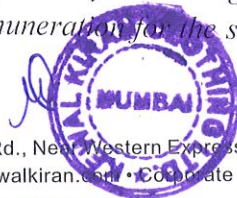
Kewal Kiran Clothing Limited had on August 13, 2022 emailed to the members of the company the Notice dated May 11, 2022 (AGM notice) for convening the 31th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Company on Tuesday, September 6, 2022 through Video Conferencing or other OAVM mode. We inadvertently missed out on a disclosure in the Notice of 31st AGM of the Company in Item No 3 and 4 of Clause no. 31 of the Notes to the said notice appearing on page no. 9. We have on August 25, 2022 emailed an addendum to the AGM notice to the members of the company. The said addendum is reproduced below:

ADDENDUM TO THE NOTICE OF 31ST ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The notice of the 31st Annual General Meeting of Kewal Kiran Clothing Limited scheduled to be held on Tuesday, September 6, 2022 at 12 Noon through Video Conferencing ("VC") / Other Audio Visual Means ("OAVM") was emailed to the shareholders on 13th August 2022.

In Clause no. 31 of the Notes to the said notice appearing on page no. 9, the detailed bellow matter shall be appended below the existing paragraph of Item No. 3 and 4:

The Board of Directors of the Company at their meeting held on 11th May 2022, on the recommendation of the Audit Committee, have recommended the appointment of M/s. Jain and Trivedi as the Statutory Auditors of the Company and M/s. N. A. Shah Associates LLP as the Joint Statutory Auditors of the Company to hold office for a period of five (5) years from the conclusion of this Annual General Meeting till the conclusion of the Thirty Sixth (36th) Annual General Meeting of the Company to be held in the year 2027, at an annual remuneration of Rs. 15,00,000/- and Rs. 25,00,000/- respectively for the year ending 31st March 2023, plus out of pocket expenses and applicable taxes. The remuneration for the subsequent year(s) of their term

shall be determined based on the recommendation of the Audit Committee and as mutually agreed between the Board of Directors of the Company and the Auditors. There is an increase by an amount of Rs. 13,00,000/- in the aggregate remuneration proposed to be paid to M/s. Jain and Trivedi and M/s. N.A. Shah Associates LLP for the statutory audit to be conducted for the year ended 31st March 2023 over the remuneration paid to M/s. Khimji Kunverji & Co. LLP, the retiring Statutory Auditors, for the statutory audit conducted for the year ended 31st March 2022.

After evaluating all proposals and considering various factors such as independence, industry experience, technical skills, geographical presence, audit team, audit quality reports, etc., M/s. Jain and Trivedi and M/s. N.A. Shah Associates LLP have respectively been recommended to be appointed as the Statutory Auditors and the Joint Statutory Auditors of the Company.

M/s. Jain and Trivedi and M/s. N.A. Shah Associates LLP, are firms of Chartered Accountants registered with the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. M/s. Jain and Trivedi is primarily engaged in providing audit and taxation services to its clients. M/s. N.A. Shah Associates LLP is primarily engaged in providing audit, taxation and consultancy services to its clients.

Pursuant to Section 139 of the Companies Act, 2013 and the rules framed thereunder, the Company has received written consent respectively from M/s. Jain and Trivedi and M/s. N.A. Shah Associates LLP, and certificate that they satisfy the criteria provided under Section 141 of the Companies Act, 2013 and that the appointment, if made, shall be in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Act and rules framed thereunder. As required under the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, M/s. Jain and Trivedi and M/s. N.A. Shah Associates LLP, have respectively confirmed that they hold a valid certificate issued by the Peer Review Board of ICAI.

None of the Directors and Key Managerial Personnel of the Company and their relatives are concerned or interested, financially or otherwise, in the resolution set out at Item No. 3 and 4 of the Notice of the 31st AGM. Accordingly, the Board of Directors recommends aforesaid appointments to the members for their approval by way of an Ordinary Resolution as set out at Item No. 3 and 4 of the Notice of the 31st AGM.

The addendum may be read in continuation of and in conjunction with AGM Notice. All concerned are requested to take note of the above. All other matters of the AGM notice remain unchanged.

