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TMC to move Prez office for Bengal Gov's recall

Days after Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee accused Bengal Governor Jagdeep Dhanekar to Jain Hawala scandal, the Trinamool Congress on Thursday brought additional charges against him saying his name had also figured in Punjab land scam which made it mandatory for the Centre to remove him from the top constitutional post that he was in at present.

Continuing its all-out offensive against Dhanekar the TMC leadership said that the party would soon prepare a list of charges against him and move the presidential office seeking his removal from Bengal.

"The name of the Governor is now not only limited to Jain Hawala diary in which there is the mention of one Dhanekar ... but also there are reports of the same name being involved in the Punjab land scam," TMC MP Sukhendu Shekhar Roy said asking "why the Governor who has been so vocal about con-



cocted stories is currently silently on these issues."

The TMC MP said that the party would soon take the issue up with the President of India. "We will approach the President of India with the case and seek his removal ... Bengal does not want a tainted Governor," Roy said adding that the party would also explore other parliamentary options to seek his removal if bringing up the matter to the notice of the President did not yield results.

"If a representation to the President fails then we will take up appropriate procedural measures in Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha to get his removal," the TMC leader said alleging the Governor had always tried to harass the State Government

and refused to cooperate with it saying "he tries to stall all the decisions taken by the Cabinet ... he always tries to block the Bills passed by a democratically elected House ... He does so because he has no regards for democracy."

Roy also referred to Dhanekar's family photographs featuring one of the security personnel of Debanjan Deb the arrested fake vaccine kingpin asking "what is this man doing in the Governor's family circles ... has this man been the mediator between vaccine scamster and the Raj Bhavan?"

Deb was arrested a few days ago for running a fake vaccine racket through which he had managed to "vaccinate" about 2,000 people at various fake camps. In most of the cases he used antibiotics in the name of corona vaccine.

The BJP promptly hit back saying the same fake vaccine kingpin had been photographed with a number of TMC top bosses including ministers and Kolkata Corporation administrators.

GULSHAN KUMAR MURDER CASE

Bombay HC upholds conviction of Dawood aide Abdul Rauf

The Bombay High Court on Thursday upheld the life imprisonment awarded to Abdul Rauf Merchant, an aide of gangster Dawood Ibrahim, by a lower court for the sensational murder of music baron and T-Series owner Gulshan Kumar, while it dismissed an appeal challenging the acquittal of TIPS company co-founder Ramesh Taurani in the same case.

Allowing partly the appeal challenging Rauf Merchant's appeal, a HC division bench comprising Justices Sadhana Jadhav and N. R. Borkar said that Merchant was convicted for offences committed under section 302 (murder) read with section 34 and 120 B (conspir-

acy) of the IPC and section 27 of the Indian Arms Act, while he was acquitted of the offences punishable under 307 (attempt to murder), 397 and 398 (robbery or dacoity with attempt to cause death or grievous hurt).

Holding that he was entitled to the set off for the period already undergone during the pendency of the trial, the HC bench ordered the cancelled Rauf Merchant's bail bonds.

The judges ordered Rauf Merchant to surrender forthwith before the Sessions Court or before D.N. Nagar Police Station and also surrender his passport to the police. They said that if he did not surrender within a week, the sessions court would issue a non-bailable warrant against him and

take him into custody.

Apart from confirming the conviction of Rauf Merchant for Gulshan Kumar's murder, the HC confirmed punishment for offence under section 120 B (conspiracy) of the IPC. "The assailants had no personal animosity or grudge against the deceased Gulshan Kumar. They had committed the ghastly act as they were hired by Nadeem Saifee and Abu Salem who wanted to satisfy their personal vendetta against the deceased. Unwarranted acquittals would not only give wrong signals to the society but would pose a threat to law and order.

Therefore, the Accused no 16/ Respondent No. 2 (Rauf Merchant) also deserves to be convicted for the offence punishable under section 120B of

the IPC," the HC bench observed in its ruling.

In the case of Ramesh Taurani, the HC bench ruled: "The Appeal challenging the acquittal of the Respondent No.1 Ramesh Sadhuram Taurani vide Judgment and Order dated April 29, 2002 by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gr. Mumbai in Sessions is hereby dismissed".

Holding that the acquittal of Taurani in the lower court called for no interference, the HC bench observed: "In the present case, there are serious lapses in the investigation and there is no cogent and convincing evidence to hold that Respondent No. 1 (Taurani) had spoken to Abu Salem in Dubai. There is no investigation to verify as to whether that

phone number was used by Abu Salem at that time. Abu Salem was an absconding Accused since 1993 serial bomb blast. The HC bench noted that "The only witness who has deposed about the involvement of Taurani was prosecution witness Arif Lakadawala. The evidence of Laddkawala would show that he was also present when Respondent No. 1 had contacted Abu Salem when they met at Juhu. The application seeking arraignment of Lakadawala as an accused had been rejected with the aid of section 132 of the Indian Evidence Act. The said order of rejection was not challenged and has attained finality.

