Dear Madam/ Sir,

We have to inform you that SEBI vide order bearing number WTM/GM/CFD/96/2018-19 dated 28/02/2019 in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 19 read with Section 11(1) and Section 11(2)(h) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India Act, 1992 ("SEBI Act") and Regulation 11(5) of the Takeover Regulations, granted exemption to the unincorporated consortium of four (4) ports viz., Visakhapatnam Port Trust, Paradip Port Trust, Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust and Deendayal Port Trust (collectively "Purchasers"), from complying with the requirements of Regulations 3 and 4 of the Takeover Regulations with respect to the acquisition/exercise of voting rights in respect of the Target Company, viz. Dredging Corporation of India Limited from President of India ("Seller")acting through Ministry of Shipping.

# I STRATEGIC SALE BY GOVERNMENT OF INDIA – SIGNING OF SHARE PURCHASE AGREEMENT.

2. In relation to the above, the Share Purchase Agreement ("SPA") dated March 8, 2019 has been executed by the **Seller** and the **Purchasers** pursuant to which 2,05,72,013 (Two Crores Five Lakhs Seventy Two Thousand and Thirteen) equity shares of the Dredging Corporation of India Limited ("DCIL"), representing 73.47% (Seventy Three point Four Seven percent) of the total paid-up share capital of DCIL held in the name of the **Seller** have been transferred along with transfer of Control to the **Purchasers** resulting in change of the Promoters.
