

One in four trains could run on 'direct' supply from solar panels

New Delhi, The direct supply of solar energy to Indian Railway lines -- without the need to connect via the grid -- would save almost seven million tons of carbon a year whilst also powering at least one in four train on the national network on competitive terms, a new study by Delhi-based Climate Trends and UK-based green tech start-up Riding Sunbeams said on Wednesday.

According to the Indian Railways 2019/2020 annual report, there was passenger traffic of over 8bn in that period, which would mean that 2bn passengers could be travelling on trains directly powered by solar energy.

Prime Minister Modi recently announced that the electrification of railways in India is progressing fast, and that the target is for the Rail-

ways to be a net-zero carbon emitter by 2030. A mix of electrification, energy efficiency and a switch to renewable energy will be needed to enable this goal.



of this new solar capacity -- up to 5,272 MW -- could be fed directly into the Railway's overhead lines instead of being procured over the electricity networks, reducing energy losses and saving money for the rail operator.

The researchers found that substituting energy supplied from the coal-dominated grid for private-wire supply from solar could

also rapidly cut emissions by as much as 6.8 million tons CO2 each year -- just over the entire annual emissions of Kanpur.

Report co-author and Director at Climate Trends Aarti Khosla told IANS, "Indian Railways plays an important role in the lives of every Indian. Not only is it the most practical mode of transportation, it is also the most famous and the largest employer in the country."

Plans are already underway to deliver 20GW of solar generation to match growing demand for energy to move trains.

Pandemic affect: Wage bill of small Cos falls up to 5% on salary, job cuts in Q1

The pandemic guided economic disruptions are pushing companies to become leaner and meaner as a survival strategy to counter falling revenues.

A large number of companies with a turnover of up to Rs 500 crore have reduced their employee expenses between 1-5 per cent in the April-June quarter of the current financial year. The expenses have fallen on account wage and job cuts as companies, particularly smaller ones, continue to face shrinking businesses with Q1 revenue falling up to 14 per cent.

According to SBI Ecwrap analysis of results of more than 3,700 listed entities, reduction in employee cost up to 5 per cent has been seen in companies with turnover of up to Rs 50 crore. These are the companies that have also seen their Q1 FY22 revenue falling by 13.6 per cent.

The cut in employee expenses reduced as the size of the companies in-

crease. Accordingly, companies with turnover of Rs 50-100 crore have seen their employees' expenses falling by 1.3 per cent, between Rs 100-500 crore the fall is about 1 per cent.

Conversely, larger companies with turnover of over Rs 500 crore, the employee expenses have actually risen by 2-3 per cent in Q1FY22 as compared to Q4FY21 even though they have taken a bigger hit of over 13 per cent in their April-June quarter revenues.

"The pandemic has impacted smaller companies the most who are resorting to survival strategies by cutting their cost and employee expenses to remain operational. For larger entities, manpower retention seems to be the strategy and economic recovery brings with it the hope that businesses

would grow and cement would pick up," said an economist with four big audit firms asking not to be named. On an overall basis, the Ecwrap study suggests that these have seen an overall around 9 per cent decrease in revenue and around 2 per cent growth in employee cost has been reported in Q1FY22 as compared to previous quarter i.e. Q4FY21. With GDP growing at 20.1 per cent in Q1, fresh hopes have emerged for the accelerated recovery of the economy. If this stands true and the country is able to overcome any new wave of the pandemic without much disruptions, the corporate sector could hope to recoup their falling revenue and start moving on the path of higher top line and bottom line.

Motor TP insurance: Administered price, long term cover vs deregulated price

Chennai, The Indian general insurance industry is divided on the aspect of long term versus one year motor third party risk cover and its pricing mode.

However, they are unanimous in their view that the third party insurance should be under them and not with the central government or administered as a pool.

Vehicle insurance policies are two parts -- own damage (insurance for the vehicle against damage, theft) and third party liability (liability for third parties). The third party insurance cover is mandatory whereas the insurance cover for vehicle damage is not mandatory. The premium is fixed by Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI).

The general insurer's role in designing the risk cover, promoting it, and fixing the premium is almost zero. "I am for the deregulation of the third party premium rates. The premium rate is not administered one in major countries," Varun

Dua, Managing Director and CEO, Acko General Insurance Limited, told IANS.

Like him, many CEO when asked by IANS agree for deregulation of premium rates but strangely that is not happening. Even after two decades after liberalisation of the sector citing various reasons including reduction in premium, insurers seem to want the price to be administered with yearly upward revision and not as per their claims experience.

Nearly 40 per cent of the general insurance business is from the motor insurance vertical and a major portion of that from third party risk cover, insurers are not enthusiastic about any changes resulting in lower premium and investment income. Contrary to the claims made by the general insurers that they are incurring huge losses under the motor portfolio, the numbers as per the Insurance Information Bureau of India.
