CM agrees to meet with AP CM to address inter-state issues

Hyderabad, July 2 (UNI) : Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy has responded to Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu's proposal to meet in Hyderabad on July 6 to resolve issues between two Telugu states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

CM agrees to meet with AP CM to address inter-state issues

Hyderabad, July 2 (UNI) : Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy has responded to Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu's proposal to meet in Hyderabad on July 6 to resolve issues between two Telugu states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

Revanth Reddy announced that he is ready to solve the problems between the two states. Reddy informed Chandrababu that on behalf of all the people of Telangana and the state government, he is inviting him to a face-to-face meeting at Mahatma Jyotirao Phule Bhavan in

Hyderabad on Saturday afternoon (July 6). "Dear Nara Chandrababu Naidu, I read your letter from the bottom of my heart on Sunday. I sincerely thank you for the kind words addressed to me. I congratulate you on your extraordinary victory in the recently held Assembly and Lok Sabha elections in Andhra Pradesh. I wish you all the best on this occasion," said Reddy in his letter.

"I fully agree to the proposed face-to-face meeting between you and me as Chief Ministers of the two Telugu states. It is indeed imperative to

indeed imperative to resolve all the pending issues related to the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act. Reddy stated that in order to provide better services to the people of both states, a personal meeting between the two parties is necessary in terms of mutual cooperation and sharing of ideas."

Chief Minister Revanth Reddy has called on the Telugu film industry to create awareness about cybercrimes and drug abuse through their movies. The Chief Minister pointed out that while producers frequently approach the government to increase movie ticket prices, they have not made efforts to raise awareness on these critical issues.

Chief Minister Revanth Reddy emphasised that a 3-minute video on drugs and cybercrimes should be shown before or after the movie. He stated that producers, directors, and cast members who fail to comply will not receive any assistance from the government. Cinema theater owners were also asked to cooperate in this initiative. The Chief Minister made it clear that theaters that do not broadcast the videos on drugs and cybercrimes will face consequences.

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Govt committed to curbing cybercrimes: CM

Hyderabad, July 2 (UNI) : Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy has reiterated the state government's commitment to curbing cybercrimes and making Telangana a cyber-safe state, emphasizing the need to deal with cyber crimes with an iron hand.

The Chief Minister chaired an interaction meeting with Law & Order officers of the Tri-Commissionerates of Hyderabad, Cyberabad, and Rachakonda at the Telangana Command & Control Centre (TGCC) in Jubilee Hills on Tuesday. During the meeting, he highlighted that around 10,000 FIRs have been registered in the state this year alone.

Telangana is one of the few states in the country with a fully functional Cyber Security Bureau and a 24/7 operational 1930 call center. The state is among the top in the country in freezing the bank accounts of fraudsters, having frozen almost 263 crores of lost amounts. Additionally, 36,000 SIMs, 8,300 IMEIs, and 2,300 URLs/ Apps have been blocked.

Utilizing state-of-the-art tools and technology, the Telangana Cyber Security Bureau (TGCSB) has linked 671 accused to nearly 77,000 cybercrime cases registered across the country. This information has been shared with the relevant states. Since April 2024, seven new specialized Cyber Crime Police Stations have started functioning in the state. To help the public recover lost money, the refund process has been simplified, resulting in a total refund of Rs 32 crores to 5,191 victims since March 18, 2024.

Every police station in the state now has a trained cyberwarrior to handle cybercrime complaints. The Chief Minister also stated that the government is committed to supporting the Cybercrime Bureau. In the first quarter of the year alone, a budget of Rs 3.75 crores has been sanctioned to the Cyber Bureau.

The Chief Minister flagged off 14 four-wheelers and 55 two-wheelers, which were sanctioned by the government to the Cyber Security Bureau.

Director General of Police Ravi Gupta, Director TGANB Sandeep Shandilya, Director TGCSB Shikha Goel, CP Hyderabad City K Sreenivasa Reddy, CP Cyberabad Avinash Mohanty, CP Rachakonda Tarun Joshi, IGP P&L Ramesh Reddy, and other senior police officers attended the occasion, according to an official statement.

