- The above Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results of the Company for the Quarter ended on June 30, 2024 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors in the Meeting held on July 20, 2024. The Statutory Auditors have conducted Limited Review of these results in terms of Regulation 33 of the Securities Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosures Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- The Consolidated Financial Results for the quarter ended June 30, 2024 include the following entities of the group:
 - i) The Consolidated results of the Company include unaudited results of the subsidiaries - Arihant Futures and Commodities Limited (100%), Arihant Financial Services Limited (100%), Arihant Insurance Broking Services Limited (100%), Arihant Capital (IFSC) Limited (100%)
 - ii) The Management certified the financial results of associate, Electrum Capital Private Limited (27.23%), in India. The financial result of Electrum Capital Private Limited does not constitute a material component of the consolidated financial results and these have been consolidated as associate, under equity method of accounting as per Indian Accounting standard.
- The figures for the quarter ended March 31, 2024 represents the balance between audited financial in respect of the full financial year and those published till the third quarter of the respective financial years.
- Previous period / year figures have been regrouped / reclassified, wherever found necessary, to conform to current period / year classification.
- The Company has sold entire shareholding of its wholly owned subsidiary Arihant Institute of Financial Education Private Limited on July 31, 2023 for a total consideration of ₹ 58.75 Lacs. The Consolidated Result for year ended FY 2023-24 include the profit/ (loss) figures of the subsidiary for the period.
- During the quarter ended June 30, 2024, the Board approved the divestment of its 100% equity stake in its wholly owned subsidiary, Arihant Insurance Broking Services Limited through an agreement dated June 21, 2024, for a total consideration of USD 400,000, plus the value of any cash available with the business. This transaction is subject to approval from the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI). This investment does not constitute a major component of the company and, therefore, is not classified as discontinued operations.

OLD RHETORICS | Mocks Biden, Pelosi in first rally since assassination attempt 'I took a bullet for democracy'

Former US president Donald Trump in his first campaign rally since surviving an assassination attempt has dismissed concerns raised by critics that he is a threat to democracy, telling a large crowd in Michigan that he "took a bullet for democracy".



Trump also spoke about Project 2025, which the opposition claim is a threat to democracy

"They (Democrats) keep saying 'he's a threat to democracy. I'm saying, 'What the hell did I do to democracy?' Last week I took a bullet for democracy," Trump said, referencing an often-used Democrat talking point. "What did I

do against democracy? Crazy," Trump, 78, said amidst applause from thousands of his supporters. The former President also spoke about Project 2025, which his rivals and the opposition Democratic Party claim is an initiative that

threatens democracy. "I don't want to know anything about it. But what they do is misinformation and disinformation," he said, as he distanced himself from it. In rhetoric that departed from his calls for unity immediately after the shooting, he returned to his usual campaign tactics -- using insulting and sometimes offensive language to attack his opponents, and repeating a string of false claims about immigration, the economy and election fraud, were major elements of his speech on Saturday. Trump, who wore a bandage on his ear, frequently mocked Democratic President Joe Biden as "feeble". He derided senior Democrats, including Pelosi, for trying to persuade Biden to end his reelection bid. Trump attacked Democrats, saying they wanted to kick Biden off the ticket after he won their presidential nominating contest. "They have a couple of problems. No. 1, they have no idea who their candidate is," Trump said to laughter and jeers. "This guy goes and he gets the votes and now they want to take it away." Referring to Pelosi, Trump said: "She's turned on him like a dog. She's as crazy as a bed bug." Pelosi's office did not immediately return a request for comment. There was a heavy police presence at Trump's rally in Grand Rapids on Saturday, with police on every street corner for several blocks. US Secret Service officers were positioned on the top balconies in the Van Andel Arena, giving them a bird's eye view of the crowd inside.

Pelosi avoids 'Biden future' in speech to N Carolina Dems

In a state expected to help decide the presidency, House Speaker Emerita Nancy Pelosi did little to quell speculation on President Joe Biden's path forward as the Democratic nominee to a roomfull of North Carolina Democrats on Saturday.

Pelosi addressed more than 900 people at the North Carolina Democratic Party fundraiser in Raleigh - an event billed as the annual "Unity Dinner" during a time of significant national discord over how the party will proceed in the 2024 presidential election. All eyes are on Democratic leaders like Pelosi, who colleagues say, has her finger on the party's pulse, to get a glimpse of what Biden's future holds. The power she holds in the Democratic Party - and in the direction the party takes - was no better emphasized than in her introduction by US Representative Alma Adams, D-N.C. "When Nancy Pelosi speaks, everybody listens," Adams said. And with everybody listening, Pelosi gave a speech largely absent of mentions to Biden's presidential bid. Pelosi spent most of her speech recounting battles over budget and policy in the US House. When she did mention Biden, it was mostly to tout his administration's policies. At the end of her speech, Pelosi shifted to discussing the party's plans in the coming months and chose to focus on Democratic mobilization efforts rather than who to mobilize behind. "Are you ready for a Democratic president?" Pelosi said amid cheers. "I thought so." Since Biden's dismal showing in the June 27 debate with former Republican President Donald Trump, significant fallout has ensued within the Democratic Party on whether the President is capable of defeating Trump. The former speaker is among a growing group of prominent Democratic leaders who have expressed concerns behind closed doors on Biden's ability to win in November.

