Users not accepting privacy terms to face limited functionality: WhatsApp

WhatsApp will not delete any account for not accepting its new privacy update, but users not agreeing to the controversial terms after "several weeks" will not be able to access their chat list, and eventually, will not be able to answer incoming phone or video calls over the app.

Last week, the Facebook-owned firm had said users not accepting its privacy policy update by its May 15 deadline will not face deletion or lose functionality of their accounts on the said date.



WhatsApp, on its website, said it is continuing to remind those who haven't had the chance to review and accept the terms, and after a period of several weeks, "the reminder (that) people receive will eventually become persistent".

It, however, did not divulge the timelines set for these reminders.

Explaining the course of action after 'persistent' reminders are sent to users, WhatsApp said: "At that time, you'll encounter limited functionality on WhatsApp until you accept the updates." "This will not happen to all users at the same time. You won't be able to access your chat list, but you can still answer incoming phone and video calls. If you have notifications enabled, you can tap on them to read or respond to a message or call back a missed phone or video call," it said.

The messaging platform said after a few weeks of limited functionality, users, who still won't

accept the terms, "won't be able to receive incoming calls or notifications and WhatsApp will stop sending messages and calls to your phone". WhatsApp said it won't delete the users' accounts if they haven't accepted the update but highlighted that its existing policy related to inactive users will apply.

While the company did not respond to specific queries around these reminders, how long they will run and other modalities, a WhatsApp spokesperson said: "We'll continue to provide reminders to those users within WhatsApp in the weeks to come".

In a first, diesel price in Delhi crosses ₹82 a litre

RETAIL PRICE OF diesel in Delhi crossed the ₹82/litre mark for the first time in history on Monday, after state-run oil-marketing companies (OMCs) raised product prices to revive their marketing margins amid rising global crude oil rates. Diesel was sold at ₹82.06/litre on Monday, surpassing the previous all-time high rate of ₹81.73/litre discovered last Friday. Petrol prices in the national capital also reached its record high on Monday, priced at ₹91.53/litre.

Auto fuel prices were seen to rise after the assembly elections as OMCs aim to improve their marketing margins. Analysts at

Credit Suisse had said at the end of April that OMCs need to increase retail prices for diesel by ₹2.8-3/litre and gasoline (petrol) by ₹5.5/litre to maintain their FY20 margins. Diesel in Delhi was priced at ₹80.73/litre and petrol at ₹90.40/litre from April 15 to May 3. The marketing margin of around ₹3 per litre for diesel in Q4FY21 is the lowest encountered by OMCs in the last nine quarters.

Legislative assembly elections were scheduled between March 27 and April 29 in Assam, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and West Bengal. "As in past instances, we expect OMCs to recoup the lost margins post elections if crude remains at current levels," analysts at Jef-

eries had said mid-April, adding that "inadequate price hikes due to elections could weigh on BPLC's privatisation".

From the start of January, diesel price has increased 11% to the current level, while the cost of Indian basket of crude has grown 34% to \$68.35/barrel in the same period. Of the retail diesel rates, Central government taxes comprise about 39% and state VAT another 14%. The Centre's tax (basic excise, surcharge, agri-infra cess and road/infra cess) is currently ₹31.80/litre for diesel and ₹32.90/litre for petrol. In March and May 2020, the Centre increased the surcharge and cess on auto fuels by ₹13/litre on petrol and ₹16/litre on diesel.

Petrol crosses ₹100-mark in Maharashtra

PETROL AND DIESEL prices on Monday hit record highs across the country after rates were increased for the fifth time in a week, following which Maharashtra joined Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh in the league of states where petrol rates breached the ₹100-a-litre mark.

Petrol price was hiked by 26p a litre and diesel by 33p/litre, according to a price notification by state-owned fuel retailers. —PTI

Maha invites bids for 500 MW wind-solar hybrid power

Soon after Maharashtra invited bids for 500 megawatt (MW) of solar power on May 7, state-run Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company (MSEDCL) has floated a tender to purchase 500 MW of additional electricity from wind-solar hybrid projects. In a wind-solar hybrid project, at least one third of the generation capacity is based on either wind or solar energy. Maharashtra will sign a 25-year power purchase agree-

ment (PPA) with the lowest bidder participating in the auction.

The hybrid policy was launched in 2018, primarily to overcome the challenges posed by the intermittent nature of wind and solar power plants. The model envisaged configuring wind turbines and solar systems at same grid connection points for optimal utilisation of power generating and transmission capacities. The Solar Energy Corporation of India's latest bid to set up 1,200 MW of wind-solar hybrid plants discovered the lowest tariff of ₹2.41/unit in



December, 2020, much lower than the ₹2.69/unit quoted by companies in the previous auction for hybrid plants held in May 2019.

The wind-solar hybrid power will be used to fulfil the Centre-

mandated renewable purchase obligation (RPO) of Maharashtra, the tender document said. Commissioned projects, which do not have any obligations towards existing buyers, are also eligible to participate in the auction. Maharashtra has also recently invited bids for 1,300 MW of solar projects to be built within the state under the 'Mukhyamantri Saur Krishi Vahini Yojana', which will be specifically used to supply power for agriculture.

Standalone solar price has fallen to the record-low level of

₹1.99/unit, buoyed by lower interest rates, declining solar panel prices, improved technology and assurance of power purchase. Of the 39,084 MW of installed solar capacity in the country, Maharashtra houses 2,290 MW.

Covid: Navy brings large amount of medical supplies from abroad

INDIA GOT MORE overseas aid on Monday as nine warships deployed by the Indian Navy, as part of its Covid relief 'Operation Samudra Setu II', transported oxygen and other medical equipment from Kuwait and Qatar. India also received 1,350 oxygen cylinders, each of capacity 46.6 litre sent by the British Oxygen Company in UK and carried by an Aid Qatar Airways flight. The supplies will augment India's O2 availability amidst a surge of the coronavirus pandemic and worsening health crisis due to shortage of oxygen, critical for treating Covid 19 patients.

Other supplies and INS Trikand arrived in Mumbai with 40 tonne of oxygen from Qatar. "Deeply value the gift of 40 MT of LMO from our friend Kuwait. A special thanks for the generous donation to the Indian community in Kuwait for 200 O2 cylinders and 4 O2 concentrators, and to the community in Qatar for 200 O2 cylinders and 4 O2 concentrators. Grateful to various private organisations based in Singapore for coming together to provide this valuable support. Will boost our O2 capacities," Ministry of External Affairs spokesperson Arindam Bagchi said in a tweet.

Over the past one week, foreign medical assistance and

supplies have poured into India in significant quantity to help India battle the second and more lethal second wave of Covid-19.

India received from Spain oxygen concentrators, 254 ventilators, 12 oxygen cylinders, 200 pulse oxymeters among other supplies on May 9.
