I hereby intimate you that CIRP has been initiated in respect of NARAYANI STEELS LIMITED (Corporate Debtor) under the provisions of Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 (IBC 2016) by an order of National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT), Kolkata on 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 against Petition No. CP No. 986/KB/2020.

As per Section 17 of IBC 2016, the powers of the Board of Directors of NARAYANI STEELS LIMITED stands suspended, and such powers shall vest with me i.e., KRISHNA KOMARAVOLU, having IP Registration Number IBBI/IPA-002/IP-N00562/2017-2018/11699, appointed as the Insolvency Resolution Professional (IRP) by NCLT, Kolkata.

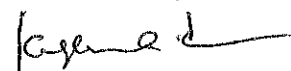
It may be further noted that as per the stipulations contained in Section 17 of IBC 2016, once the Interim Resolution Professional has been appointed:

- The Management of affairs of the Corporate Debtor is taken over by the IRP
- The powers of the Board of Directors of the Corporate Debtor are suspended and be exercised by the Interim Resolution Professional
- The officers and managers of the Corporate Debtor shall report to the IRP and co-operate with him in providing access to the documents and records of the Corporate Debtor
- The financial institutions maintaining the accounts of the Corporate Debtor shall furnish all information relating to the Corporate Debtor available with them to the IRP

In accordance with the above mentioned provision, you are requested to co-operate with me in providing access to the documents and records pertaining to the Corporate Debtor, as and when requested by me, for the smooth conduct of the CIRP.

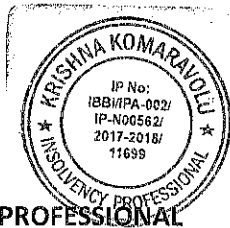

**ORDER**

**Per: Harish Chander Suri, Member (T)**

1. This Company petition being CP (IB) No. 986/KB/2020, filed under section 7 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code,2016 by **ICICI Bank Limited**, having its registered office at Vadodara, Gujarat, Regional office at Kolkata, through its authorised signatory Mr. Suman Mazumdar, Identification Number L65190GJ1994PLC021012 (hereinafter referred to as the Financial Creditor), against Narayani Steels Limited, a corporate entity, having its registered office at Kolkata, Identification Number L27109WB1996PLC082021 (hereinafter referred to as the Corporate Debtor) seeks initiation of Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process under the IBC Code,2016 against the Corporate Debtor.

2. It is submitted in the petition that the Corporate Debtor had entered into an agreement to purchase iron and steel products from Rashtriya Ispat Nigam Limited ( RINL) and for the purposes of making payment to it, the Corporate Debtor availed financial assistance in the nature of over draft facility not exceeding Rs. 9,50,00,000/- (Rupees Nine Crores Fifty Lakhs) vide a Credit Arrangement Letter dated January 13,2017, which was extended till May 27,2019 vide a Transition Letter dated May 28,2018.

3. It is stated that the Financial Creditor had authorized Mr. Suman

Mazumdar, to file the present application, vide Power of Attorney dated May 04,2019.

4. The Corporate Debtor had authorised share capital of Rs.14,00,00,000/- (Rs. Fourteen Crore only) as per its Memorandum of Association. The Financial Creditor had granted Revolving line of credit in the nature of overdraft facility aggregating to a cumulative value of Rs. 9,50,00,000 ( Rupees Nine Crores Fifty Lakhs only), to the Corporate Debtor.

5. The Financial Creditor has submitted that the amount in default under the facility as on July 31,2020 is Rs. 10,15,65,418.16 ( Rs. Ten Crore Fifteen Lakhs Sixty Five Thousand Four Hundred Eighteen and Sixteen paise). It is stated that since the Corporate Debtor had committed various breaches, a Facility Recall Notice was sent to the Corporate Debtor on February 24,2020. A computation of amount of default has also been annexed by the Financial Creditor as (Annexure-F).

6. The Corporate Debtor has enclosed a copy of the record of default as submitted by NeSL in relation to the Corporate Debtor dated July 10, 2020 (Annexure-K), which indicates the date of default as 01/10/2019.The Financial Creditor has also filed supplementary affidavit for the purposes of bringing on record the transaction statements for the entire period and to supplement the statements contained in the Financial Creditor's original application under section 7 of the IBC.