A copy of the of the rectified notice is also attached herewith. May we request the exchange to kindly upload the attached rectified notice on the website of the exchange for benefit of all concerned.

1. Pursuant to General Circular No 2/ 2022 dated May 5, 2022 read with Circular No. 20/ 2020 dated May 5, 2020 issued by Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA Circulars") and Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/ CIR/P/2022/62 dated May 13, 2022 read with SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2021/697 dated December 22, 2021 issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI Circular") and in compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") and the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI Listing Regulations"), the 31st AGM of the company is being conducted through means of VC/OAVM Facility, which does not require physical presence of Members at a common venue. The deemed venue of 31st AGM shall be the Registered Office of the company.
 2. Pursuant to the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 a Member entitled to attend and vote at the AGM is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote on his / her behalf and the proxy need not be a Member of the Company. In terms of MCA circulars since the physical attendance of Members has been dispensed with, there is no requirement of appointment of proxies. Accordingly, the facility of appointment of proxies by Members under Section 105 of the Act will not be available for the 31st AGM and hence the Proxy Form and Attendance Slip are not annexed to the Notice. However the body corporates are entitled to appoint authorised representatives as members to attend the AGM through VC/OAVM and participate thereat and cast their vote through e-voting.
 3. Institutional/Corporate Shareholders (i.e. other than individuals/HUF, NRI, etc) are required to send a scanned copy (PDF/JPEG Format) of its Board Resolution or governing body Resolution/ Authorisation etc., authorising its representative to attend the Annual General Meeting through VC/OAVM on its behalf and to vote through remote e-voting.  4. The attendance of the Members participating in the 31st AGM through VC/OAVM facility shall be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under section 103 of the Act.
 5. Voting rights shall be reckoned on the paidup capital value of shares registered in the name of member/ beneficial owners (in case of electronic shareholding) as on the cut-off date i.e Tuesday, August 30, 2022.
 6. In line with MCA circular No. 2/ 2022 dated May 5, 2022 and Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/ CIR/P/2022/62 dated May 13, 2022 the Annual Report for the year 2021-22 including the Notice of the 31st AGM of the company, inter alia, indicating the process and manner of E-voting is being sent only by Email, to all the Members whose Email IDs are registered with the Company/Registrar and Share Transfer Agent or with the respective Depository Participant(s) for communication purposes to the members and to all other persons so entitled. Further in terms of the applicable provisions of the Act, SEBI Listing regulations read with the circulars issued by MCA and SEBI, the Annual report along with the Notice of the 31st AGM will be available on the website of the company at www.kewalkiran.com. The same can also be accessed from the websites of the stock exchanges i.e. BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com and National Stock Exchanges of India Limited at www.nseindia.com and on the website of Link Intime India Private Limited at <https://instavote.linkintime.co.in>.
 7. Since there is no special business, statement pursuant to Section 102(1) of the Companies Act 2013, is not annexed hereto.
 8. To conserve capital your Board of Directors thought it prudent to not recommend any Final dividend for the financial year ended March 31, 2022.
 9. The Register of Members and the Share Transfer Books of the Company will remain closed from Wednesday, August 31, 2022 to Tuesday, September 6, 2022 (both days inclusive).
- Unclaimed Dividend**
10. Under Section 124 of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Investor Education and Protection Fund Authority (Accounting, Audit, Transfer and Refund) Rules, 2016 ('IEPF Rules, 2016'), the amount of dividend remaining unpaid or unclaimed for a period of seven years from the due date is required to be transferred to the Investor Education and Protection Fund (IEPF), constituted by the Central Government. The Company had during the year, accordingly, transferred to IEPF, the unpaid and unclaimed dividend amounts pertaining to 3rd interim 2013-14 of ₹ 9225/-, Final Dividend 2013-14 of ₹ 4,998/-, 1st Interim Dividend 2014-15 of ₹ 22,224/- 2nd Interim Dividend 2014-15 of ₹ 15,923/-, 3rd Interim Dividend 2014-15 of ₹ 12,215/- to the IEPF. Dividend declared by the Company thereafter, is still lying in the respective unpaid dividend accounts of the Company.
