment of Mr Ramaswamy Neelakandan. The Collegium resolution said, "Shri Neelakandan who is a member of the Bar has been recommended earlier in point

of time must be appointed before Shri Rajasekar is appointed. Otherwise, Shri Rajasekar, would rank senior to Shri Neelakandan. Such a deviation in seniority would be unfair and against settled convention." Although the SC in the same resolution expressed concern over failure by the centre to clear names recommended earlier and urged it to take necessary steps for issuing notification for names proposed earlier, including that of advocate R John Sathyan, the centre had still not notified his name.

Two booked under POCSO Act in Kovai

According to police, a 31-year-old man groomed a 17-year-old girl who was living with her grandmother and sexually assaulted her after marrying her. The incident came to light when the girl became pregnant and was admitted in a government hospital. Doctors after inquiring with her informed Thudiyallur All women police on Thursday. The suspect was booked and search is on for him. In the second incident, parents of a 16-year-old girl lodged a complaint in Pollachi All-Women Police Station stating that the girl was missing on Wednesday. After preliminary investigation, police found that a 26-year-old man allegedly kidnapped her on the pretext of marrying her. Further investigation is on.

Rajiv Gandhi case convict acquitted in 2020 Vellore jail case

THE Vellore district judicial arbitration court acquitted two persons, including Murugan, one of the convicts in Rajiv Gandhi assassination case, in a case related to obstructing a woman guard at the Vellore central jail from performing her duties. Murugan, who had been in jail for over 30 years in connection with the assassination case, was released on November 12, 2022, following a Supreme Court direction. However, being a Sri Lankan national and owing to cases pending against him, Murugan was detained at the special camp in Tiruchy. The central prisons department meanwhile filed a complaint with the Bagayam police against Murugan and another inmate, Gabriel, for allegedly hindering a woman guard from performing her duty during inspection at their cell in Vellore central jail in 2020. Murugan had represented himself in the case and the verdict was pronounced on Friday. Amid tight security, He was brought to the Vellore judicial magistrate court from the special camp. Judge Roshkala acquitted Murugan and Gabriel of the charges. Murugan was later sent back to the camp.

CM: Civic officials to monitor day-to-day progress of desilting works by contractors

PRATIPACHARYA MUMBAI, MAY 19

AFTER INSPECTING the monsoon preparedness of the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) in the western suburbs, Chief Minister Eknath Shinde Friday said that a monitoring team of civic body officials will be deployed at the ground level who will track the day-to-day progress of the pre-monsoon desilting works that is being carried out by contractors.

Every year, as a precautionary move to minimise water-logging in the city, the civic body removes silt from all the major and minor drains, rivers and water-bodies in Mumbai, to allow free-flow of water during the heavy rains.

Shinde also said that an online dashboard will be created through which, citizens will be able to lodge complaints related to incomplete desilting of drains and rivers in Mumbai.

"In the past many years we have seen the BMC making claims of overachieving its target of pre-monsoon desilting works, even after this, there were waterlogging. This clearly shows that there is a lack of accountability. Therefore, I have asked the municipal commissioner to appoint a team of civic officials who will monitor the desilting works and not take the figures given out by the contractors on their face value. If the team finds that the work is not being carried out as per standards then they should penalise the contractors," said Shinde while addressing reporters.

"The deadline of completing

the desilting works is on May 31 and by this time BMC will open a helpline number through which citizens will be able to register complaints if they find that the drains and waterbodies in their locality are not desilted properly. The administration will have a time till June 10 to act on the complaint and failing to which officers responsible for not executing the works will be penalised," he said.

Shinde also said that the state government will felicitate officers if there is no significant flooding and water-logging during monsoon in Mumbai.

"The process of keeping Mumbai flood free is ongoing and we are hopeful that we will be fully ready to mitigate flooding during the rains, unlike previous years when there used to be serious waterlogging even after a 50 mm spell of rains," Shinde said.

The CM along with senior civic officials carried out a two day long inspection of the drains and rivers of Mumbai.

On Friday, Shinde visited the chronic flooding areas in western suburbs including the Khar subway and Oshiwara, following which he took stock of the river rejuvenation works in Dahisar, Oshiwara and Poisar.

According to BMC's data, 90 per cent of the pre-monsoon desilting work has been achieved in the eastern suburbs, followed by 89 per cent in western suburbs and 75 per cent each in island city and Mithi River.

The civic body's data states that 93 per cent of the minor drains have been desilted so far and it is pertinent to note that Mumbai has an overall 2,200 KM labyrinth network of drains.

ANTOP HILL POLICE STATION

Probe ordered after police assault two advocates

A DEPARTMENTAL inquiry has been initiated against senior police inspector Nasir Kulkarni and other police personnel posted at Antop Hill police station for allegedly beating up two lawyers inside the police station premises.

This comes a fortnight after three policemen from Samta Nagar police station were suspended for allegedly assaulting two doctors with a belt and extracting Rs 25,000 from them.

