Opinion

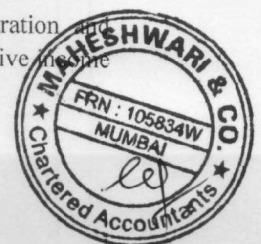
Basis for Opinion

We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements under the provisions of the Act and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence obtained by us is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Management's Responsibilities for the Standalone Financial Results

The statement has been prepared on the basis of the annual financial statements.

The Company's Management and the Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of statement that gives a true and fair view of the net profit and other comprehensive income



and other financial information in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Act and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations.

This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the standalone annual financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the statement, the Management and the Board of Directors are responsible for assessing the Company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

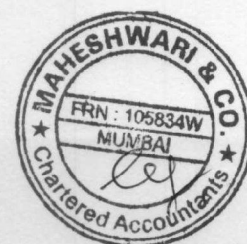
The Board of Directors is responsible for overseeing the Company's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Results

Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these statement.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional scepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the statement, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.

If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial results or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Company to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the statement including the disclosures, and whether the Statement represents the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

The s statement includes the results for the quarter ended 31 March 2022 being the balancing figure between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended March 31, 2022 and the published unaudited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the current financial year which were subject to limited review by us as required under the listing Regulations.

The statement also includes the results for the quarter ended March 2021 being the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of full financial year and the unaudited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the previous financial year which have been prepared solely based on the information compiled by the management and has not been subject to review by us.

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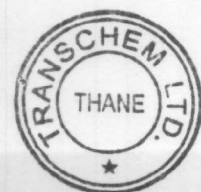

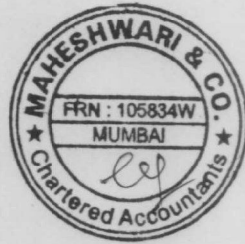

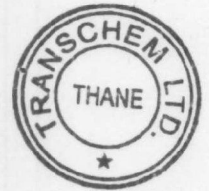
- 1 The audited financial results of Transchem Limited ("the Company") for the quarter and year ended 31 March 2022 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and thereafter approved and taken on record by the Board of Directors in their meeting held on 21 May 2022.
- 2 During the year ended 31 March 2022 and year ended 31 March 2021, the Company does not have revenue from operations and hence for the purpose of disclosure of segment information, the Company does not have a business segment. Further, the Company operates in India and accordingly no disclosures are required under secondary segment reporting.
- 3 The Audited Financial Results of the Company have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable Indian Accounting Standards ("Ind-AS") as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act 2013, as amended, read with relevant rules thereunder and in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015, as amended and SEBI Circular No.CIR/CFD/CMD 1/44/2019 dated March 29, 2019.
- 4 During the quarter ended 30 June 2020, the Company had sold out its undertaking known as "Mushroom Plant" consisting of pieces and parcels of lands or ground bearing Gat nos. 379, 382, 380, 381, 384, 416 (part), 433, 434, 435, 438, 436 (part), and 383 of Village Bebadohal and Gat no. 579 (part) of Village Urse, Taluka Maval, District Pune 410 506, together with its land, structures, machinery and fixtures therein and accordingly the Company had recognised the gain on sale of the said area of Mushroom Plant during the said quarter.
- 5 The above results of the Company has been audited by the statutory auditors and they have issued an unqualified audit opinion on the same.
- 6 The figures for the quarter ended 31 March 2022 and 31 March 2021 mentioned in the above financial results are the balancing figures between the audited figures for the whole financial year(s) and the year to date unaudited figures published up to the third quarter of the said financial years.
- 7 The previous periods numbers have been regrouped/ rearranged wherever necessary to confirm the current period presentation.
