**'We need a British Trump'**

Former British prime minister Elizabeth Truss on Saturday pitched for bringing the "best of reforms", fixing some arrangement in the "powerful bureaucracy" in the United Kingdom and creating a movement akin to the one in the US that led to "big changes" there.

"Frankly, I think we need a British Trump. The question is who that individual might be," she said and cited US President-elect Donald Trump's "MAGA" (Make America Great Again) movement.

**More areas in severe category**

Delhi's air quality worsened further on Saturday, with many areas in the "severe" category, even as authorities intensified their action by imposing penalties of around Rs 5.85 crore on the first day of anti-pollution measures under the third stage of Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP). The city's 24-hour Air Quality Index (AQI), recorded at 4 pm daily, stood at 417, making it the worst in the country. On Friday, the AQI level was 396.

**Foreign cos need nod for survey**

The Kerala High Court has held that if any foreign organisation wants to conduct a survey in India, permission from the central government is necessary. The ruling from the High Court came while disposing of a plea seeking quashing of criminal proceedings against an Indian company for conducting a survey in Thiruvananthapuram in 2010, which according to the police was aimed at "injuring the emotional feelings of the Muslim community".

**Expired fire extinguisher; faulty alarm system, a recipe for tragedy**

**Govt dismisses claims of expired fire extinguishers**

A fire at the Special Newborn Care Unit (SNCU) of Maharani Laxmi Bai Medical College in Jhansi claimed the lives of 10 newborns on Friday night, exposing significant lapses in fire safety measures as Uttar Pradesh government has ordered probe into the incident.

The incident occurred while 55 newborns were being treated in the ward. Although 45 infants were rescued, 10 succumbed to severe burns and asphyxiation.

Initial investigations revealed that expired fire extinguishers and non-functional fire alarms severely hampered the rescue operations. Some extinguishers had not been refilled since 2019, making them non-operational for

years, while others had exceeded their service life. Many others had exceeded their service life by one to two years. Instead of being functional safety tools, these extinguishers were mere decorative relics, rendering them useless in containing the fire.

Deputy Chief Minister Brajesh Pathak refuted these claims saying hospital's fire safety systems were last inspected in February 2024, followed by a mock drill in June. Further compounding

the tragedy was the failure of the fire alarms installed in the SNCU. Witnesses reported no alarm sounding when the fire broke out, delaying immediate evacuation efforts. By the time smoke engulfed the ward, panic and confusion had spread, making rescue efforts more challenging.

"If the fire alarm had sounded in time, this would have alerted people around that place," eyewitness said.

The fire reportedly began due to sparking in an oxygen

concentrator, causing flames to spread rapidly through the ward. Staff and firefighters struggled to gain access to the infants as the blaze blocked the main entry point. Rescuers eventually broke windows to reach the babies. Most of those rescued were from the external unit of the SNCU, while those in the inner unit suffered the most severe injuries.

Deputy Chief Minister Brajesh Pathak who visited the hospital on Saturday morning expressed sorrow over the tragedy, describing it as a deeply unfortunate incident. He commended the efforts of the ward staff, who worked alongside family members to rescue the babies, but dismissed allegations of negligence.

Pathak stated that the hospital's fire safety systems were last inspected in February 2024, with a mock drill conducted in June. However, critics have questioned the efficacy of these measures, pointing to the failure of critical safety equipment during the emergency.

**Gandhi siblings mourn fire deaths**

The Gandhi siblings, Rahul Gandhi and Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, on Saturday mourned the death of a large number of newborn children in a fire at the Jhansi Medical College. Rahul also questioned why so many tragic incidents continue to happen in Uttar Pradesh and claimed that these

"raise questions about the negligence of the government and the administration". In a statement on "X", Rahul, who is also the Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha, said, he was "deeply saddened by the news of the death and injury of several newborn children in the tragic accident at Jhansi Medical College."

**'B'deshi infiltrators marrying tribals due to state's nod'**

Ahead of the second phase of Jharkhand assembly election, union home minister Amit Shah on Saturday accused chief minister Hemant Soren of allowing Bangladeshi infiltrators to marry tribals.

Addressing an election rally in Dumka, Shah alleged that Hemant was responsible for declining tribal population as he was allowing infiltrators to enter Jharkhand and marry tribal women. He also asserted that infiltrators were snatching tribal land and his party would not allow it if it came to power in the state. He also referred to the Jharkhand government challenging the order of the High Court in which it was directed to identify illegal Bangladeshi immigrants residing in the Santhal Pargana region of the state in the Supreme Court. The Supreme Court has allowed the state government not to appoint expert members to the independent fact-finding committee till December 3 for identifying Bangladeshi infiltrators.

Union home minister claimed that Hemant was trying to provide reservations to Muslims through backdoors with the support from Congress. "I warn that BJP will not allow any such plans of Hemant and Rahul Gandhi to succeed," he added.