7. The Financial Creditor has *inter aila* placed on record various documents to support its claim.

- a. A Credit Arrangement Letter dated January 13,2017 facilitating line of credit in the nature of OD facility upto sums in the aggregate not exceeding overall limits of Rs. 95.00 million (Annexure G)

- b. A Transaction Letter dated May 28,2018 extending the period of drawals under the OD facility for a further period till May 27, 2019 (Annexure-H).
  - c. A copy of the document evidencing the details of the computation of amount of default is annexed at (Annexure-F). However, the Financial Creditor has filed the supplementary affidavit for the purposes of bringing on record the transaction statements for the entire period and to supplement the statements contained in Financial Creditors original application.
  - d. A copy of statement of accounts (summary) as on August 02,2020 available with the Financial Creditor (Annexure-I)
  - e. A copy of Deed of Guarantee dated January 25,2017(Annexure J3).
  - f. A copy of PDC Declaration by the Corporate Debtor dated January 20,2017( Annexure J4).
  - g. A copy of the postdated cheque issued as security and a copy of the cheque dishonor letter dated May 14, 2020 (Annexure J15).
  - h. A copy of the Facility Recall Notice issued by the Financial Creditor to the Corporate Debtor dated February 24,2020 alongwith proof of service (Annexure J13).
  - i. A copy of the letter dated February 26,2020 for invocation of personal guarantees by the Financial Creditor (Annexure J14).
  - j. A copy of the record of default as submitted and held by NeSL in relation to the Corporate Debtor for the financial debt under default since October 01,2019 (Annexure-K).
8. In spite of Facility Recall Notice dated 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2020, recalling the entire OD facility and demanding repayment, the Corporate Debtor has not paid its dues, thereby committing the default.
9. The Financial Creditor proposed the name of Mr. Krishna Komaravolu having Registration No. IBBI/IPA-002/IP-N00562/2017-2018/11699 to act as IRP in respect of Corporate Debtor. The Financial Creditor has also submitted

the authorization for assignment in Form B as mandated under By-laws 12A of the Insolvency Professional Agency with which the proposed IRP is registered.

10. The application filed by the Financial Creditor is otherwise complete and in proper form.

11. On being issued notice, the Corporate Debtor has filed reply through its authorized signatory Mr. Siddartha Bera. It is submitted in the affidavit in opposition filed by the Corporate Debtor that the allegations and detailed transactions mentioned in the petition are denied and disputed. The Corporate Debtor has further denied any transaction with the Financial Creditor except to the extent of an arrangement of purchasing iron and steel products from Rashtriya Ispat Nigam Limited (RINL). The Corporate Debtor has accepted the contract. It is stated that all payments were made by the Corporate Debtor and duly accepted by the Financial Creditor and that the transfer of amounts from the FD closure proceeds was also adjusted. It is stated that the question of the Corporate Debtor being liable to make any payment to the Financial Creditor on account is redundant and does not arise as due to the business assignments which got stalled as the World Health Organization (WHO) declared COVID 19 as a pandemic on March 11, 2020. The Government of India and the State Governments issued several advisory related to COVID 19 pandemic. On March 11, 2020, the Government of India issued an order under Section 69 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 delegated its power under Section 10 of the Act to the Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to enhance the preparedness and containment of COVID 19 and other ancillary connected matters. It is stated that as per the Government of India notification, the entire business transactions system collapsed due to pandemic, and the decision went to jeopardise the planning of the Corporate Debtor. It is further stated that the Ministry of Finance have already undertaken certain decision pertaining thereto on the NPA Accounts but the Corporate Debtors having no financial

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assistance and for such reason, has not been able to take any decisions to settle the accounts. It is further stated that the allegations on account of default are denied and since there is no default, the question of invocation of the provisions of the IBC does not arise.

12. We have considered the petition and the reply affidavit and all other documents filed by the parties, we have also heard Ld. Counsel for the parties. During the course of arguments, Ld. Counsel for the Corporate Debtor however, candidly admitted that there is no defence at all in this case and he has no valid grounds to dispute the claim of the Financial Creditor and therefore submitted before this Adjudicating Authority may pass appropriate orders. It was, therefore, noticed that the arguments advanced in Court were somewhat against the averments made in the reply affidavit.

13. In these circumstances, we have no hesitation in admitting the application and in ordering initiation of CIRP against the Corporate Debtor.

