Budget unveils new programme to promote research and innovation in pharmaceuticals

New Delhi, Feb 1: A new programme to promote research and innovation in pharmaceuticals will be taken up through centres of excellence, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman announced on Wednesday.

"We shall also encourage industry to invest in research and development," she said while presenting the Union Budget 2023-24 in the parliament.

"Dedicated multidisciplinary courses for medical devices will be supported in existing institutions to ensure availability of skilled manpower for future futuristic medical technologies, high end manufacturing and research," she added.

She also said that the govern-

ment will work in a mission mode to eliminate sickle-cell anaemia by 2047.

The minister also announced that 157 new nursing colleges will be established at core locations or places where the existing 157 medical colleges have been established since 2014.

Facilities in some selected Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) labs will be made available for research by public and private medical college faculty and private sector Research and Development teams for encouraging collaborative research and innovation.

The minister said India's rising global profile is because of several accomplishments. "Unique world-class digital public infrastructure, for example, Aadhar, Co-Win and UPI," she said.

She praised the Covid vaccination drive saying it was conducted on an unparalleled scale and with great speed.

Over 220 crore Covid vaccine doses have been administered in India. Ninety seven percent of eligible beneficiaries have already received at least one dose of the Covid-19 vaccine and around 90 percent of eligible beneficiaries have received both doses.

50 more tourism destinations to be developed: FM

New Delhi, Feb 1: Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman while announcing the Budget 2023 said that the government is on a mission mode to promote tourism in the country.

She said that the country offers immense attractions for domestic as well as foreign tourists. "There is large potential to be tapped in tourism. The sector holds huge opportunity for jobs and entrepreneurship for youth in particular. Promotion of tourism will be taken on mission mode with the active participation of states, the convergence of government programme and public-private partnership," said Sitharaman.

In addition, the Finance Minister said that with an integrated and innovative approach, at least 50 destinations will be selected through challenge mode.

"In addition to aspects such as physical connectivity, virtual connectivity, tourist guides, high standards for food streets, and tourist security, all the

relevant aspects would be made available on an app to enhance the tourist experience. Every destination would be developed as a complete package," she said. This is for the first time in the Union Budget that tourism has been the key focus policy area. India has huge potential for tourism given the diverse nature and culture of the country. The government's

focus to promote tourism will be positive for hotel companies including Indian Hotels, EIH, and Lemon Tree Hotels.

The Economic Survey which was tabled in Parliament by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on January 31 noted that the tourism sector is showing signs of revival after two years of Covid-induced challenges. Foreign tourist arrivals

in FY23 grew month-on-month with the resumption of international flights and the easing of Covid-19 regulations.

Foreign tourist arrivals in India in FY23 have been growing month-on-month with the resumption of scheduled international flights and the easing of Covid-19 regulations, the survey said.

Cash transfer of Rs. 2.2 lakh crore under PM-KISAN scheme

New Delhi, Feb 1: The government made cash transfer of Rs.2.2 lakh crore under the PM-KISAN scheme, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said on February 1.

Presenting the last full Union Budget 2023 of the second term of the BJP-led NDA government ahead of the general elections in 2024, she said the mission of the government is to achieve knowledge-driven economy.

She further said Indian economy has become more formalised as witnessed by significant enhancement in digital payments. Institutional credit in agriculture sector grew as much as Rs.18.6 lakh crore in FY22 from Rs.15.8 lakh crore in FY21.

Initiatives such as PM-KISAN, PM-Fasal Bima Yojana and forming agriculture infrastructure fund have provided much needed support to the sector. At the same

time the role of digital infrastructure in socio-economic development has gathered increased importance and India positioned itself strongly as a knowledge hub.

The focus of digital India programme rests on providing high speed internet as a core utility to citizens for delivering services, creating unique digital identity, providing shareable private space on public cloud (digitally store certificate and documents).

List of announcements relating to the Income Tax, announced in the Budget: "There were six income slabs starting from Rs.2.5 lakh. I propose to reduce the tax slabs and raise the limit to Rs. 3 lakh," she said.

PAN will be used as common identifier for all specified Govt agencies: FM

New Delhi, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Wednesday said Permanent Account Number (PAN) will be used for common identifier for all digital systems of specified government agencies.

The move would help in further promoting ease of doing business in the country.

PAN is a 10-digit alphanumeric

number allotted by the income tax department to a person, firm or entity.

She also said that if MSMEs fail to execute contract, 95 per cent of performance security will be returned to small business as part of Vivad Se Vishwas scheme.

Vivad Se Vishwas scheme provides for settlement of disputed tax, interests, penalty or fees in

relation to an assessment or reassessment order on payment of 100 per cent of the disputed tax and 25 per cent of the disputed penalty or interest or fee.

She also said that Phase-III of e-courts will be launched.

State support mission of Niti Aayog will be continued for three years, the finance minister said.

Government to continue 50-year interest-free loans to States

New Delhi, Feb 1: Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on February 1 announced that the Centre will continue 50-year interest-free loans to State governments for one more year. She also said the enhanced capex of Rs.10 lakh crore for infrastructure development is at 3.3% of the GDP.

Presenting the Budget for 2023-24, she said

the newly established infrastructure Finance Secretariat will assist in attracting more private investment. "An expert committee will also be set up to make infrastructure classification and financing framework suitable for Amrit Kaal," she added.

On October 13 last year, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had launched the Gati Shakti - National Master Plan, aimed at developing

integrated infrastructure to reduce logistics costs.

All logistics and connectivity infrastructure projects, entailing investment of over Rs.500 crore, are routed through the NPG, constituted under the PM Gati Shakti initiative. She also informed that the PM Primitive Vulnerable Tribal Group scheme would benefit 3.5 lakh tribals.

PMAY allocation increased to Rs. 79,000 cr

New Delhi, Feb 1: The Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana allocation has been proposed to be increased in the Union Budget 2023-24.

Union Minister of Finance Nirmala Sitharaman while presenting Budget 2023 has proposed to increase the allocation made towards the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana by 66% to Rs 79,000 in the

Union Budget 2023-24. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U) was extended on August 17, 2022 up to December 2024 with all the verticals except Credit Link Subsidy (CLSS). CLSS for EWS and LIG were till March 31, 2022.

During the extended period, no new houses were to be sanctioned. The additional outlay could be for completing

the existing projects. "The outlay for the PMAY scheme has been increased from 66% to Rs 79,000 crore, which represents a significant increase in funding for the program. This increase in funding will likely help the government achieve its goal of providing affordable housing to more people and contribute to the overall growth and development of the country," says Arpit Mehrotra, MD, office services, south India &

head of flex | India, Colliers.

With the PMAY CLSS, qualifying borrowers were to obtain a home loan from banks and housing finance firms at a reduced interest rate, achieving the goal of "Housing for All."

Under PMAY-U, Individuals who belong under MIG-I and have an annual income between Rs. 6 lakh and Rs. 12 lakh were eligible for a 4% interest subsidy on loans up to Rs. 9 lakh. Similarly, people whose

income is between Rs. 12 lakh and Rs. 18 lakh fall under MIG-II and were eligible for a 3% interest subsidy on loans up to Rs. 9 lakh.
