TRP GAME ZONE FIRE RMC panel nod to prosecute ex-town planner, chief fire officer

TWO WEEKS after the police filed a chargesheet against former Rajkot chief fire officer Ilesh Kher and town planner M D Sagathiya for their alleged involvement in the TRP Game Zone fire case, the standing committee of the Rajkot Municipal Corporation (RMC) on Tuesday approved a proposal granting sanction to initiate criminal proceedings against the two suspended officers.

The standing committee green signal comes a day after Kher's successor Anil Maru was arrested by Anti-Corruption Bureau for allegedly taking Rs 1.8 lakh bribe from a private contractor to provide fire safety clearance to a building in Rajkot.

Standing Committee chairman Jaimin Thakar said, "We had received a letter from the state home department recently, directing us that these two officers have to be prosecuted in the TRP Game Zone fire case and that necessary sanction may be given at the earliest. Accordingly, the standing committee discussed the proposal sent by the municipal commissioner and approved the same."

After the approval of the standing committee, the proposal granting sanction to prosecute Kher and Sagathiya — both Class II officers — will be referred to the RMC general board for its ratification.

A massive fire had broken out in a shed housing indoor gaming facilities at TRP Game Zone on May 25, killing 27 people. The special investigation team of Rajkot City Police had charged Sagathiya and Kher — both currently in jail — for their alleged acts of omission leading to the fire.

As per the SIT, they were aware that a giant shed in the amusement park didn't have fire safety clearance and required

approvals from the RMC town planning department but neither took any action against the park. The SIT alleged that Kher was also aware about a fire having broken out at TRP Game Zone on September 4, 2023 but took no action.

Existing rules bar a court from taking cognizance of chargesheet against government servants without prior sanction from competent authority to prosecute such servants. In case of the RMC, the powers to give sanction for prosecution of its Class II officers are vested in its 72-member general board — the highest decision-making body of the civic body.

The municipal commissioner is authorised to give sanction to prosecute Class II, III and IV employees. Thakar said the commissioner has already granted sanction to prosecute six Class II and III RMC employees, who have also been charged in the case.

The proposal forwarded to standing committee by the office of Municipal Commissioner Devang Desai referred to a letter sent by ACP (Crime) Bharat Basiya on July 18, seeking sanction of the RMC to prosecute Sagathiya and Kher.

"As stated in the letter, the two officers are public servants attached to the Rajkot Municipal Corporation and sanction has been sought before filing chargesheet and initiating criminal proceedings against them under Section 197 of CrPC," the proposal stated. Basiya was the investigating officer of the case in which 15 people were arrested and subsequently charged.

New fire chief sent to 3-day ACB custody in bribery case

Arrested for taking Rs 1.8-lakh bribe to provide fire safety clearance to building

A LOCAL court remanded Rajkot in charge chief fire officer (CFO), Anil Maru, who was arrested for allegedly taking Rs 1.8 lakh bribe, in three-day custody of the Gujarat Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) Tuesday.

ACB produced the 39-year-old officer in a Rajkot court to seek his remand.

"The police granted our plea and gave us Maru's custody till August 16," ACB police inspector Prakash Dekavadiya, who is the investigating officer in the case, told *The Indian Express*.

Maru was arrested late on Monday based on a complaint after he allegedly demanded and accepted Rs 1.8 lakh bribe from a private contractor in the business of installing fire-fighting equipment. After installing fire-fighting systems in five residential towers, the contractor had approached Maru on behalf of the builders to obtain a no-objection certificate or fire-safety clearance.

According to ACB officials, Maru had demanded Rs 5 lakh for granting the clearance certificate but settled for Rs 3 lakh after negotiations.

The contractor paid Rs 1.2 lakh to Maru around a week ago, but complained to the ACB as he did not want to bribe the officer.

The ACB laid a trap at Maru's office in the headquarters of the Rajkot Municipal Corporation (RMC) and detained him as soon as he accepted Rs 1.8 lakh in cash from the contractor.

Notably, Maru was caught "red-handed" by the ACB exactly three years after his elder brother Amrut Marvada and

Amrut's wife Kanku Marvada, the award-winning Sarpanch of Kutch's Kukma village, were arrested by the bureau for allegedly demanding and accepting Rs 5 lakh bribe from a mining firm on August 13, 2021 for allowing it to construct a shed.

"The ACB has filed a charge sheet in the case against Amrut and Kanku, but the trial is yet to start," said a senior ACB officer.

Incidentally, Kanku was detained by the ACB hours after she shared the stage with top state government officials at an event that was virtually addressed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Grant domicile certificate to aspiring medical student: HC to Rajkot dist admn

THE GUJARAT High Court on August 9 ordered the Rajkot district administration to issue a domicile certificate to an aspiring medical student — seeking admission in state quota that mandates a continuous 10-year stay in Gujarat — stating that the concept of one's domicile means "a place where a person has his actual residence".

The high court stated this while hearing the plea of Vishwa Ramoliya, a resident of Rajkot's Upleta. Earlier this year, Ramoliya's application for domicile certificate was rejected by Rajkot district's mamlatdar stating that she was born and lived in Karnataka with her parents until 2019 and thus was not eligible for the state quota.

Considering the August 13 deadline to apply for the medical admission in the state quota, Justice Sangeta Vishen directed the Rajkot authorities "to act upon the petitioner's application and issue the requisite domicile certificate before August 13, 2024, without any further delay."

Ruling in petitioner's favour, the court said, "...the concept of one's domicile has a definite implication and is directly linked with the place where a person lives or has his home. It is a place where a person has his actual residence, inhabitancy or comorbancy. It has been held and observed that residence need not be continuous but it must be indefinite not purely fleeting."

boarding student and returns to the state of his permanent residence and also pursues further education of Standard-IX to XII, then in such circumstances the period for which he remained outside Gujarat cannot be excluded while computing minimum continuous stay of ten years in Gujarat."

The court considered the "voluminous documents" that backed the arguments of Ramoliya's counsel that it was only in 2004 that the petitioner's father shifted to Karnataka and the petitioner was born there. The family had shifted to Gujarat in 2019 and Ramoliya completed her studies from Class VIII to XII in Gujarat. The court also considered records of birth of Ramoliya's grandparents, parents as well as school leaving certificates of her parents, all belonging to Rajkot district, along with details of the immovable properties owned by the family and her parents in the district. Ramoliya's counsel also placed on record that the petitioner's Aadhaar card was also issued in Gujarat with the permanent address stated as Rajkot.

The court said, "Intention is writ large of the parents of the petitioner to settle in Gujarat. Also, voluminous documents, placed on record, clearly suggest that the root of the petitioner and her family continued to be in Gujarat..."
