Pak Minister: Families of Af Taliban reside in Pak

Islamabad: In a rare admission, a top Pakistani Minister has said that the families of Afghanistan's Taliban militants reside in Pakistan, including in popular suburban areas of the national capital, and sometimes the members of the insurgent outfit receive medical treatment in local hospitals.

Islamabad has been consistently rejecting allegations levelled by Afghan leaders that the Taliban use Pakistani soil to direct and sustain insurgent activities in Afghanistan.

In an interview aired by private Pakistani TV channel Geo News on Sunday, Interior Minister Sheikh Rashid Ahmed

said, "Taliban families live here in Pakistan — in areas like Rawat, Loi Ber, Bara Kahu and Tarnol."

The areas mentioned by the minister are well-known suburban areas of Islamabad. "Sometimes their (fighters) dead bodies arrive and sometimes they come here to hospitals to get medical treatment," Rashid told the Urdu-language network.

Pakistan is often accused of hosting and supporting the Afghan Taliban militants who have been fighting the Afghanistan Government for about the last two decades. It is rare for a top Pakistani minister and senior politician to accept it.

In the same interview, Rashid said that former military dictator Pervez Musharraf believed in the efficacy of drone attacks to target rebels in areas which were inaccessible to Pakistani forces.

The Taliban has intensified attacks against Afghan government forces since May 1 when the US-led international forces formally began their withdrawal from the country.

Last week, Prime Minister Imran Khan ruled out hosting American bases in Pakistan for military action inside Afghanistan, fearing it might lead to his country being "targeted in revenge attacks" by terrorists.

US airstrikes target Iran-backed militias in Syria, Iraq

Washington: The US military, under the direction of President Joe Biden, carried out airstrikes against what it said were "facilities used by Iran-backed militia groups" near the border between Iraq and Syria, drawing condemnation from Iraq's military and calls for revenge by the militias.

"The United States took necessary, appropriate, and deliberate action designed to limit the risk of escalation — but also to send a clear and unambiguous deterrent message," Kirby said.

The Pentagon said the facilities were used by Iran-backed militia factions, including Kata'ib Hezbollah and Kata'ib Sayyid al-Shuhada.

Secretary of State Antony Blinken, speaking to reporters in Rome on Monday, said Biden has been clear that the US will act to protect American personnel.

Iran: No decision on camera deal with UN nuclear inspectors

Tehran: Iran has not made a decision yet about whether to extend an agreement with the UN atomic watchdog over access to surveillance footage at its nuclear sites, the country's foreign ministry said Monday.

The remarks by Foreign Ministry spokesman Saeed Khatibzadeh come after a three-month deal between Tehran and international nuclear inspectors to preserve video data at the country's atomic installations expired last week, following a one-month extension.

Iran began limiting the access of U.N. atomic watchdog inspectors to its nuclear sites earlier this year, part of a pressure campaign on the West over its tattered 2015 nuclear deal with world powers.

Russia, China declare friendship treaty extension, hail ties

Moscow: The leaders of Russia and China on Monday hailed increasingly close ties between their countries and announced the extension of a 20-year-old friendship treaty, a show of unity amid their tensions with the West.

Speaking in a video call with Chinese President Xi Jinping, Russian President Vladimir Putin said that the treaty signed in July 2001 in Moscow helped take relations between Moscow and Beijing to an "unprecedented height" and would be extended for another five years.

The Russian leader noted that the coordination of foreign policy efforts by Russia and China has played a "stabilizing role in global affairs."

Xi in his opening remarks emphasized the importance of a "strategic cooperation" between Moscow and Beijing in defending their common interests on the global stage. He added that Russia and China have worked to uphold a "true multilateralism and global justice."

Putin and Xi have developed strong personal ties to bolster a "strategic partnership" between the two former Communist rivals as they vie with the West for influence and face soaring tensions in rela-

tions with the U.S. and its allies.

