Sub: Intimation under SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015

This is inform you that GMR Megawide Consortium had submitted an unsolicited proposal for decongestion and comprehensive capacity enhancement at Ninoy Aquino International Airport, Manila, Philippines to the Manila International Airport Authority and Department of Transportation on March 1, 2018.

In a letter dated July 15, 2020, the Manila International Airport Authority (MIAA) - the project implementing agency has granted the GMR Megawide Consortium (comprising of Megawide Construction Corporation 60% and GMR Group 40%), the Original Proponent Status (OPS) for developing the Ninoy Aquino International Airport.

As per the applicable Build Operate Transfer (BOT) Law, the next steps prior to potentially awarding the project include NEDA Board Approval, Negotiations and Swiss Challenge.

About the Consortium

GMR MEGAWIDE brings significant experience in turning around high-volume capital city airports as well as operating and transforming a major airport in the Philippines, Mactan-Cebu International Airport (MCIA).

The consortium took over operations in November 1, 2014. Since then MCIA has won a number of international awards, most notably the Asia Pacific Regional Airport of the Year from the CAPA Center for Aviation in 2016.
