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INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM STANDALONE FINANCIAL RESULTS TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF IFB INDUSTRIES LIMITED

- We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Standalone Unaudited Financial Results of **IFB INDUSTRIES LIMITED** ("the Company"), for the quarter ended 30 June 2024 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("the Listing Regulations").
- 2.