Error in PCS-J answer sheets was due to negligence: claims UP govt

Lucknow, July 2 (UNI) : The issue of marks alteration in the English answer sheets of the PCS-J Main Exam-2022, conducted by the Uttar Pradesh Public Service Commission, was due to human error, out of negligence, rather than any criminal misconduct, official sources claimed here on Tuesday.

Sources said that the human error did not compromise the confidentiality of any candidate. "However, to eliminate the possibility of any other discrepancy or error and to maintain trust among the candidates, the Commission has decided to re-evaluate the answer sheets of all candidates who appeared for the exam," they said.

It may be noted that the UPPSC maintains a unique transparent system of

showing answer sheets to candidates, a practice not even followed by the Union Public Service Commission.

Sources from the Commission said that the inquiry committee formed by the Commission found that in the exam, only one page of the mark sheet bundle for the English language paper (which contains the details of the marks of 25 candidates for the concerned subject) had the candidate-wise code mistakenly pasted on another page of the same mark sheet (which also contains the details of the marks of 25 candidates for the subject).

Due to this, the candidate-wise code of the second page got pasted on the first page, causing the marks of the English language answer sheets of the candidates to get swapped, resulting in

incorrect English language marks.

The Commission has decided that the re-evaluation of the answer sheets will be completed by July 30 and thereafter appropriate action will be taken in the interest of the candidates according to the rules. According to sources, the concerned task was carried out in the highly confidential section under the leadership of the Section Officer, mainly by 3 female personnel who have been doing this work for years and have extensive experience in it.

The main exam had a total of 6 papers with 4 papers of 200 marks each and 2 papers of 100 marks each, making the total 1,000 marks. The question paper in which the error occurred due to human error was of only 100 marks. To prevent such errors in the future, the

Commission is evaluating confidential tasks and instituting reforms.

It may be mentioned here that the final selection result for PCS-J 2022 was declared within six and a half months, with 55 percent of the successful candidates being women.

Due to the error caused by negligence in the exam, a Section Officer, a Review Officer, and an Assistant Review Officer directly responsible for the mistake have been suspended and departmental action is being taken against them.

Departmental action is also being taken against a retired Assistant Review Officer. Disciplinary action is also being taken against a Deputy Secretary for lax supervision and preparations are being made for disciplinary action against the then Exam Controller.

India, Belarus hold consular dialogue, discuss welfare of Indian students

New Delhi, July 2 (UNI) : India and Belarus held the first ever Consular Dialogue on June 28 in Minsk, during which a wide gamut of Consular issues was covered ranging from the welfare of Indian students in Belarus to enhancing tourism between the two countries.

The Indian delegation was led by Aman Puri, JS (CPV), while the Belarusian delegation was led by Andrei Kozhan, Head of General Directorate for Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Belarus.

The visiting Indian delegation also met with senior officials of the Belarusian Ministry of Sports and Tourism as well as representatives of the Indian student community in Belarus. The two sides agreed to follow up on the decisions of the Dialogue and review them at the next edition of the India-Belarus Consular Dialogue which will be held in New Delhi at a mutually convenient date. There are over 900 Indian students in Belarus, a landlocked country in Eastern Europe, bordered by Russia to the East. Most of the Indians are medical students spread across four medical colleges in Minsk, Gomel, Grodno and Vitebsk.