The incident took place on Thursday evening after one of the two lawyers identified as Sadana Yadav reported an incident at the Mumbai police control room.

Her colleague lawyer Harikesh Sharma said, "We have our office at Wadala (east) and there are two persons in the locality who would close the door after she would go to the common washroom. As she was tired of the mischief, she initially contacted the administrator of the

locality but as he refused to help, Yadav then dialed Mumbai police control room and lodged a complaint.

"Following her complaint to the control room, a team from Antop Hill police station went to the spot after which Yadav and two alleged miscreants were taken to the police station. Sharma, who was also at



the spot at the time, also went to the police station separately.

"We tried explaining our grievances to them but the station house officer was not ready to lodge a complaint," said Sharma, adding, "We were then taken inside the cabin of senior police inspector Nasir Kulkarni after which there was some argument there

and subsequently some lady constables pulled Yadav outside the cabin and dragged her inside a neighbouring room where she was brutally assaulted."

Sharma was also taken to another room, where he was beaten by the policemen at Antop Hill police station.

"Senior police inspector Kulkarni has also assaulted them. Belt was used to assault both of them and Yadav is admitted in Sion hospital as her leg fractured in the assault," said Ravi Jadhav, president of All India Federation of Advocates and Associations.

When contacted Deputy Commissioner of Police Pravin Munde (zone IV) said, "We have initiated an inquiry into the matter and are trying to ascertain the facts of the incident."

In March this year an inquiry was ordered against Assistant Police Inspector Hemant Gite following allegations that he slapped a lawyer at Borivali Metropolitan Magistrate Court. The incident had led to protests from lawyers.

MMRDA scouting firm to develop recreational ground along Mithi

SWEETY ADIMULAM MUMBAI, MAY 19

THE MUMBAI Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) is looking to hire a private entity to develop recreational ground and other allied activities along the Mithi River bank in Bandra Kurla Complex (BKC).

As per the proposed plan, MMRDA is looking for an agency which can work on Design Build Finance Operate and Transfer

(DBFOT) basis. The scope of work includes development of recreational ground (RG) with allied facilities including club house, public garden, sports facilities and helipad along Mithi River in G Block of BKC.

The agency has earmarked a total plot area of 1,08,546.51 square ft for this purpose. The selected agency is obligated to provide access to the general public to the open to sky garden.

The MMRDA has proposed the development along the Mithi river

in BKC in lieu of an annual revenue sharing model. The selected agency will have to pay MMRDA Rs 5 crore annually with Rs 25 lakh increment on five yearly basis.

As per the MMRDA, the construction period will be three years from date of signing of contract. The licence period for the agency will be valid for 30 years and plus 30 years extended licence period.

The selected agency can earn revenue by imposing entry fee to the garden, hosting of sports events, rental income from ban-

quet lawn like parties, social gathering and events, clubhouse membership, helipad services, rental income from rooms/suites, sports facility, gym, auditorium, restaurants.

Apart from the licence fee thale agency will also have to give club membership to the five persons per year nominated by the MMRDA. Also, all the facilities developed will be allowed to be used by MMRDA for hosting/organizing its official functions at 50% of normal rates.

Gokhale bridge will be partially opened by end of Oct, says CM

PRATIPACHARYA MUMBAI, MAY 19

CHIEF MINISTER Eknath Shinde, who inspected the ongoing construction works of the Gopal Krishna Gokhale Bridge on Friday, said that the bridge will be opened partially by October-end.

The Gokhale Bridge was shut for pedestrian and vehicular movement last November, owing to its poor structural condition. Following which dismantling works were taken up by the railways since the bridge passed above the railway tracks.

The BMC had floated a tender for reconstructing the bridge last December and initially it had aimed to open one arm of this bridge by end of May. However, owing to a shortage of steel supply from Jindal and Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) plants, the deadline was pushed.

"Today I took stock of the situation, I spoke with the DRM of western railways and I will monitor the steel supply as well. Therefore, I can assure that vehicular movement on the bridge could be started by October end this year," said Shinde.

Andheri legislator Ameet Satam, however, maintained that while one arm of this bridge will be opened by end of October, the entire bridge will be fully operational by May 2024.

"Total requirement of steel for railway portion is around 2,600 MT out of which 750 MT has been received and 1,200 MT will be received by the end of this month. Remaining steel will be received by July. Following this, fabrication works will be taken up and the work of completing one arm of this bridge has been set till end of October. The work on opening the second lane will be started in November and will be completed by May 2024," said Satam.

Civic officials, however, said that the BMC will try to open the bridge by end of December.

Meanwhile, local residents said that any postponement will cause serious traffic woes.

"Postponement of second arm to May 2024 is very disheartening and is a cause of worry as this will cause more hardships for residents who hoped for year end deadline," said Dhaval Shah from Lokhandwala Oshiwara Citizen's Association (LOCA).
