UNPARALLELED LEGACY Bevan inducted into Australia's Cricket Hall of Fame 'PICASSO IN PYJAMAS' LEAVES A LASTING LEGACY

ANI MELBOURNE Dubbed one of the world's top limited-over batters, former cricketer Michael Bevan has been elevated to Australia's Cricket Hall of Fame. "One of the best finishers the game has ever seen. Congratulations to former Australian player Michael Bevan on his induction to the Australian Cricket Hall of Fame," Cricket Australia wrote on X.

Australia's Picasso in Pyjamas was an artist in the ODI format. He boasts 6912 runs in 232 matches at an average of 53.58, putting him in the debate for Australia's greatest one-day batters. He was a master in creating moments and memories that are etched in the hearts of cricket fans. During his decorated career, Bevan was a part of Australia's 1999 and 2003 World Cup wins.

"I feel very fortunate. I got to play a sport that I loved... I got to play in some great teams and experience some amazing moments in a really great era of Australian cricket. And it's amazing to be recognised for perhaps some of the unique things that I help bring to Australian cricket, particularly in one-day cricket. It's been a number of years, but I look back on all those things with a lot of pride and a lot of fondness," Bevan said as quoted from cricket.com.au.

Bevan's inclusion comes in the aftermath of Cricket Australia making a change in criteria that allows players to be included for their overall contribution to the game of cricket, whether that is across all formats, or in just one format, available in their era. Bevan represented Australia, New South Wales, Tasmania, South Australia, Yorkshire, Sussex, Leicestershire and Kent. In first-class cricket, he made 207 appearances and garnered 19,147 runs at 57.32, including 68 centuries and 81 fifties, with a top score of 216.

His induction into Australia's Hall of Fame follows this season's previous inductees, Michael Clarke and Christina Matthews.

Travis Head's Stellar Year The 31-year-old batter amassed 1,427 runs across formats, earning 208 votes to secure the Allan Border Medal, beating Josh Hazle-

wood (158 votes) and Pat Cummins (147 votes). Annabel triumph Sutherland claimed her first Belinda Clark Medal with 168 votes, beating Ashleigh Gardner (143) and Beth Mooney (115).

England, who were beaten by India in the second semifinal, have two players selected: Davina Perrin - the tournament's second-highest run-scorer with 176 - and wicket-keeper Katie Jones. Australia's Caoimhe Bray is at number five, with the XI Lanka bowler Chamodi Prabhoda (SL) and Nepal's Nthabiseng Nini (SA).

India players named: G Trisha (India), Jemima Botha (SA), Davina Perrin (Eng), G Kamalini (India), Caoimhe Bray (Aus), Puja Mahato (Nepal), Kayla Reyneke (c) (SA), Katie Jones (wk) (Eng), Anayushi Shukla (India), Chamodi Prabhoda (SL), Vainshavi Sharma (Ind), Nthabiseng Nini (SA).

The team is headed by Sri Lanka bowler Chamodi Prabhoda, who also took nine wickets, including three for 16 against India. The adjudication panel was comprised of commentators Julia Price, HD Ackerman, Raunak Kapoor, and Snehal Pradhan - ICC Manager, Women's Cricket.