14. In view of the observations and directions, we hereby admit the petition and pass the following Orders:-

#### **O R D E R S**

- i) The application filed by the Financial Creditor under Section 7 of the Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code, 2016 for initiating Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process against the Corporate Debtor **Narayani Steels Limited** is hereby **admitted**.
- ii) We hereby declare a moratorium and public announcement in accordance with Sections 13 and 15 of the I & B Code, 2016.
- iii) Moratorium is declared for the purposes referred to in Section 14 of the Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code, 2016. The I.R.P. shall cause a public announcement of the initiation of Corporate Insolvency

Resolution Process and call for the submission of claims under Section 15. The public announcement referred to in clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 15 of Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code, 2016 shall be made immediately.

- iv) Moratorium under Section 14 of the Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code, 2016 prohibits the following:
- a) The institution of suits or continuation of pending suits or proceedings against the Corporate Debtor including execution of any judgment, decree or order in any court of law, tribunal, arbitration panel or other authority;
  - b) Transferring, encumbering, alienating or disposing of by the Corporate Debtor any of its assets or any legal right or beneficial interest therein;
  - c) Any action to foreclose, recover or enforce any security interest created by the Corporate Debtor in respect of its property including any action under the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (54 of 2002);
  - d) The recovery of any property by an owner or lessor where such property is occupied by or in the possession of the corporate debtor.
- v) The supply essential goods or services rendered to the corporate debtor as may be specified shall not be terminated, suspended, or interrupted during the moratorium period.



- vi) The provisions of sub-section (1) shall not apply to such transactions as may be notified by the Central Government in consultation with any financial sector regulator.
- vii) The order of moratorium shall have effect from the date of admission till the completion of the corporate insolvency resolution process.
- viii) Provided that where at any time during the Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process period, if the Adjudicating Authority approves the resolution plan under sub-section (1) of Section 31 or passes an order for liquidation of the corporate debtor under Section 33, the moratorium shall cease to have effect from the date of such approval or liquidation order, as the case may be.
- ix) **Mr. Krishna Komaravolu**, registered with Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India, having Registration No. IBBI/IPA-002/IP-N00562/2017-2018/11699 is hereby appointed as Interim Resolution Professional for ascertaining the particulars of creditors and convening a Committee of Creditors for evolving a resolution plan subject to production of written consent within one week from the date of receipt of this order.
- x) The Interim Resolution Professional should convene a meeting of the Committee of Creditors and submit the resolution passed by the Committee of Creditors and shall identify the prospective Resolution Applicant within 105 days from the insolvency commencement date.
- xi) The Financial Creditor/Applicant is directed to deposit **Rs 5,00,000/-(Rupees Five Lacs)** with the IRP appointed hereinabove within **three** days from this order. IRP can claim the

preliminary expenses and fees subject to the approval by the CoC and after constitution of CoC.

- xii) Registry is hereby directed to communicate the order to the Operational Creditor, the Corporate Debtor, the I.R.P. and the jurisdictional Registrar of Companies by Speed Post as well as through email.
- xiii) List the matter on **22/04/2021** for the filing of the **progress report**.
- xiv) Certified copy of the order may be issued to all the concerned parties, if applied for, upon compliance with all requisite formalities.

# Govt prepares four-point plan to deal with blockage of Suez Canal

New Delhi, March 26

The government on Friday said a four-point plan has been chalked out to deal with the situation arising from the blockage of Suez Canal.

The plan was chalked out in a meeting convened by the logistics division, Ministry of Commerce. It includes prioritisation of cargo, freight rates, advisory to ports and re-routing of ships.

A meeting in this regard was chaired by Special Secretary (Logistics) Pawan Agarwal attended by representative from the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, ADG Shipping, Container Shipping Lines Association (CSLA) and Federation of Indian Export Organisations.

Under prioritisation of cargo, FIEO, MPEDA and APEDA will jointly identify cargo particularly perishable cargo for priority movement and work with the shipping lines for the same.

Besides, CSLA assured that the freight rates as per existing contracts will be honoured. "A request has been made to the shipping lines to

maintain stability in freight rates during the period of this crisis. It was noted that the situation is temporary and is unlikely to have a long-lasting impact," the commerce ministry stated.

Once the blockage is over, it is expected that some bunching may take place, especially at the ports of JNPT, Mundra and Hazira, it said. "Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways assured to issue an advisory to these ports so as to gear up arrangements and ensure efficient handling during the forthcoming busy period," the statement said.

