When there were no takers for an invitation to join in an innovative fishing project in his native village, he ventured to bring capital, which opened a new world of livelihood for thousands and this laid the foundation for "**KINGS**" in the year 1958. It was this mindset and his ardent desire to improve the living standards of his community that prompted him to establish Kings as an innovative fishing company.

Baby John never allowed his dreams to get washed ashore by tides of time. He kept track of the corporate game, introducing new ideas, and of course, products. While renewing himself constantly, he was not daunted by short term goals.

BabyJohn's long legislative career began in the early 1950s when he was elected to the Travancore-Cochin assembly. For nearly four decades, Baby John was Chavara's trusted voice in the Kerala Legislative Assembly. An able and astute administrator, he served many terms as a Minister in the Government of Kerala, handling key portfolios such as Revenue, Education, Labour, Irrigation, Cooperation, and Excise earning him a reputation for unparalleled administrative skill.

All who knew him, knew him as the ultimate man to resolve conflicts. It was always Baby John who found a way towards coalescence and cooperation. In essence, a quintessential peacemaker.
