KOCHI: The Kerala High Court on Thursday rejected a plea seeking CBI probe into the killing of an RSS worker who was hacked to death in November last year in Palakkad district of the state. Justice K Haripal dismissed the petition moved by the deceased RSS worker's widow. The detailed order is not yet available. The state had opposed the plea saying it has arrested all the accused and that if any new agency comes in, it will have to carry out the entire process again which would delay filing of the final report and in the meanwhile, the accused might get out on bail.

Irani's visit to Wayanad a 'cheap political game': Chennithala

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Senior Congress leader Ramesh Chennithala on Thursday termed as "cheap political games" the visit of Union Minister of Women and Child Development Smriti Irani to Wayanad and her criticism of the alleged lack of development in Congress Member of Parliament Rahul Gandhi's parliamentary constituency. Jumping to the defence of Gandhi, Chennithala said Wayanad was not the ideal place for Irani and her Sangh Parivar politics and that the people will reject the political games being played by her.

AP CM inaugurates Tata Trusts cancer hospital in Tirupati

TIRUPATI: Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy on Thursday inaugurated a charitable state-of-the-art cancer care institute set up by the Tata Trusts at Alipiri, the foothills of Tirumala here. Built at a cost of Rs 180 crore, the sprawling cancer hospital called Sri Venkateswara Institute of Cancer Care and Advanced Research (SVICCAR) was constructed by Tata Trusts on a site allotted by Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) that administers the shrine of Lord Venkateswara here, a TTD official said.

PSI scam: Candidates approach Karna High Court

BENGALURU: Rachana Hanumantha and Jagrut, among candidates aspiring for the post of police sub-inspector (PSI), who are named in the FIR lodged at a police station here in connection with the PSI recruitment scam, have approached the High Court of Karnataka seeking quashing of the case against them. The FIR was lodged in the High Grounds station. Following numerous allegations of corruption and malpractice, the government recently annulled the examination and ordered fresh exams.

Options open to get pardon for nurse facing death sentence: MEA

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: The Centre is exploring all options including getting pardon to an Indian nurse facing capital punishment in Yemen for allegedly killing a Yemeni businessman in 2017, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar has said. In his letter to Rajya Sabha member John Brittas who sought the Union government's intervention to release Keralite nurse Nimishapriya lodged in a Yemeni jail, Jaishankar said "the possibility that tribal customs and traditions may offer relief is also being explored in cooperation with community organisations".

PK to go on padyatra in Bihar, won't float political party for now

PATNA: Celebrated election strategist Prashant Kishor on Thursday announced that he has had his fill as a backroom operator for leading political players of the country and that he now intended to create a platform of like-minded people named 'Jan Suraj' aimed at transforming his home state Bihar.

While he brushed aside speculation that he would announce the setting up of a new party, Kishor

held out the possibility of Jan Suraj metamorphosing into a political party at a latter stage.

He said he was in touch with "about 18,000 people" who shared his vision for Bihar and whom he will "try to meet personally", before launching a 3,000-km 'padyatra' from Gandhi Ashram at Champaran on October 2. Kishor came out with an outline of his project, titled 'Jan Suraj', drawing inspira-

a crowded press conference here, days after he had announced his decision to go back "to the Real Masters - the people".

"A political party can be floated even a few months ahead of elections. Bihar faces none in the next few years," Kishor said averting pointed questions about his future political moves.

"I plan to cover a distance of 3,000 km in about a year. I will travel to

every nook and corner of the state and meet as many people as possible, trying to learn from their grievances and aspirations," he said. Kishor, who founded the political consultancy IPAC and who has worked with both Chief Minister Nitish Kumar and his arch rival Lalu Prasad, credited the two leaders with achievements in terms of social and economic empowerment in the last three decades.

'Focus on self-reliance in defence for future wars'

AGENCIES New Delhi

The nature of future wars can be assessed through a closer look at the situation in Syria, Afghanistan and the recent Ukrainian conflict, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh said on Thursday as he called for focusing on self-reliance in defence and use of technology in dealing with national security challenges.

Delivering the 37th PC Lal memorial lecture, he the situation in Ukraine has demonstrated that it could impact not only defence supplies, but commercial contracts are also prone to be affected when it comes to national interests.

Referring to steps being taken to ensure synergy among the three services, Singh said the ongoing process of integration of the armed forces is aimed at not only increasing the combined capability but also efficiency.

The defence minister also exhorted the Indian Air Force to become an "aerospace force" and be ready to protect the

country from evolving threats, and asked the armed forces to enhance their capabilities saying "you have to up your game".

Sharing his views on the need to achieve self-reliance in defence, Singh said it is essential not only to build the domestic capacity but also to safeguard the sovereignty of the country. "Our past experiences have taught us that India cannot depend on imports for its security. Recent conflicts, especially the situation

in Ukraine, have told us that not just defence supplies (could be affected), but commercial contracts are also prone to be affected when it comes to national interests," he added.

Singh's comments came in the backdrop of apprehensions among the military brass that there could be delays in the supply of military hardware from Russia to India in view of the Ukraine conflict.