Besides, shipping lines were advised through CSLA to explore the option of re-routing of ships via the Cape of Good Hope. It was pointed that such re-routing usually takes 15 additional days' time.

Blockage of Suez Canal since March 23, 2021, is seriously hitting the global trade, the commerce ministry said.

This route is used for Indian exports and imports worth USD 200 billion to/from North America, South America and Europe. It includes petroleum goods, organic chemicals, iron and steel, automobile, machinery, textiles and carpets, and handicrafts, including furniture and leather goods.

It was noted in the meeting that over 200 vessels are waiting on the North and South sides of the Suez Canal, and about 60 vessels are getting added to the queue on a daily basis.

If two more days are taken before the efforts result in clearance of the canal (digging on both sides, extra barges being added on every high tide, tugboats, etc, to straighten the stuck vessel), the total backlog created would be about 350 vessels.

"It is estimated that this backlog should take about a week's time to clear out. It was decided in the meeting to closely monitor the situation," the ministry said.

## India tells overseas vaccine buyers it has to prioritise local needs

INDIA, THE WORLD'S biggest vaccine maker, said on Friday it would make domestic Covid-19 inoculations a priority as infections surge and had told international buyers of its decision.

Reports that India will delay deliveries of AstraZeneca's Covid-19 vaccine to a global programme to inoculate poorer countries triggered alarm on Thursday, with the head of Africa's disease control agency describing the continent as "helpless".

India has exported 60.5 million doses, more than the number of inoculations conducted at home, and says there is no outright ban on exports.

"In the coming weeks and months... obviously there will be a demand spike and obviously people are preparing for it," Subrahmanyam Jaishankar told the Times Network's India Economic Enclave. "In many cases, we have told our international partners that... Covid rates are going up in India, we are expanding our own vaccination ambit, so we are sure you will understand that at this time we have to purpose it much more focused at where we are."

The Gavi alliance said in a statement that the COVAX vaccine-sharing facility had notified

all affected economies of potential delays of exports by the Serum Institute of India (SII).

India is diverting more supplies from SII to inoculations at home. Its other vaccine maker, Bharat Biotech, is struggling to boost output.

"SII has pledged that, alongside supplying India, it will prioritise the COVAX multilateral solution for equitable distribution," Gavi said. India on Friday reported 59,118 new infections, taking its tally to 11.85 million, the world's third largest after the United States and Brazil. The death toll rose by 257 to stand at 1,60,949.

Everyone above 45 in India is eligible for vaccination from April 1 and the government is considering including more people after new infections nearly quadrupled this month. "The government is already

planning to widen the umbrella of Covid-19 vaccine beneficiaries in the near future to cover other sections of our population," health minister Harsh Vardhan told a virtual summit organised by the *Economic Times*.

India has injected 55 million vaccine doses, the third highest figure after the United States and Brazil, although much lower as a proportion of its population of 1.35 billion, the website Our World in Data showed. The western state of Maharashtra, hardest hit by a resurgence in cases, has warned of vaccine shortages and imposed lockdowns in some towns. Authorities have also warned of a strict lockdown in Pune district, which on Thursday reported a record 6,427 new cases, the highest in the country.

## Centre asks states, UTs to regulate crowd during upcoming festivals

New Delhi, March 26

THE CENTRE ON Friday asked states and Union Territories to regulate crowd during upcoming festivals like Holi, Easter and Eid in view of rising cases of Covid-19.

In a communication to chief secretaries of all states and UTs, Union home secretary Ajay Bhalla said the country is passing through a critical juncture as Covid-19 cases and deaths have been on the rise.

Bhalla said after assessing the situation, guidelines for effective control of Covid-19 were issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs on March 23 and it has been emphasised that states and UTs should strictly enforce the "test-track-treat" protocol.

It has also been told that Covid-19 appropriate behaviour should be observed and prescribed standard operating procedures followed on various activities, such as opening of schools, higher education institutions, hotels and restaurants, shopping malls, multiplexes, entertainment parks, gymnasium, exhibitions, among others.

Further, states and UTs, based on their assessment of the situation, are allowed to impose local restrictions at the district,

sub-district, and city and ward levels.

"In view of upcoming festivals such as Holi, Shab-e-Barat, harvesting festivals, Easter, Eid-ul-Fitr, etc. the state governments and UT administrations should take necessary measures to regulate crowds during these festivals by ensuring strict observance of COVID appropriate behaviour, such as wearing of mask and maintaining social distancing, as mandated in aforesaid guidelines and in the National Directives for COVID-19 Management," the communication said.