While Moscow and Beijing in the past rejected the possibility of forging a military alliance, Putin said last fall that such a prospect can't be ruled out entirely.

During Monday's call, Putin congratulated Xi on the 100th anniversary of the Communist Party of China celebrated Thursday, saying that China is marking it with "new achievements in the country's social-economic development and on the international stage" and recalling Soviet support for the Chinese communists.

Germany's Merkel defends idea of summit between EU & Putin

Berlin: German Chancellor Angela Merkel on Monday defended the idea of holding a European Union meeting with Russian President Vladimir Putin, arguing that it would offer an opportunity to confront Putin with European concerns.

The idea was rejected last week by eastern EU members. At a summit on Friday, EU leaders agreed only to "explore formats and conditionalities of dialogue with Russia."

There was no mention of any high-level meetings or plans for a summit with Putin, an idea that Germany and France had

pushed. The outcome reflected deep divisions in the 27-nation EU's approach to Moscow.

The EU is concerned that Putin is turning increasingly authoritarian and wants to distance himself from the West. Both it and the NATO military alliance are struggling to bring Russia back to the table.

U.S. President Joe Biden's meeting with Putin this month was a rare exception. "The concern was that we perhaps wouldn't be able to put up a united front, (and) such a summit of course requires very intensive preparation," Merkel said at a question-and-answer session with German and French lawmakers.

She said it would allow Europeans to "address all the questions that weigh on us and also those on which we want to cooperate."

Media: NKoreans heartbroken over Kim's emaciated looks

Seoul: Heartbroken North Koreans have been worrying tearfully about leader Kim Jong Un's "emaciated looks," state media quoted a local resident as saying, in a rare acknowledgement of foreign speculation about his weight loss.

The comments were seen as an effort to boost domestic support for Kim's efforts as he grapples with deepening economic hardships caused by the Covid, mismanagement, U.N. economic sanctions and natural disasters, experts said.

"Our people's hearts ached most when we saw (Kim's) emaciated looks," North Korean state TV cited the unidentified male resident wearing a straw hat as saying on Friday. "Everyone says their tears are welling up in their eyes naturally."

In recent state media photos, Kim has appeared to have lost a considerable amount of weight. Some North Korea watchers said Kim, who is about 170 centimeters (5 feet, 8 inches) tall and has previously weighed 140 kilograms (308 pounds), may have lost 10-20 kilograms (22-44 pounds).

Kim's health is the focus of keen outside attention as the 37-year-old leader hasn't publicly anointed a successor who would take charge of North Korea's advancing nuclear arsenal targeting the US and its allies if he is incapacitated.

Pak says 5,000 TTP militants present in Afghan; Kabul denies

Islamabad: Pakistan on Monday claimed that more than 5,000 militants of the Tehreek-i-Taliban Pakistan (TTP) were present in Afghanistan, a day after Kabul denied the presence of the banned terror outfit in the war-torn country.

"The assertions of the Afghan side are contrary to facts on ground and various reports of the UN, which also corroborate the presence and activities of over 5,000-strong TTP in Afghanistan," Pakistan Foreign Office spokesperson Zahid Hafeez Chaudri said.

He made the remarks in response to the media queries about the Afghan Foreign Ministry statement, which said that the TTP "is neither founded in Afghanistan nor operates on our soil."

"This movement along with other terrorist groups is recognised as the enemy of peace, stability, and prosperity in Afghanistan and the region, and the Afghan government fights against this terrorist outfit like any other terrorist group without discrimination," the Afghan Foreign Ministry said on Sunday.

Afghanistan has "consistently stressed upon implementation of UNSC resolutions and Doha agreement which calls on Taliban to cut ties with regional and international terrorist groups including the Tehrik-i-Taliban Pakistan (TTP), Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT), The Islamic Movement of Uzbekistan (IMU), The East Turkistan Islamic Movement (ETIM), Al-Qaeda and ISIS," it said.
