BULLDOZER ACTION: Thousands of buildings razed in six years in state Nath started it all; Shivraj, Mohan, too, went for it

Former chief minister Babulal Gaur deployed bulldozer to remove encroachments

Bulldozer action going on in the state for a long time may stop after the Supreme Court judgment on Wednesday.

Now that the SC issued an order, it would not be easy for the government to go for such an action.

In the past six years, thousands of buildings have been bulldozed in the state.

Such actions were taken to dismantle illegal buildings, remove encroachments and to free government land from the grips of the mafia.

Apart from that, the buildings of some criminals and of

those who were involved in riots were bulldozed.

Bulldozers have been used for several years to remove encroachments upon government land. For removing encroachments with bulldozers, former chief minister Babulal Gaur was called Bulldozer Minister.

Nevertheless, bulldozer action, during Digvijaya Singh's tenure as chief minister for ten years and during the BJP's first 15 years rule, was not much discussed.

The issue became popular after UP Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath launched the campaign of Bulldozer Justice

which was followed by the Congress government led by the then chief minister Kamal Nath.

The Nath-led government started bulldozer action in 2018. When the honey trap case came to light, the houses of some people were bulldozed in Indore.

Afterwards, bulldozer action was launched in the name of checking the mafia. The campaign that began from Indore was carried out in Gwalior, Sagar and in other places.

After the ouster of the Congress government, Shivraj Singh Chouhan again took over the reins of power in the state.

Kamal Nath-led government started bulldozer action in 2018. When the honey trap case came to light, the houses of some people were bulldozed in Indore.

During his tenure as chief minister in 2020, the Chouhan-led government plunged into action bulldozing thousands of buildings.

Because the government gave a free hand to the officials of the district administration they also used bulldozers as weapons against the criminals.

Bulldozer was used against rapists, murderers and those

who were involved in molesting women and in torturing the people of the SC/ST community.

After the communal riots in Khargone, the government used bulldozers against the people of a particular community.

After Mohan Yadav took over as chief minister, several bulldozer actions were taken.

Bulldozing the palatial house of Haji Shahjad Ali after the stone-pelting incident in Chhatarpur hoggged the media headlines across the country, although Yadav said he was opposed to such action.

Tankha welcomes SC judgment

Rajya Sabha member and senior lawyer Vivek Tankha has welcomed the SC judgment.

The SC has declared the bulldozer action unconstitutional and that the government cannot interfere in the court's area of jurisdiction, Tankha said.

The officers and politicians, involved in such actions, will have no chance to get out of the arms of law, he said.

Cong demands high-level probe into financial irregularities in UMC

In the BJP-led board, there has been extensive financial irregularity in contractor payments in the cash-strapped Ujjain Municipal Corporation (UMC), with funds being diverted inappropriately.

In several instances, loans were taken but contractors still weren't paid. Loans were taken for many complexes, which remain incomplete and even the loan funds meant for payment to con-

tractors were not utilised for that purpose. Contracts were issued for Sanjeevani Clinics, which were deposit works, yet payments were not made. Only those who pay extra are receiving payments in the UMC, corruption is prevalent, with payments going to allies and those who provide additional money.

Raising these allegations, City Congress Committee president Mukesh Bhati and Leader of Opposition Ravi Rai have urged state government to form a high-level committee to investigate the

irregularities in contractor payments.

Rai stated that Congress has been consistently protesting over the financial situation of the municipal corporation, and there has been no construction work in any corporator's area. Officials are selectively making payments at their discretion. The corporation has fixed deposits in its account, but no grants are being received from the government. Payments of Rs 50 to 55 crore to contractors have been pending since December 2020.

41 e-check-posts to curb illegal mineral transport: CM

Chief Minister Mohan Yadav has said that 41 AI-powered check-posts are being established across the state to curb the illegal transportation of minerals. These check-posts will be equipped with varifocal cameras, RFID readers, and automatic number plate readers, to monitor the vehicles engaged in transportation of minerals. This initiative aims to increase surveillance and enforcement.

In the form of a pilot project, E-check posts have been established at four places. To keep an eye on illegal transportation, a state level command and control center has been established in Bhopal and district command

centers have been set up in Bhopal and Raipur. The target has been set to establish all 41 E-Check posts by December

month. CM had also started satellite and drone based projects to contain the illegal transporta-

tion of minerals. Under this, all 7000 mines have been geo-tagged. With the implementation of the project, 3D imaging

of the sanctioned mines and volumetric analysis of excavated minerals could be done in an accurate manner.

MP Board students to pay Rs 65 for taking half yearly exams

For the first time, the students of both government and private MP Board schools will have to pay to write the half-yearly exams. The Madhya Pradesh State Open School Board (MPSOS) will charge a fee of Rs 65 per student for printing the exam paper, adding financial burden on the students of government as well as private schools. The fees will also apply to those students whose papers will not be printed by the MPSOS.

The half-yearly exams for classes 9 to 12 will start on December 9. The exams for classes 9 and 10 will continue until December 18, while those for classes 11 and 12 will run until December 19. For classes 9 to 12, the question papers will be prepared at the state level, with the printing responsibilities assigned to the MPSOS.

Around 20 lakh students from government schools across the state are expected to participate in these exams. A list of question papers to be printed by the MPSOS has already been sent, while some question papers will be prepared locally by District Education Officers (DEOs). The question papers are based on the syllabus up to November 2024, as per the marking scheme and academic calendar issued by the MPBSE. RESULTS ON VIMARSH PORTAL: As per the order issued by DPI Commissioner Shilpa Gupta, after the exams, teachers will evaluate the answer sheets and show the students their mistakes. A Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) will be held on December 30 to inform parents about the exam results. Additionally, the results of the half-year exams must be uploaded on the Vimarsh portal by December 30.