The home secretary also asked chief secretaries to issue necessary instructions to district administrations and police authorities to scrupulously enforce COVID-19 appropriate behaviour and SOPs in all public gatherings during the upcoming festivals.

Further, Bhalla said, campaign should also be intensified for creating public awareness.

"As has been emphasised time and again by health experts, strict adherence to COVID appropriate behaviour in public places and gatherings will help in breaking the chain of transmission and reduce the incidence of COVID cases in the country," he said.

## Supreme Court reserves verdict in Maratha reservation case

THE SUPREME COURT Friday reserved judgement on a batch of petitions challenging the Bombay High Court verdict which had upheld the grant of reservation to Marathas in admissions and government jobs in the state.

A five-judge Constitution bench headed by Justice Ashok Bhushan concluded hearing of arguments in the matter in which submissions were also advanced on whether the landmark 1992 Indra Sawhney verdict (called the Mandal judgement), which put a cap of 50 per cent on reservations, requires reconsideration by a larger bench.

"K K Venugopal, Attorney General has addressed his arguments in reply to the submissions made in the writ petition... Tushar Mehta, Solicitor General appearing for the UOI (Union of India) and state of Gujarat adopts the submission of the Attorney General. Hearing completed. Judgment reserved," said the bench, which also comprised justices L Nageswara Rao, S Abdul Nazeer, Hemant Gupta and S Ravindra Bhat.

The bench had commenced hearing arguments in the matter on March 15.

## ED raids ex-United Bank of India CMD Archana Bhargava

New Delhi, March 26

THE ENFORCEMENT DIRECTORATE (ED) on Friday said it has searched two premises of former United Bank of India (UBI) CMD Archana Bhargava in connection with a money laundering investigation.

It said the action against the banker, also a former executive director of Canara Bank, was undertaken in Delhi under provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) and is based on a 2018 FIR filed against her by the CBI for alleged possession of disproportionate assets.

"As per the CBI FIR, she had amassed disproportionate assets to the tune of ₹3.63 crore during the check period when she was occupying senior positions in various public sector banks," the agency said in a statement.

"The searches were carried out by the ED to trace the proceeds of crime and to unearth the documentary evidence showing acquisition, routing, layering and projection (as legitimate assets) of the said proceeds of crime amounting to ₹3.63 crore, leading to commission of the offence of money-laundering," the agency added.

As a result of searches, it said, ED has recovered certain "incriminating documents and electronic evidences pertaining to aforesaid further reinforcing the case against Archana Bhar-

gava." The ED said this is a second case of money laundering filed against the ex-banker and she was already being probed by it under the criminal sections of PMLA on the basis of a 2016 CBI FIR. "The said FIR pertains to use of Kolkata-based shell companies to layer the proceeds of crime into the accounts of Rank Mercantile (RMPL), a company owned by her husband and son," the ED said.

Bhargava became a Deputy General Manager of Punjab National Bank in 2004 and General Manager in 2008. She worked as Executive Director at Canara Bank from April 1, 2001 to April 22, 2013. She joined the United Bank of India on April 23, 2013 as Chairperson-cum-MD, a position she held till February 20, 2014.

## Pune could see lockdown if situation worsens

AS THE SURGE in Covid-19 cases continues unabated with 6,432 new positive cases in Pune district, Maharashtra deputy chief minister Ajit Pawar said on Friday that the state would have to consider lockdown in Pune if the situation worsened in the next

couple of days. The number of vaccination centres in Pune would be doubled to 600 to immunise more people in the coming days. Private hospitals have been directed to set aside 50% of their beds for Covid patients, while Covid beds in government hospitals was being doubled.

Reviewing the situation in Pune on Friday, Pawar said

they were monitoring it and there would be no lockdown for now but the government would impose additional curbs. All schools and colleges would remain closed till April 30 and night curfew would continue in Pune. Restaurants and bars can only run at 50% capacity and have to shut after 10 pm for dine-in and by 11 pm for food par-

celling, but if the situation worsens dine-in could be closed down completely after April 2. Pawar said they did not want a lockdown but a final call would be taken after a review meeting to be held on April 2.

