## FORMER IPS OFFICER ATTENDS PUBLIC EVENT IN POLICE UNIFORM

# Would have restored law and order if I was the Delhi Commissioner: Vanzara

FORMER IPS officer D G Vanzara wore the Gujarat police uniform, six years after his retirement, at an event in Ahmedabad on Sunday, where he claimed that if he were made the Delhi Police Commissioner, he would have "cleared all blocked roads" and "restored law and order" within minutes in the national capital.

An IPS officer of the 1987 batch, Vanzara retired as Deputy Inspector General (DIG) on May 31, 2014, after he was arrested and suspended from police service in April, 2007 for his alleged involvement in multiple cases of extra judicial killings.

Jaher Nagrik Samman Samiti, where he was felicitated for his post retirement promotion.

In an apparent reference to the recent riots in Delhi where more than 52 were killed and the ongoing protests at Shaheen Bagh against the Citizenship Amendment Act and the National Register of Citizens, Vanzara said, "Consider this hypothetical situation... if news flashes that D G Vanzara has been appointed as the Delhi Police commissioner... Vanzara sahib has arrived at Indira Gandhi International Airport in Delhi... I guarantee you that the law and order situation will be restored just by that news. I guarantee you that all blocked roads will be opened (sic)," said Vanzara at the event.

The event was also attended by Jay Vasavada, renowned Gujarati writer along with other dignitaries. Vasavada also spoke in favour of Vanzara and called him a warrior of Gujarat.

Vanzara in his address spoke about the encounter cases which were conducted during his tenure from 2002 to 2006 in Gujarat and the nine years he had spent in jail. "...The nationalism wave which India is experiencing right

now, it's base lies in Gujarat. In all the terrorism related activities which occurred in Gujarat and all the encounters that happened there was one thing common in each FIR filed for these cases - all these terrorists had come to Gujarat to kill the then chief minister Narendra Modi. The Gujarat Police, based on the input received by the Central Intelligence Bureau (IB) had finished off these terrorists following due procedures of IPC and CRPC. However, the kind of politics that has been going on for the past 70 years in India en-

sured that the nationalist police officers of Gujarat were sent to jail for their actions," said Vanzara.

He was also seen holding a sword which he was gifted at the event and saluting the audience, while donning the official uniform.

When asked why he had come dressed in police uniform, Vanzara said, "I wore it to show that my uniform is spotless and clean and there are no blots on it." In April 2007, Vanzara and SP-rank officers Rajkumar Pandian and Dinesh MN (Rajasthan cadre) were arrested by a team of Gujarat CID led by then IPS officer Rajnish Rai, for their alleged involvement in the alleged fake encounter case of Sohrahuddin Sheikh and his wife Kausar Bi. Vanzara was later charged for the encounter killing of Ishrat Jahan, three others and Tulsiram Prajapati.

Vanzara was lodged in Sabarmati Central Jail following his arrest in 2007. In November 2012, he was transferred to Mumbai's Talaja jail.

## Gujarat University students' elections held, counting today

THE STUDENT senate and students' welfare board elections of the Gujarat University that were held after a gap of four years witnessed nearly 75 per cent and 73.31 per cent voting respectively on Sunday. The counting is scheduled on Monday.

A total of five student organisations - Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad (ABVP) and National Students' Union of India (NSUI), Nationalist Congress Party (NCP), Students' Federation of India (SFI) and Vidyarthi Sena fielded their candidates.

Eight candidates each from ABVP and NSUI contested for the senate, while 14 each from these two student organisations fought for the students' welfare board. In addition, one candidate each was fielded from Vidyarthi Sena, SFI and NCP.

Also, nominations from one independent candidate each was received from the faculty medical and dental surgery. Thus, there was no election in these two faculties.

It will be a tough fight for the senate seat from the Faculty of

Law where four organisations - NSUI, ABVP, Vidyarthi Sena and SFI - fielded their candidates. The lone NCP candidate contested for undergraduate Commerce seat.

For the remaining senate seats, majority two student organisations - ABVP and NSUI candidates are contesting.

A total of 30 candidates contested for 14 seats for students' welfare board for which the voting was held Sunday. Similarly, for the 10 student representatives for the senate, a total of 41 candidates contested.

The elections were held after a gap of four years as several petitions were filed challenging the process.

This year too, ABVP had been demanding action against college principals for furnishing incomplete details of student voters. "Due to incomplete or incorrect address, we could not canvass and reach out to some students with our literature and campaign material. We had filed a representation with the education department for the same," said Gujarat ABVP spokesperson Samarth Bhatt.

## Bank manager booked for 'hate messages against Bharatiya Tribal Party'

THE POLICE on Sunday booked a Narmada-based bank manager for allegedly circulating objectionable messages against the Bharatiya Tribal Party (BTP) and its leaders, including Jhagdadia MLA Chhotubhai Vasava and Dediapada MLA Mahesh Vasava.

In his complaint, president of BTP's Narmada district unit, Chaitrabhai Vasava stated that the accused, Jagdish Vasava has been circulating abusive messages on various WhatsApp groups against BTP and its leaders, in addition to threatening party members via messages since earlier this year. The accused works as a branch manager at the Bank of Baroda in Nani Bedwan. When the complainant had confronted the accused regarding the messages, the latter had allegedly thrashed him.

Based on the complaint, the accused has been booked under IPC section 323 (Punishment for voluntarily causing hurt), 504 (Intentional insult with intent to provoke breach of the peace), 506 (2) (Punishment for criminal intimidation) and under relevant sections of the Information Technology Act.

According to police, both Chaitrabhai and Jagdish has been at loggerheads for the past couple of months after the former had allegedly abused Jagdish's wife and sent her lewd messages. After Jagdish had registered a complaint against Chaitrabhai, he was arrested and was recently released on bail.

"The complainant was released on bail a few weeks ago and the accused allegedly went on an abusive spree against the party, its leaders and threatened the members on their common social media groups. The complainant had first approached the court and as per orders, an FIR was registered at Dediapada police station. We will now record statements and are also getting the messages based on which the complaint has been filed. Based on the evidence, arrest will be made," said investigating Officer PP Chaudhary.