Beautiful note from Xi but will be tough if elected: Don

Former US president Donald Trump has said that Chinese President Xi Jinping wrote him a beautiful note after he suffered a gunshot wound to his ear during an assassination attempt. Speaking at an election rally on Saturday in Grand Rapids, Trump, 78, said, "I got along very well with President Xi, who's a great guy. He wrote me a beautiful note the other day when he heard about what happened. He added that he received such notes from other leaders as well. Trump has long boasted of having a warm relationship with Xi. In 2020, while serving as President, Trump said that he and the Chinese president "love each other" despite accusing the country of en-

gaging in "predatory practices" in its trade relationship with the US. As president, Trump imposed tariffs on Chinese exports and sharply criticized the country for its handling of the coronavirus pandemic. Trump said that he would be tough on China. "I took on China like no administration in history, bringing hundreds of billions of dollars pouring into our treasury when no other president had gotten 10 cents. China never gave us 10 cents," he said. Trump described Xi as a brilliant man who controls 1.4 billion people with an iron fist. "He is a fierce person," he said. "When I'm back in the White House... we will build American, buy American. We're going to hire an American. We're going to get the auto industry back," he said.

Nepal's new PM Oli wins trust vote

Nepal Prime Minister K P Sharma Oli won a crucial floor test in Parliament on Sunday with more than two-thirds of lawmakers voting in his favour, nearly a week after he was sworn in to lead a coalition government in the politically unstable Himalayan nation. Oli secured 188 votes in favour of the vote of confidence motion tabled by him, while 74 votes were cast against. Out of a total of 263 members of the House of Representatives who were present, one member abstained. Oli, 72, required 138 votes to pass the floor test in the lower house of Parliament. "I declare that the motion of the vote of confidence tabled by Prime Minister Oli has been endorsed with a majority," announced Speaker Devraj Ghimire after the counting of votes. According to Nepal's Constitution, Oli needed to secure a vote of confidence

from Parliament within 30 days of appointment. He was sworn in on Monday as Nepal's Prime Minister for a fourth time. Earlier while tabling the motion seeking a vote of confidence in his government, Oli made public the content of the seven-point agreement reached between the Nepali Congress and the CPN-UML earlier this month. Oli said the agreement between the two parties was part of the two largest parties' efforts to address pressing issues. "We [the two parties] compete in our ideologies, but there are instances of collaboration between the Congress and the UML," he said. "This is a continuation of that collaboration. We have agreed to work together to protect national interests, control corruption, improve governance, expedite development activities, and ensure political stability, in accordance with the public desire," Oli said. Oli said his government will neither tolerate corruption nor let it happen. He said the government will move forward for good governance. House of Representatives members belonging to the ruling alliance Nepali Congress, CPN-UML, Lokatantrik Samajwadi Party and Janata Samajwadi Party Nepal were among those who voted in favour of Oli's motion.

Indian-American leader backs Biden

President Joe Biden and Vice-President Kamala Harris represent the path forward for America, a prominent Indian-American community leader has said, as he asked Democrats to rally behind them to defeat their rival Donald Trump's destructive and regressive agenda.

The remarks by Ajay Jain Bhutoria, a supporter of Biden and a member of the White House Advisory Council on Asian Americans, came amidst reports of internal divisions in the ruling Democratic Party over Biden's presidential nomination.

Many Democrats at the highest levels want Biden to bow out of the 2024 election to make way for a new nominee and try to prevent widespread party losses in the November presidential election. "We're not just campaigning against an opponent; we're fighting for the soul of our nation. President Biden is our candidate because he stands for the values and progress that benefit all Americans," Bhutoria said on Saturday.

Bhutoria said Biden and Kamala Harris represent the "path forward" for America, while Donald Trump and J D Vance, threaten to reverse progress and impose a regressive agenda. "All Democrats, including elected officials at every level, members of Congress, and the Senate, must channel their energy into highlighting the stark differences between President Biden's record of achievement and the destructive agenda outlined in Trump's Project 2025," said Bhutoria, who was the only Indian-American to be present at the presidential launch rally of Biden in Pennsylvania in 2019, he said.