Fresh Covid-19 cases in Pune district on Friday was 6,432 with 42 deaths. Pune city accounted for 3,286

cases, while Pimpri Chinchwad reported 1,811 cases. The positivity rate in the district was 24.7%, which is up from 9% in February 2021. There were 10,270 people in hospital while 39,440 active cases were in home quarantine.

Total positive cases has risen to 4.92 lakh with 9,724 deaths till date.

## Indian-American Dr Vivek Murthy sworn in as US Surgeon General

INDIAN-AMERICAN PHYSICIAN Vivek Murthy has been sworn in as the 21st Surgeon General of the US, a role in which his top priority would be to end the coronavirus pandemic that has severely hit the country and be a voice for science.

"Honoured to be sworn in as your Surgeon General. I owe this day to my family who has guided & supported me every step of the way," Dr Murthy, 43, said on Thursday soon after being sworn in as the top doctor of the country by Secretary of Health and Human Services Xavier Becerra.

He has occupied the position of America's Surgeon General for the second time. In 2011, president Barack Obama tapped him to serve on the advisory group on prevention, health promotion, and integrative and public health.

"I stand ready to work with you to end this pandemic & build a world where good health is within everyone's grasp," he said. Ready to take on this position as the Nation's Doctor to help end this pandemic, be a voice for science, & support our nation on its path to rebuilding and healing, said Dr Murthy, who now is the highest ranking Indian-American in the Biden administration.

COVID-19 has taken the lives of several members of Murthy's extended family. During his confirmation hearing in February, he said that seven of his family members in India and America have died due to the virus. A day earlier Murthy was confirmed by the Senate by 57-43 votes. As US Surgeon General, Murthy will advise President Biden on the coronavirus pandemic and will be the federal government's leading voice on public health.

In 2013, Obama nominated Dr Murthy to be the Surgeon General. He was the youngest ever to hold the office at the age of 37. However, he had to abruptly leave the position during the Trump administration.

During his previous tenure as 19th Surgeon General, Dr Murthy has created initiatives to tackle America's most pressing public health challenges.



As America's Doctor he helped lead the national response to a range of health challenges, including the Ebola and Zika viruses, the opioid crisis, and the growing threat of stress and loneliness to Americans' physical and mental wellbeing.

He also issued the first Surgeons General's report on Alcohol, Drugs and Health, in which he challenged the nation to expand access to prevention and treatment and to recognise addiction as a chronic illness, not a character flaw. Dr Murthy continued the office's legacy on preventing tobacco-related disease, releasing a historic Surgeon General's report on e-cigarettes and youth.

Prior to his tenure as Surgeon General, Dr Murthy co-founded VISIONS, a global HIV/AIDS education organization; the Swasthya Project, a rural health partnership that trained women in South India to become community health workers and educators; TrialNetworks, a technology company dedicated to improving collaboration and efficiency in clinical trials; and Doctors for America, a nonprofit mobilising physicians and medical students to improve access to affordable care. His scientific research has focused on vaccine development and the participation of women and minorities in clinical trials. As an internal medicine doctor at Brigham and Women's Hospital and at Harvard Medical School, Dr Murthy cared for thousands of patients over the years.

## CBI seeks custody of Binay Mishra brother in coal scam

CBI ON FRIDAY sought the permission of a designated ED court in Delhi the custody of Trinamooli Youth Congress leader Binay Mishra's brother in the multi-crore rupees coal smuggling scam, sources in the central investigating agency said.

Mishra's brother Bikash is now in the custody of the Enforcement Directorate, which had arrested him from Delhi on March 16, the sources said.

Bikash Mishra was also summoned to appear before CBI officials here for the second time

in connection with the cattle smuggling probe.

The CBI has summoned businessman Amit Agarwal, a close aide of the kingpin Anup Majhi, alias Lala, in connection with the coal pilferage scam.

Sources said Agarwal has been called to face interrogation in the scam next week.

CBI had raided Agarwal's premises in Kulti and Durgapur and his company's head office in Kolkata.

The agency is also searching for Majhi, who is absconding and a look-out circular has been

issued against him. CBI had raided several premises of Majhi in the city and in the coal bearing belt of Asansol and Raniganj.

The investigation agency is of the view that the coal scam, arising out of illegal mining from abandoned mines of Eastern Coalfields, runs into several thousands of crores of rupees and part of the crime proceeds had been transacted through the hawala route.

The Enforcement Directorate had joined the probe to investigate it. —PTI