In view of this, the acquittal of the Taurani calls for no interference."

Kerala's West Asian dreams come to an end, bleak future for Gulf returnees

Close on the heels of the announcement by the State's leading business house that it was pulling out of the Memorandum of Understanding signed with the Government of Kerala to set up industrial units which would have created more than 35,000 jobs, a more shocking disclosure has been made by the department in charge of expatriates.

More than 1.5 million Keralaites have returned to their home state from West Asian countries following Covid-19 and large scale retrenchment and localization since March 2020, according to Salin Mankuzhi, spokesman of Non Resident Keralaites Association, a joint venture service by Government of Kerala and major entrepreneurs from the State who have made it in West Asia. The NORKA is also into manpower placement services in various countries abroad.

The army of unemployed people in the State has shot past the 6 million mark with the influx of people from Gulf countries who lost their livelihoods. "Kerala is in for major crisis and the State and Central Governments should initiate

moves to address this burning issue," said Attakkoya Pallikkandi, one of the early Keralaites who settled in Dubai and returned to his roots after nearly five decades.

He said the budget proposals by the State Government for the year 2021 to 2022 is silent about any moves to rehabilitate and resettle the Gulf returnees whose remittances had sustained the development process of Kerala.

Attakkoya had reached Dubai in early 1970 and worked there for more than four decades as a journalist. "When I reached Dubai for the first time, a four storied building was the tallest structure in that Kingdom. There were no state-of-the-art roads in the oil kingdom. Though Dubai and other emirates made giant strides in the succeeding years, all has come to a stop and job opportunities have dried up," he told *The Pioneer*.

The post-retirement days of Attakkoya are busy helping hundreds of Gulf returnees from Kozhikode, Kannur and Kasaragod districts to relaunch a new life in Kerala. "These returnees sent all their income to their houses and now they are left in the lurch without any source of income," said Attakkoya.

Live-in partner kills Bengal girl in U'khand

A girl from Andal in West Burdwan district of Bengal who was working at Dehradun was allegedly pushed to death from the mountains by her live-in partner, her family members complained.

Seeking justice for the girl Nandita Mukherjee (name changed) her sister Antara said that her sister was living in with a man called A Chowdhury who belonged to Sahranpur in Uttar Pradesh.

Chowdhury who was subsequently arrested by the Uttarakhand Police allegedly pushed his partner from the hills and then burnt her body before faking a story for her sudden disappearance. He told her mother at Andal that she had left him in a huff and was not traceable.

The family was kept in a mist of concocted stories for more than month before finally he conceded over telephone that the victim had leapt to her death from the roof of her building. The man had been arrested, the family members said. "We have no wherewithal to regularly go to Uttarakhand to fight the case ... but we want justice for our sister ... we want this man to be hanged," the victim's sister said.

Situation continues to be grave in Kerala

KOCHI: Kerala continues to be in a grave state as there has been no let up in the enormity of the transmission of Covid-19. The State diagnosed 12,868 new cases of Covid-19 on Thursday while the average Test Positivity Rate was 10.3 per cent. But there were nearly 100 regions in the State which are under triple lock down because of high TPR.

Kerala leads the table of the States that diagnose high daily positive cases. A release issued by the health department said the State recorded 124 deaths on Thursday due to Covid.

The day began with a controversy over the exclusion of thousands from the list of beneficiaries who are eligible for compensation declared by the

Centre for Covid-19 patients who succumbed to the pandemic. Leader of Opposition V D Satheesan alleged that the Kerala Government was openly violating the norms prescribed by the Indian Council of Medical Research for considering the Covid-19 victims for cash compensation to be awarded by the Centre.

The State's death toll, as per Government figures, was 13,359. "But this is a fake figure as thousands of patients have succumbed to the pandemic. The LDF Government is trying to cover up and suppress the number of casualties to deceive the people about the poor medical facilities in the State," said Satheesan while speaking to reporters.

Koo says it 'proactively moderated' 54K posts in June

Koo has proactively moderated 54,235 content pieces even as 5,502 posts were reported by its users during June.

In its monthly compliance report, Koo said its report for June 2021 shows that of the 5,502 Kooos (posts) reported by its user community, 22.7 per cent (1,253) were removed, while 'other action' was taken against the rest (4,249 Kooos). Similarly, Koo took steps to proactively moderate 54,235 Kooos, of which 2.2 per cent (1,996) were removed, while 'other action' was taken against the rest (52,239). 'Other action' includes overlay, blur, ignore, warning etc on Kooos that do not comply with the guidelines.

Centre launches special drive to bring more farmers under PM crop cover scheme

In a major farmer outreach, the Government on Thursday launched a special drive to enrol more cultivators under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY). A week-long drive, starting July 1, will cover all notified areas under the kharif 2021 season with special focus on 75 aspirational districts where crop insurance penetration is low.