Speaking at another rally in Madhupur in Deoghar district, Shah said that Jharkhand had reached its 50 percent reservation cap and if Muslims had to be given reservations, it had to be cut down from the reservation quotas of SCs, STs and OBCs.

"I assure you that till the time we (BJP) have one MP, we will not let Muslims have any reservation," he remarked.

BJP leaders contended that the ongoing assembly election was not to elect an MLA or a party but to bring a BJP by ousting Hemant from power. "This election is to form the future of Jharkhand's women, youth and backward castes," he asserted.

Targeting Rahul, Shah claimed, "Rahul baba makes promises one after another, but after making promises he flies abroad. Contrary to it, Prime Minister Narendra Modi's promise is like one etched on stone (patthar ki lakeer). He fulfills what he promises. BJP fulfils its guarantees and only we can shape Jharkhand. Congress, JMM and RJD can never work in the interest of the state

**Badal quits as SAD chief**

Sukhbir Badal on Saturday resigned as president of the Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) to pave the way for the election of the party's new president; The elections for the said post are due next month

Founded in 1920, the SAD is the country's second oldest political party after Congress. Prior to Sukhbir, his father Parkash Singh Badal, an 11-time MLA and five-term chief minister, remained party's chief for 12 years. Sukhbir was SAD chief since 2008 and it was under his

leadership that the party had formed government for two terms in a row in 2012, though the party was on a constant slide losing all the subsequent polls and has just three legislators in the House of 117 members in the Punjab assembly as on today.

Akal Takht - the supreme temporal seat of the Sikhs - had also declared Sukhbir Bada "tankhaiya" (guilty of religious misconduct) on August 30, 2024, and barred him from contesting elections for the alleged "mistakes" committed by his party and government during its rule from 2007 to 2017.

**'INDIA will form govt in J'khand'**

With less than a week left when it would be decided who will form the government in Jharkhand, Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge on Saturday asserted that the INDIA alliance would be voted back to power in the state.

Earlier, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had claimed that the NDA would form a government in Jharkhand with more seats than at any time in history.

While speaking in Ranchi, Congress president claimed, "Polling for 43 Assembly constituencies in Jharkhand has

already concluded, and it is clearly evident that the INDIA alliance will form the government again."

Targeting PM Narendra Modi, he said that Modi was not working for the people's welfare but to save his chair. "PM Modi does not work for the poor, but for himself," he alleged. He claimed that rising inflation and soaring prices of essential commodities were evidence of PM Modi's failure to address public concerns.

Kharge said Modi would never condemn the BJP's controversial "batenge to katenge" slogan, which he claimed was

designed to polarise voters. He also accused the Centre of blocking crucial legislation, such as a bill passed by the Hemant Soren government in Jharkhand to increase reservations for SC/ST/OBCs. "After spending about 25 years in power, whether Modi could manage to eradicate poverty in Gujarat?" he asked.

Addressing a rally at Khijri in Jharkhand, he said, "The tribal society fought the British, will you be afraid of Modi-Shah? The posts of PM and HM are not just for giving speeches or scaring people. They are for working."

**BJP: Muslim orgns trying to impact electoral atmosphere in Maha, J'khand**

The Bharatiya Janata Party on Saturday accused some Muslim organizations of openly issuing appeals to voters to influence the outcome of the Assembly elections in Maharashtra and Jharkhand.

Addressing a press conference at the party headquarters, BJP spokesperson Gaurav Bhatia charged that many of these organisations have appealed to or directed the Muslim voters to back the INDIA bloc candidates in the elections. Maharashtra is due to vote in a single phase on November 20 while Jharkhand has already voted in the first phase and would also be voting in the second and final phase on the same day.

Bhatia charged that All India Muslim Personal Law Board member Maulana Sajjad Nomani had openly urged voters of the community to support the Maha Vikas Ag-

hadi (MVA) and other non-BJP parties in Maharashtra. He said this was the outcome of the "appeasement politics" of the bloc.

Termining the Maulana's actions as "vote jihad", Bhatia insisted that such practices go against established democratic principles. Stating that they also corrupt the election process, he said the calls from such minority groups also put a question mark on the priorities of the INDIA bloc when it comes to national security.

Over the last week, the BJP has repeatedly questioned the calls for support from various Muslim organisations to the MVA in Maharashtra and the INDIA bloc parties in Jharkhand.

It had also accused the of conspiring with "conservative and divisive elements" for getting the votes of the Muslim community. Senior party leader Ravi Shankar Prasad had earlier charged that this was a conspiracy to "break the country".

**BJP leader Varier joins Congress**

In a blow for the BJP, disident senior party leader Sandeep Varier joined the Congress Saturday, marking the culmination of his growing disenchantment with the saffron party.

