'Tanker gas gushed out like water from overflowing dam'

Officials said over 25 fire engines were deployed to bring Jaipur tanker crash blaze under control on Friday

CTV footage from the scene captured the scale of explosions at 5.45am, with the flames visible from a distance and the noise waking up people several kilometres away.

Seven of the deceased were identified as Harlal (32), motorcyclist Radheyshyam Choudhary (32), truck driver Shahbuddin (34) of UP's Rae Bareilly; Shahid (34) and Faizan (20) from Udaipur; Mahendra (27) of Makrana; and Anita Meena (28), an armed police constable.

The tanker driver was unaccounted for until evening. Unconfirmed reports said he tried to flee but was unlikely to have made it through the inferno. The seven injured who are on ventilator support at Jaipur's SMS Hospital include Yusuf (45), a Banwarra resident; Vijeta (23); Raju Ram Baberwal (40) of Sikar; and Govind (32) from Kekri.

A witness to the crash said gas "gushed out of the nozzles like water from an overflowing dam". A sleeper bus from Udaipur ferrying 24 passengers went up in flames. A truck filled with cartons of matchboxes caught fire just outside a fuel pump. Another tanker filled with gas broke down. Fire tenders used foam and water to avert an explosion.

Officials said over 25 fire engines were deployed to bring the blaze under control, with teams arriving from Mansarovar, VKI,

Vaishali Nagar, and Bani Park. The fire brigade removed the LPG tanker that exploded from the middle of the road after the flames were doused. The residual gas was transferred to another tanker.

In an official statement on X, Bharat Petroleum condoled the deaths and pledged Rs 6 lakh each to the next of kin of the victims and Rs 2 lakh to the injured.

PM Modi announced ex gratia of Rs 2 lakh and Rs 50,000 for the injured. CM Bhajan Lal Shar-

ma announced assistance of Rs 5 lakh to the families of the deceased and Rs 1 lakh each to the injured.

Transport secretary Shuchi Tyagi directed Jaipur district magistrate to set up a six-member committee to investigate the accident. The Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety, too, wrote to the Rajasthan govt, seeking a report on the accident. The committee also asked for a plan from the state to improve road safety, officials said.

Do not resort to demonstrations or protests at any gate or anywhere within the Parliament premises. Otherwise, the House will take serious action," Birla said amidst sloganeering by opposition MPs. "It is improper to hold any protests or demonstrations at any of Parliament's gates. You must follow the rules in this regard. I urge you once again to take this warning seriously."

Birla adjourned Lok Sabha within three minutes without summarising the session's highlights. Notably, opposition leaders did not attend the traditional tea hosted by the Speaker, resulting in no photo release from the secretariat.

PM Modi, defence minister Rajnath Singh, BJP president J P Nadda, parliamentary affairs minister Kiren Rijiju and leaders from other NDA parties assembled in Birla's chamber after the session was adjourned.

The discord between the treasury and opposition sides was stark, with only one bill — Bharatiya Vayuyam Vidheyak — passed in the first six months of 18th Lok Sabha, marking the lowest legislative output in the last six terms according to

PRS Legislative Research.

The functioning of question hour in the winter session was severely hampered; in Rajya Sabha, it did not function for 15 out of 19 days while in Lok Sabha, it went on for more than 10 minutes on only eight out of 20 days. Also, there was no private members' business in Lok Sabha, and only one resolution was discussed in the upper House.

ONOE panel to file report by 1st day of last week of next session

Sources said govt decided to increase committee's strength to 39 to cover more states and accommodate parties which wished to be part of the exercise to examine the two draft legislations. The two ONOE bills lay down mechanism to hold simultaneous polls and were introduced in LS Tuesday after a fiery debate.

"Govt agreed the matter is very important and relates to reformation of election process, so we agreed to include most of the prominent political parties," parliamentary affairs minister Kiren Rijiju told reporters. He said there was no limit on the size of JPC and pointed out that one parliamentary panel examining Centre-state relations had 51 members. Among the 39 members, 16 are from BJP, five from Congress, two each from SP, TMC and DMK, and one each from Shiv Sena, TDP, JD(U), RLD, LJP (RV), JSP, Shiv Sena (UBT), NCP (SP), CPM, AAP, BJD and YSRCP.

The committee has been asked to submit its report to LS by the first day of the last week of the next session.

Provide 0.5% quota, waive fees of trans students: HC to NLSIU

Bengaluru: Karnataka HC directed National Law School India University (NLSIU) to provide 0.5% reservation in admissions and fee waiver as an interim measure till the institute formulates a policy on quota and financial aid for trans-genders.

The court pointed out that the interim quota was half the reservation provided for trans-genders in employment by state govt. NLSIU may apply to state govt or Centre for appropriate grants to cover the financial aid. Justice Ravi V Hosmani said city-based NLSIU must formulate a reservation policy before admissions for next academic year by implementing directions issued by SC.

HC directed NLSIU to admit petitioner Mugil Anbu Vasanthan under interim reservation for trans-genders, if there was no other candidate who had sought, or taken, admission to three-year LLB course in current academic year. HC said NLSIU takes pride in measures for trans-genders to create a level playing field, but "it has not disclosed whether any steps are in progress, or were taken, for providing reservation and a financial aid specifically tailored for trans-genders".

Murder accused hacked to death near TN court

Madurai: A murder accused, 25, was hacked to death in front of Tirunelveli district court premises in Tamil Nadu on Friday as he was coming to appear in a case. The murderers mutilated the man's face before fleeing. Police and advocates overpowered one assailant while four others were arrested soon after.

Deceased S Mayandi alias Palla Mayandi was one of the main accused in the murder of dalit panchayat ward member N Rajamani, 32, of Keelanatham

panchayat ward member N Rajamani, 32, of Keelanatham on Aug 13 last year. Mayandi was arrested by police within days, and city police slapped Gondas Act on him in Sept 2023. He came out on bail in Jan. On Friday, Mayandi was coming to the district court to appear in a case pending against him when the gang rounded him up.

He evaded them and run towards the court. A special SI tried to stop one of the men wielding sickles but others caught up with Mayandi and hacked him. Condemning the murder, AIADMK general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami, AMMK leader TTV Dinakaran and VK Sasikala accused state govt of failing to maintain law and order.
