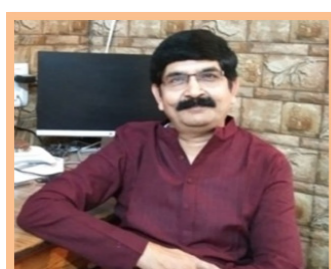

Child should always be taught discipline without tears

One would find that in the present day in schools the children are oriented in a defined way of learning where the teacher imparted a systematized way of education through which children acquire some general and professional skills etc. But the home learning has tended to orient itself to goals which are of fundamental importance to a community where in social change the children marks the crux of its further development in their life. Normally our schools are closed for summer vacation when the children are not demanded to take part in economic activities. It is necessary that the schools

timings have to be adjusted to the needs of the community, depending on the locality etc. It is also found that majority of parents particularly in the rural areas send their children to school till they are grown up and capable of taking up economically gainful activities and the percentage of dropouts is significantly much higher among girls than for the boys.

The Supreme Court has held that the right to education is a fundamental right under Article 21 of the Constitution and that the state is obliged to provide education to children at the primary level. Good education is not only desirable in itself but is also essential for the empowerment of our people. Education should be viewed as a basic human right leading to empowerment and awareness. The politicization of education poses a serious threat to society. It is necessary for the authorities to investigate whether reservation has genuinely helped the backward sections of society. The government should address this problem on an urgent basis and take a

holistic approach to it. Granting everyone the right to education is not enough in itself. It is the duty of the State to ensure proper implementation of this law in every section of the society. The 25 per cent reservation for poor kids is a terrible insult to the majority of India's children. It is like the 'two-tumbler' system that prevails in many villages. The government should take effective steps to provide sound education to students from the backward classes rather than just creating quotas. What is more important is to ensure that proper facilities are provided in schools and the best teachers recruited to teach children in their formative years. Right to education will remain a dream unless sincere efforts are made to create the necessary infrastructure.

Today one would clearly find that the child is by no means a helpless victim of parents and teachers who are active agents of change in their life. The conflict between the child and the adult is not confined to home. Today the child insists on doing something whose consequences the teacher or parents in his mature wisdom thinks will be unpleasant where the parents prevent their child to do so but it must be remembered that sometimes-unpleasant consequences also remove the illusion which the child may have nurtured about his ability whose outcome is defiance. It is also found that parents and teachers praise the child sky high for every achievement but over praise makes the child an addict like an alcoholic and he never wants to do anything if praise does not come and he is not ready to listen critics of his performance. As the child grows up, he should be allowed to become independent and should be allowed to make mistakes so that he can learn from them. There are many parents who are too sensitive about what people will think of their children. Ahmedabad, After the uproar across the state over the celebrity scandal, the government has filed a police complaint against five people including the hospital's doctor and director. Danta, Banaskantha You must know that in the year 1947, when it came to the merger of princely states, Bhavnagar king Krishnakumarsingh ji was the first to give up Rajpat and named 1800 padars to India, but do you know which princely state from Gujarat merged with India last? For the merger of which the king was immediately changed.
Nestled amidst the picturesque Aravalli mountain ranges, this kingdom was then known as the Danta State. Danta is considered a smaller kingdom than the states like Bhavnagar, Vadodara, Jamnagar at that time, but it was so powerful that even the Mughals sitting in Delhi took note of every activity that took place here, which you can estimate from the fact that when Shahzada was against the Mughal emperor Akbar. After Salim

(Jahangir) rebelled, no state was willing to give refuge to Salim. Then the ruler of Danta not only surrendered, but also showed strength against the Sultan of Delhi. When Salim came to power, the king of Danta was given the title of 'Sharanagat Sadhar'.
Read about Danta State in today's episode of Divya Bhaskar's special series 'Rajpat'. Apart from Rajasthan, it has a special relationship with the royal families of Dehradun, Jammu and Puri (Odisha). Not only this, a 900-year-old mythological idol of Ambaji is also preserved with this family. The descendant of the king named Vikramaditya in whose name the Vikram Samvat began is the ruler of Danta.
Traditionally, Riddhiraj Singh is currently sitting on the throne as the royal of Danta State. Riddhiraj Singh was enthroned in August 2023 after his father Maharana Mahipendrasinhji passed away last year.
Riddhiraj Singh's family consists of his mother Chandrakumari, wife Divya Jyotikumari and son Brijraj Singh.
Talking about the history of Danta's royal family, Riddhiraj Singh said, the area of ??North Gujarat was ruled

by the Solanki dynasty many years ago, which had Siddharaj Jai Singh, Nayikadevi etc.
In this period, the invasions of Mohammad Ghori, Mohammad Ghazni, Alauddin Khilji started increasing. So the younger brother from Sindh was demanded as dowry. He settled in a town called Chandravati. After that he supported Naikadevi and defeated Mohammad Ghori. He was a Parmar general. He was attained to Virgati. The entire Solanki kingdom had fallen when Muhammad Ghori came back and wreaked havoc. We were defeated.
Riddhiraj Singh said, Jashraj Parmar came to power after a few years. He renovated the Ambaji temple. There is a legend that Mataji used to walk behind the king. Then his chariot got stuck at Gabbar, so he decided to build his capital here. Even today, Mataji's footsteps are on the Gabbar and the Yantra is in the Ambaji temple. While Chalit Murthy has come with us to Ujjain, Bhopal, Sindh, Chandravati, Tarsang and Danta. Even today that idol is in our Amba palace. This place was closed to general public. But it has been opened for fifteen years. So people can

have darshan.
Danta was a hunting hub. Because the area of ??Danta State had the highest number of tigers, leopards and leopards. Leopards and bears still exist in the area.
During the monarchy the forest area was divided into different zones with the king providing assistance if wild animals preyed on domestic animals . In which one's cow is left in the core zone and the owner of the cow has to pay a fine if a leopard or a tiger hunts it. But if a domestic animal went into the buffer zone and was hunted by a wild animal, it was subsidized from the Danta State treasury at half the cost of the animal. Also, if a leopard or a tiger hunted a domestic animal in the outer zone, the help was twice the price. Such were the rules.
At that time hunting was done according to zone in the forest area, hunting was done mainly in the outer zone by the local king. When a foreign guest or a king of another state came to the core zone, hunting took place.