LOUDSPEAKER ROW Raj won't get political benefit from: Ramdas

SOLAPUR: Union minister Ramdas Athawale on Thursday slammed MNS chief Raj Thackeray over his call for removal of loudspeakers from mosques, and said the MNS leader will not get any political benefit from his "hard stand" on the issue.

Addressing a press conference here, the Republican Party of India (A) chief also said the Shiv Sena-led Maharashtra government "failed" to present its case in the Supreme Court over the OBC quota issue.

MNS president Thackeray had earlier given an ultimatum to the state government to remove loudspeakers from mosques by May 3. He had urged people to play Hanuman Chalisa on loudspeakers on Wednesday wherever they hear loudspeakers "blaring azaan".

Athawale, whose party is an ally of the BJP-led NDA, said there is no need to take any unjust stand over loudspeakers. "With this stand, Raj Thackeray will not gain any political benefit. He has been putting forth different stands, but has never received any political benefits," he said.

Danve wants a Brahmin CM in Maharashtra

Ajit Pawar says even transgender can become one with backing of 145 MLAs

A transgender, a woman or anyone from any caste could become the chief minister of Maharashtra if they have the support of 145 legislators in the 288-member state legislative assembly, said Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar on Thursday. This response was triggered by a statement made by Union Minister of State for Railways Raosaheb Danve that he wished to see a Brahmin as the chief minister of Maharashtra.

Danve had made the comment on Tuesday night in Jalna, while addressing a rally organised by the Brahmin community on the occasion of Parashuram

Jayanti. A dignitary present at the rally demanded that Brahmins be given more representation in local governing bodies. In response, Danve said, "I don't want to see Brahmins just as corporators or civic body heads, I wish to see a Brahmin as the chief minister of this state."

Danve said he had campaigned in Uttarakhanda and Uttar Pradesh for the assembly elections held in these states earlier this year. "So much casteism has entered politics that it cannot be ignored. But there should be a leader who can keep communities together," he said.

"Anyone can become a chief minister. A 'tritiyapanthi' (transgender) or a person from any caste/religion or any woman can be chief minister by securing majority of 145 MLAs," said Pawar.

Lalitpur gang-rape: Accused SHO sent to judicial custody

LALITPUR: The Station House Officer arrested on charges of raping a minor girl here was on Thursday sent to 14-day judicial custody.

With this, all the six accused in the case have been sent to jail following court orders, police said.

"Accused SHO Tilakdhari Saroj was produced before a district court which sent him to 14-day judicial custody," Superintendent of Police Nikhil Patank said.

The 13-year-old girl was allegedly raped by four men over three days and was sexually assaulted again by the SHO of a police station where she had been left by

her attackers, police said. Saroj was arrested in Prayagraj on Wednesday and was brought here. DIG Jogendra Kumar had removed the entire staff of the Pali police station after the incident came to light.

While Dharmendra Singh has been made the new SHO of the police station, new staff has also been posted there, officials said.

The accused SHO was arrested from an area near the Allahabad High Court. Five others, including the girl's aunt and the four men who had lured the victim to Bhopal and raped her, have been arrested as well, they added.

KRISHNA JANMABHOOMI CASE

Court to pronounce verdict on May 19

MATHURA: A court here on Thursday reserved its verdict in the Shri Krishna Janmabhoomi-Shahi Idgah Mosque dispute case for May 19.

The judgment relates to the first suit in the case, which was filed by Lucknow's Ranjana Agnihotri as the next friend of child deity Shri Krishna Virajman of the Katra Keshav Dev temple and six others. Of the three lawsuits in this case, the second suit was filed by Hindu Army chief Manish Yadav and the third by five other plaintiffs

through advocate Mahendra Pratap Singh. The suits have demanded the removal of the mosque allegedly built on orders of Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb in 1669-70 in the 13.37-acre premises of Katra Keshav Dev temple near the birthplace of the deity Krishna.

"As the arguments by both sides concluded on Thursday, Sessions Judge Rajeev Bharti set May 19 for pronouncing the judgment on the Sri Krishna Janmabhoomi suit," District Government Counsel (Civil) Sanjai Gaur said.

NAVNEET, HUSBAND RELEASED FROM JAIL

MUMBAI: Independent MP Navneet Rana was released from Byculla Jail on Thursday afternoon and was taken to Lilavati Hospital in Mumbai for a medical check-up.

Earlier in the day, Mumbai's Borivali Court issued the release order of Navneet Rana and her husband, Ravi Rana, MLA, who were arrested after they declared that they would recite Hanuman Chalisa outside Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray's residence. The legal process of furnishing Rs 50,000 each for



the Rana couple's surety amount has been completed in court. From the Borivali court, one team of lawyers of the Rana couple left for Taloja Jail for the release of Ravi Rana, and another team for Byculla Jail, where Navneet Rana was lodged. Navneet Rana's lawyer had dropped a copy of her release order in the bail box placed outside Byculla Jail.