After joining Congress in the presence of KPCC chief K Sudhakaran, Opposition leader VD Satheesan and other senior leaders, Varier said that BJP has only hatred in them.

"I am happy that I came out of a factory that generates hatred," he said and now "I have stepped into the shop of love."

The move comes as a setback to the BJP, particularly amid the crucial Palakkad bye-election campaign. Sources close to the development said Varier's decision was preceded by two weeks of intensive discussions with Congress leadership.

**MUDA Scam: Lokayukta interim report gives clean chit to Sidda**

Mysuru Lokayukta police probing the allotment of alternative plots scam by Mysore Urban Development Authority (MUDA) has given clean chit to Chief Minister Siddaramaiah while pointing at serious lapses by officials.

An interim report was submitted by investigating officer and Superintendent of Police (SP) TJ Udesht to Lokayukta Inspector General of Police (IGP) Dr A Subramaneswara Rao.

Siddaramaiah is number one accused in the case, while his wife BM Parvathi is accused number two, her brother Mallikharjun Swamy is three and Devaraj who had sold land to Swamy is accused number four.

In the report, it is said that there is no evidence against the CM's role in allotment of alternative plots to his wife BM Paravathi by MUDA in lieu of 3.16 acres of agricultural land acquired by the latter.

**Prosecution Permission**

Meanwhile, the State government on Saturday sanctioned permission to prosecute former MUDA commissioner DB Natesh, a senior Karnataka Administrative Service (KAS).

The Lokayukta Mysuru police had applied for prosecution permission for Natesh and another former MUDA commis-

sioner Dinesh Kumar about three weeks back. They had sought permission under Section 17A (permission to investigate a public servant) of the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988.

On Saturday, Chief Secretary Shalini Rajaneesh granted permission to prosecute Natesh while that of Dinesh Kumar is still pending before her.

It is said that Parvathi's brother Mallikharjun Swamy purchased the land from Devaraju. Devraju had acquired this 3.16 acres of land from his brother who in turn inherited it from his father. The report also points out that the MUDA officials have done conversion of land without verification when Swamy applied for land use change.

**Bride, groom among 7 killed in road mishap**

In a tragic accident in Bijnor, Uttar Pradesh, seven people, including a newlywed bride and groom, lost their lives early Friday morning while returning from Jharkhand after their marriage. The incident occurred at 2 am on National Highway-74 near Dhampur.

The family, who had arrived by train at Moradabad station, was travelling to Dhampur in an auto-rickshaw when a car rammed into their vehicle from behind. The impact caused the auto to overturn and fall into a roadside ditch.

The groom's house was just five kilometers from the accident site. According to Bijnor Superintendent of Police Abhishek, the crash was likely caused by dense fog, which re-

duced visibility on the highway.

The groom's brother, recounting the sequence of events, revealed that the marriage had taken place on November 13. The family boarded a train on the evening of November 14 to return home, but a six-hour delay in the train's schedule forced them to travel late at night.

"Our father had a friend in Jharkhand, whose daughter was getting married. This connection brought the families together," the groom's brother said. He also shared that their father worked in a press, while the groom and another brother earned their livelihood hawking goods in Delhi.

The accident has cast a pall of grief over the family and the local community, as they mourn the loss of lives in what should have been a joyous occasion.

**Centre mum on relief funds for Wayanad**

Even after three months, there is no sign of any disaster relief funds coming in from the Centre for the victims of the Wayanad landslide.

The Centre has also decided against categorizing the disaster under the L3 category (a nearly catastrophic situation that overwhelmed the state and district authorities) that would have allowed more funds for the victims of the tragedy.

The Centre has said that "under the existing guidelines of SDRF/NDRF, there is no provision to declare any calamity as a national disaster."

This goes against the promises made by Prime Minister Narendra Modi soon after the

massive landslide that the Centre would go all out to help the victims regain their lives.

The LDF and the UDF have declared a bandh on Tuesday in protest against the Centre's 'indifference' towards the people of Wayanad.

IUML general secretary P K Kunhalikutty said Kerala was missing from the BJP's map, and hence, BJP too should also have no place in Kerala's map.

Accusing the BJP of adopting a hostile attitude towards Kerala, Kunhalikutty said despite people's resilience in overcoming the disaster, the Union government provided no assistance and betrayed the people.

"The Centre betrayed the people of Wayanad, instead of

standing with them. The people of Kerala, including those in Palakkad (where a bypoll will be held on November 20), will not forget it," Kunhalikutty said.

Leader of Opposition V D Satheesan said the neglect shown by the Centre towards the disaster-affected people of Wayanad reflected its disregard for Kerala.

"Despite the Prime Minister's visit and the central team's assessment, the decision to not allocate even a single rupee to Kerala is shocking."

"UDF MPs from Kerala will strongly protest against this injustice in the Parliament," Satheesan said, adding that the UDF will escalate the issue at the state and national levels.
