Guruvayur express to run via Pollachi for four days

TO facilitate engineering maintenance as part of rail track doubling works at Nagercoil Town, Nagercoil, Aralvaymoli, and Kanniyakumari stations, the Southern Railway on Tuesday announced that the Chennai Egmore-Guruvayur Express will be rerouted via Pollachi and Palakkad, bypassing all stations in Tamil Nadu and Kerala beyond Dindigul station.

According to a press note, Chennai Egmore-Guruvayur Express leaving Egmore at 9.45 am on March 23, 24, 25 and 26 will be diverted to run via Dindigul, Pollachi and Palakkad skipping stoppages at Kodaikanal Road, Sholavandan, Kudal Nagar, Madurai, Virudhunagar, Satur, Kovilpatti, Maniyachchi, Tirunelveli, Nanguneri, Valliyur, Aralvaymoli, Nagercoil, Eranian, Kulithurai, Neyattinkara, Thiruvananthapuram Central, Chirayinkeezhu, Kadakavur, Varkala, Paravur, Kollam, Kayankulam, Alappuzha, Cherthala, Ernakulam Jn, Ernakulam Town, Aluva, Angamali, Chakkudi and Irinjalakuda. Additional stoppages will be provided at Pollachi and Palakkad.

Similarly, during the return journey, the Guruvayur-Chennai Egmore Express departing from Guruvayur at 11.15 pm on March 23, 24, 25, and 26 will be diverted via Palakkad, Pollachi, and Dindigul, without stopping at all stations in Kerala and Tamil Nadu until Dindigul. The train stop at all designated stations between Dindigul and Chennai Egmore as per the schedule, added the statement.

Corpn rescues 142 dogs from house in Velachery

FOLLOWING the orders of the Madras High Court, the Chennai corporation has seized 142 dogs from a home in Velachery. The orders were passed on a petition filed by residents of Andal Avenue in Velachery. The petition alleged that one resident was illegally housing stray dogs in large numbers, inconveniencing other residents in the area. They sought the removal of the dogs from her custody.

Following the seizure, the animals were sent to various

corporation centres across the city. A corporation official said they would vaccinate and sterilise the dogs before releasing them in the same area. Their health will also be examined. "The HC order will help in recovering dogs that are illegally sheltered by individuals without adequate facilities. Most of the dogs recovered from Velachery are stray and unvaccinated. However, the animals were fed properly. Lack of adequate spacing was the concern and owners should register with the corporation for raising pet dogs," the official added.

AC coaches in Chennai-B'lu double decker reduced

Chennai: A month after adding five non-AC sitting coaches in the Chennai-Bengaluru double decker train, the Southern Railway has reduced the number of AC chair car coaches in the train from eight to seven. The revised composition of the rake will come into effect from Wednesday. Similarly, the change in rake composition will come into effect in Coimbatore-Bengaluru UDAY express which shares rake with the Bengaluru double decker. The Chennai-Bengaluru DD express which was fully air-conditioned, was attached with five non-AC second-class coaches from February 15. "The coach composition was altered due to operational reasons," said an official from the Chennai division. ENS

Jains Westminster: Rtd judges' panel to oversee evacuation of 472 flats

Alternative lodging must be given within 5-km radius or owners must get to pick location

THE Madras High Court has constituted a two-member committee comprising retired High Court judges to look into issues regarding the poor quality of construction and damages in the structure of the Jains Westminster apartments at Saligramam in Chennai.

A division bench of Justices SS Sundar and N Senthilkumar on Tuesday passed the interim orders to form the committee on the petitions filed by aggrieved flat owners. The committee, consisting of retired judges Justice KN Basha and Kannan, is tasked with the supervision of evacuating 472 occupants of the three blocks and providing them with alternative accommodation.

"The committee is required to consider the representation of individual flat owners for arranging accommodation. It shall find alternative accommodation for the flat owners with equal space
