SC bench defers hearing of Article 370 petitions

Supreme Court gives Centre four weeks to file replies, counter affidavit

A five-judge constitutional bench of the Supreme Court on Tuesday adjourned to 14 November the hearing of petitions challenging the abrogation of provisions of Article 370, which gave special status to Jammu and Kashmir. Meanwhile, a three-judge SC bench adjourned the hearing of petitions challenging the restrictions imposed following the Centre's move to 16 October.

The five-judge bench, headed by Justice N.V. Ramana, and comprising Justices S.K. Kaul, R. Subhash Reddy, B.R. Gawai, and Surya Kant, heard several pleas challenging the Centre's 5 August decision to revoke J&K's special status, and bifurcate the state into the Union territories (UTs) of Jammu and Kashmir, and Ladakh. The UTs will come into being on 31 October.

The apex court has given the Centre four weeks to file its replies.

The constitutional bench said no fresh petition will be entertained to challenge the constitutional validity of the abrogation of Article 370 by the central government.

Attorney general K.K. Venugopal, appearing for the government, said there were 10 petitions and related averments for which time was required to submit counter affidavits. Venugopal and solicitor general Tushar Mehta, appearing for the state of Jammu and Kashmir, sought four weeks to file replies to all petitions.

The bench agreed that sufficient time should be given to the Centre and the state to file their replies.

The petitions were filed by the National Conference and the Sajjad Lone-led JK People's Conference, besides several others. The petitioners sought directions declaring the presidential orders of 5

August "unconstitutional, void and inoperative". A petition filed by Lok Sabha MPs Mohammad Akbar Lone and Justice (Retd) Hasnain Masoodi wants the court to examine whether the Union government can "unilaterally" unravel the unique federal scheme, which it argued, was done "under the cover" of President's rule,

of an individual and national security."

The bunch of petitions relates to curbs on the media and communication, and movement of individuals, alleged violation of child and minors rights, illegal detention of children, and restoration of landlines and medical facilities in the valley. Several petitioners, including Kashmir Times executive editor, Anuradha Bhasin, activist Tehseen Poonawala, and the Foundation of Media Professionals, through its president Paranjay Guha Thakurta, claimed that there was a complete lockdown of communication networks, as

well as restrictions on movement of journalists.

The counsels for the Centre argued that restrictions on mobile operations and internet cannot be lifted as of now because there was a grave threat of fake messages coming from across the border through social media platforms.

Global merchandise trade volume is estimated to grow by only 1.2% in 2019 due to mounting trade tensions and a slowing world economy, World Trade Organization (WTO) economists said on Tuesday. In April, the economists had pegged volume growth for 2019 at 2.6%—down from 3.0% in 2018.

The projected sharp fall in international trade is largely attributed to US trade wars against China and other countries.

The WTO said several downside risks continued to remain high and the "2020 projection depends on a return to more normal trade relations."

WTO director-general Roberto Azevedo said: "The darkening outlook for trade is discouraging but not unexpected," adding that "beyond their direct effects, trade conflicts heighten uncertainty, which is leading some businesses to delay the productivity-enhancing investments that are essential to raising living standards."

"Job creation may also be ham-

pered as firms employ fewer workers to produce goods and services for export. Resolving trade disagreements would allow WTO members to avoid such costs," he added.

The WTO's highest adjudicating body for global trade disputes is set to become non-functional from 11 December due to a continued obstructive position adopted by the US. However, Azevedo said: "The multilateral trading system remains the most important global forum for settling differences and providing solutions for the challenges of the 21st century global economy."

Azevedo did not mention the current impasse created by the US, which has blocked the selection of six judges to the WTO's dispute settlement platform, the Appellate Body. "Members should work together in a spirit of cooperation to reform the WTO and make it even stronger and more effective," he said.

A WTO release said: "Slowing economic growth is partly due to rising trade tensions, but also reflects country-specific cyclical and structural factors, including the shifting monetary policy stance in developed economies and Brexit-related uncertainty in the European Union. Macroeconomic risks are firmly tilted to the downside."

WTO economists said "due to the high degree of uncertainty associated with trade forecasts under current conditions, the estimated growth rate for world trade in 2019 is placed within a range of 0.5% to 1.6%."

Trade growth could fall below this range if trade tensions continue to build, or outperform it if they start to recede."

The range of likely values is wider for 2020, ranging from 1.7% to 3.7%, with better outcomes depending on an easing of trade tensions.

No infiltrator will be allowed to stay in India: Shah

Union home minister Amit Shah on Tuesday vowed to build a National Register of Citizens in West Bengal, preceded by a citizenship bill to protect Hindu, Sikh, Jain, and Christian refugees.

The bill is pivotal to India's internal security and no "infiltrator" would be allowed to

stay in the country, Shah said in Kolkata.

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leader's stress on an NRC in the border state comes ahead of the 2021 Assembly elections in the state, in which the party hopes to make deep inroads. The BJP had won 18 out of 42 seats in

West Bengal in the recently concluded Lok Sabha elections. A fortnight ago, state chief minister and Trinamool Congress (TMC) chief Mamata Banerjee had expressed her misgivings about the NRC plan to Shah.

"All of Bengal is being misled. Mamata didi is saying that if NRC is brought

here, Hindus will have to leave West Bengal. This is the biggest lie. I assure all of Bengal that all people, especially our Hindu brothers, Jains, Christians, and Buddhists, will not be thrown out by the Indian government," Shah said.

"Before NRC, we will bring the citizenship bill. This means within India, all Hindus, Sikhs, Jains, and Christians who have sought refuge will be given Indian citizenship," Shah said.
