The Board of Directors of the Company has appointed Mr. Tapan Shah, Practising Company Secretary (Membership No.: FCS 4476: COP No.: 2839), as Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot through remote e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner who had communicated his willingness to be appointed for the said purpose. The Company has engaged the services of Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL") as the agency to provide e-voting facility enabling the members to cast their votes electronically in a secure manner.

During this period, Members of the Company holding shares either in physical or dematerialised form as on the Cut-off date, i.e. Friday, 10 January 2025 (including those Members who may not have received this Notice due to non-registration of their e-mail address with the Company or the Depositories / Depository Participants), may cast their vote electronically, in respect of the resolution as set out in this Notice only through the remote e-voting. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- 2) During the remote e-voting period, Members can login at CDSL e-voting platform any number of times till they have voted on the resolution. Once the vote on resolution is cast by a Member, whether partially or otherwise, Member shall not be allowed to change it subsequently or cast the vote again.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

(PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013)

As required by Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("Act"), the following explanatory statement sets out all material facts relating to the business mentioned under Item Nos. 1 of the accompanying Notice:

Item Number 1:
