Opinion

- 1. We have (a) audited the financial results for the year ended 31st March, 2024 and (b) reviewed the financial results for the quarter ended 31st March,2024(refer "Other Matters" section below), which were subject to limited review by us, both included in the accompanying "statement of financial results for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2024" of KAKATIYA TEXTILES LIMITED("the company") being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations")
- 2. In our opinion and to the best of information and according to the explanations given to us, the financial results for the year ended 31st March 2024

3. We consider quantitative materiality and quantitative factors in (i) planning the scope of our audit work and in evaluating the results of our work; and (ii) to evaluate the effect of any identified misstatements in the Annual Financial Results.
- 9. We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit. We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.

10.
