Kanniyakumari, Nov 11: As Thiruvananthapuram, in neighboring Kerala is witnessing a surge in COVID-19 cases, the Health Department staff have been instructed to intensify tests on interstate travelers as a precautionary measure. The state government would continue with all required steps to contain COVID-19 further, the Chief Minister said.

border with the neighbouring State will be monitored round-the-clock to check the entry of infected persons, Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami said. Addressing a COVID-19 review meeting at the Kanniyakumari Collectorate, Mr. Palaniswami said the district officials had been directed to organise 35 fever clinics every day at people's doorstep to detect cases. Thus far, 43,410 persons have been screened through fever clinics

for ensuring timely isolation of patients and appropriate treatment. "To make these efforts more effective and to ensure better results, stringent surveillance has been put in place on the Kanniyakumari-Kerala border. Inter-State travellers from the district should be very cautious and take all precautionary measures to shield themselves from the infection," he said. "The district administration has

been asked to ensure rigorous surveillance on the border round-the-clock, as any lapse would pose a serious threat to the efforts made to control the spread," the CM said. The Chief Minister said adequate beds, medicines, RT-PCR kits and personal protective equipment had been made available in the district to handle any situation arising out of COVID-19.

(Contd from page 3) quality and sea erosion, this road, which is paramount for free movement of fishermen and materials required for the industry, should be re-laid afresh while ensuring superior quality. Coming down heavily on beach minerals being mined

by the Manavaalukurichi-based Indian Rare Earths Limited, the fishermen said the quarrying of sand on the beach by this public sector undertaking was the prime reason for the sea erosion in the coast. So, the government should take steps to permanently stop quarrying beach minerals in the

district. Since this region has more than 1,000 mechanised boats mostly involved in multi-day deep sea stay fishing, a control room should be set up at Irayumanthurai to transmit and receive satellite phone signals for alerting fishermen fishing

## Remarks over death of Doraikannu, Defamation case will be filed on Stalin: Minister

Chennai, Nov 11: Health Minister C.Vijayabaskar on Tuesday said the government will take legal action against DMK president M.K.Stalin for his false statement relating to the death of Agriculture Minister R.Doraikannu. Strongly condemning DMK president MK Stalin's remarks over the death of former Agriculture Minister R Doraikannu and other false charges levelled by him, Health Minister C Vijaya Baskar today said a defamation case would be filed against the

DMK chief for his remarks. The Minister also produced the medical records from Kauvery hospital where he was treated. "The government headed by Chief Minister Edappadi K Palaniswami has been functioning with a motto - 'Every single life is important to the government'. When DMK MLA J Anbazhagan was treated for COVID-19, there was a demand for important medicines for him and the State government immediately provided the medicines. The DMK chief's statement is

maligned the invaluable service being rendered by our doctors. I wish to point out that MK Stalin's father and former Chief Minister M Karunanidhi was treated in the same hospital." Vijaya Baskar said in a statement. The Health Minister said that since the Leader of the Opposition could not find any concrete fault against the AIADMK government, has been engaging in cheap politics by levelling false charges regarding the death of the former Minister. Giving details of the treatment

given to Doraikannu right from day one of his admission to the Kauvery hospital, Vijaya Baskar said from October 24 onwards, vital organs of Doraikannu started failing. Despite the best efforts, Doraikannu passed away on October 31. Either the government or the hospital did not hide anything about the treatment given to Doraikannu and through frequent medical bulletin, information about his health condition was given to the public.

## Lankan Navy arrests 4 TN fishermen; rescues 14 stranded from Karaikal

Nagapattinam, Nov 11: Four Tamil Nadu fishermen were arrested by the Sri Lankan Navy on Tuesday when they were allegedly fishing in the sea off Kodiakarai coast, a fishermen association here said. The fishermen belonging to Tarangambadi in this district were apprehended for allegedly entering Lankan territorial waters. The fishermen ventured into the sea on November 7 and were fishing about 20 nautical miles southeast of Kodiakarai this morning when the Lankan naval personnel came to the spot and arrested them,

representatives of the association claimed. The fishermen have been taken to Kangesanthurai in the island nation, they said and added that they have lodged complaints with the officials of the Fisheries department. Meanwhile, 14 fishermen belonging to neighbouring Karaikal district in the union territory of Puducherry, who drifted to Lankan territory due to an engine snag in the boat were rescued by the Navy of the island nation, an official said. All are being sent back home and are expected to reach on

Wednesday, a report from Karaikal said. The fishermen ventured into the sea from Karaikal on November 8 and drifted in the sea the next day, Kaviyarasan, Deputy Director of Fisheries, Karaikal, said. When their boat was struggling in the sea near Kaalai area in Sri Lanka, the Lankan Navy helped them reach the shore at Kaalai town. Their boat has now been set right and the fishermen have been sent back home by the Lankan authorities, he said.

## Panna gets UNESCO's 'Biosphere Reserve' status

Madhya Pradesh, Nov 11: Panna National Park in Madhya Pradesh, a popular tourist spot for wildlife lovers has been declared as a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve. Union Minister of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Prakash Javadekar sharing the news on Twitter congratulated the reserve for the status and praised its work on tiger conservation. Adding the tiger reserve to UNESCO's list

will help in exploring new measures towards the conservation of wildlife and sustainability.Panna Tiger Reserve last year witnessed a remarkable turnaround in tiger population by increasing the number of big cats to 50 from zero estimated a decade ago, reported PTI. The Tiger Reintroduction Project started in 2009 by bringing five female and two male felines from Bandhavgarh and Kanha national parks.

The Panna National Park got the status of Project Tiger Reserve 13 years after its formation in 1981. Report by the All India Tiger Estimation made Madhya Pradesh the state with the highest number of tigers. The state had a total of 526 big cats according to 2018 census. After Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka and Uttarakhand have the highest number of tigers.