PMFBY, launched on January 13, 2016, aims to provide a comprehensive risk solution to farmers at the lowest uniform premium across the country. Launching the special drive, Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar said so far 29.16 crore farmers have insured their crops under the PMFBY.

More than ₹95,000 crore worth of claims have been pro-

vided to farmers since the launch of the scheme, against the total premium of ₹17,000 crore paid by them, he said. However, there is a need to expand the scheme in the country so that the crop insurance coverage can be increased and more farmers get benefits, an official statement quoted the minister as saying.

Tomar also urged state governments and other stakeholders such as banks and insurance companies to work together and reach out to the farmers in these identified 75 aspirational districts. He also urged the farmers to come forward and enjoy the benefits of crop insurance and become self-sufficient in times of crisis. The minister flagged off Information Education Communication (IEC) mobile vans to engage with farmers on PMFBY during the week-long drive.

Always be action-oriented: Amit Shah to IPS officers

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Thursday urged the new batch of IPS officers to be vigilant and always be action oriented rather than inaction or extreme action. Addressing young IPS officers of 72nd batch, the Home Minister said dialogue and sensitivity are necessary to improve the image of police and every police personnel has to sensitized and there should be increased communication and public contact.

He advised that young SPs should go to Tehsils and villages to meet people and stay overnight to understand the problems of common man in general. He also advised the young officers to stay away from publicity and make up mind to overcome fear of transfers.

Interacting with the young police officers, Shah said that a system is very important for any organization. He said that any organization runs successfully only when those who run it become a part of the system and work to strengthen it. By improving the system of the organization, the organization automatically improves and gives better results.

The Home Minister also said that making the organization system-centred is the key to success. Shah said that the seed should be planted in training itself to remove the problems, so that a person can be made more and more responsible and dutiful. He said that training works to mold the personality, way of working and the whole personality and if training is done properly, then it brings good results throughout life.

Union Minister of State for Home Nityanand Rai, Union Home Secretary AK Bhalla, were also present on the virtual interaction with young IPS officers. Shah said there are allegations of no action and extreme action against the police. He said the police should avoid these and move towards just action. He said just action means natural action and police should understand the law and do the right thing.

On improving the image of the police, Shah said only policemen will have to work for improving their image. The Home Minister said "communication and sensitivity" is necessary to improve the image of the police that is why there is a need to sensitize all policepersons as well as increase communication and public contact.

Maha deaths rise to 252

The number of daily Covid-19 deaths climbed to 252 and the infections dipped marginally to 9,195 in Maharashtra on Thursday, even as 8,694 patients were discharged after fully recovery from various hospitals in the State.

A day after the state logged 141 deaths and 9,771 infections, the daily deaths went up by 111, while the infections dropped by 576.

Significantly enough, for the first time in two months, no "old and unaccounted" deaths are not being reported for the past three days. As a result, there was no reconciliation of the death figures.

With 141 deaths, the Covid-19 toll in the State jumped from 1,21,804 to 1,21,945. Similarly, with 9,771 fresh infections, the total infections in the state climbed from 60,51,633 to 60,61,404.

recovery rate in the state dropped from 96.02 per cent to 96.01 per cent. The total "active cases" in the state rose 1,16,364 to 1,16,667. The fatality rate in the State stood static at 2.01 per cent.

Mumbai recorded 21 deaths and 656 infections. As a result, the Covid-19 toll in the metropolis increased from 15,451 to 15,472, while the infected cases in Mumbai went up from 7,22,222 to 7,22,878.

Pune with 17,086 active cases emerged as the first in the state in terms of maximum number of "active cases" in the state, while Thane with 16,105 stood second, followed by Mumbai (12,605), Kolhapur (12,495), Sangli (10,382), Satara (7,650), Ratnagiri (5,478), Raigad (5,191) and Sindhudurg (4,457).

Of the 4,18,75,217 samples sent to various laboratories across the state so far, 60,70,599 have tested positive (14.5 per cent) for Covid-19 until Thursday.

Currently, 6,15,285 people are in home quarantine while 4,339 people are in institutional quarantine.

GRP rescues 40 children being taken to Punjab

Acting on a tip-off about children being trafficked from West Bengal on a Punjab-bound train, officers and personnel of the Government Railway Police (GRP) raided a compartment of Karmabhoomi Express train and rescued 40 children in Moradabad railway station on Thursday morning.

All children were below 15 years of age and were deboarded from the train which originates from Jalpaiguri in West Bengal.

While it was suspected that the children were being trafficked, GRP Inspector Sudheer Kumar said that the children were travelling with relatives but investigations were underway to establish the human trafficking angle with complicity of the relatives for to any reason.

The GRP officers also contacted their counterparts in West Bengal to verify the antecedent of the relatives as well as of the children and confirm whether they were being taken to far off Punjab, as claimed by the kin, to work in hotels, restaurants, shops, dhabas etc or for some other illegal work.