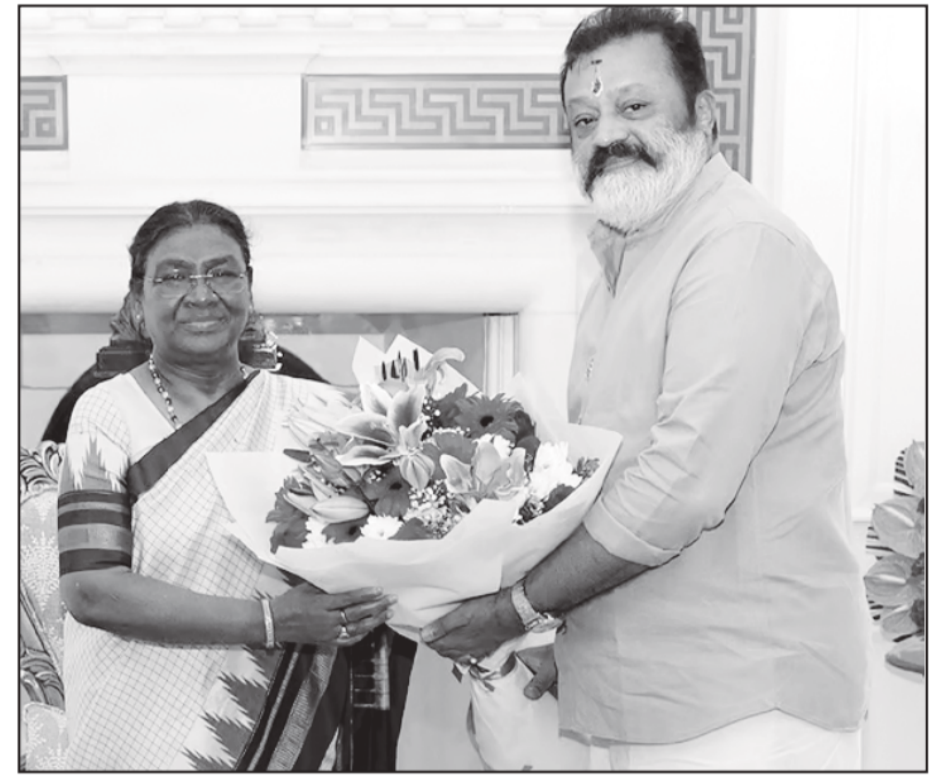
KTR condemns digital vandalism of Telangana Govt websites & social media handles

Hyderabad, July 2 (UNI) : BRS Party Working President Kalvakuntla Taraka Rama Rao (KTR) raised serious concerns regarding the digital vandalism of Telangana Government websites and social media handles.

In a detailed letter addressed to Shanti Kumari, the Chief Secretary of the Government of Telangana, KTR highlighted the alarming trend of disappearing digital content, which he believes to be a deliberate act of sabotage by certain elements within the state government. KTR requested the immediate restoration of all removed content from the public domain and urged the Chief Secretary to acknowledge the issue and take swift action to address this digital vandalism.

He emphasised the importance of preserving digital content created using public funds. This information, he asserts, is a crucial part of Telangana's history and belongs to the people of Telangana, not to any individual or political party.

He stressed that future generations would not forgive the destruction of this public property based on the whims of a select few. KTR called on the Chief Secretary to fulfill her duty as the guardian of the state's physical and digital assets, ensuring the protection and restoration of this valuable information.

Agriculture Minister urges unified effort to support farmers

Hyderabad, July 2 : Agriculture Minister Tummala Nageswara Rao has advised that the agriculture and allied departments work together to support farmers who produce rice despite natural calamities.

Speaking at the inauguration of the newly built integrated lab complex building at the Telangana Institute of Rural Development (TGIRD) in Rajendranagar, Ranga Reddy district, on Tuesday, along with Rajendranagar MLA Prakash Goud and District Collector Shashanka, the Minister highlighted the state government's commitment under Chief Minister Revanth Reddy to support the agriculture sector, a vital resource for society. The Minister announced that the government will spend about Rs 50,000 crore within the next two to three months on loan waivers and the Rythu Bheema scheme for farmers' welfare. He emphasized that despite the significant burden on the state exchequer, the government prioritizes the cultivation sector in the best interest of the farmers.

Through the Rythu Nestham programs, the government will gather opinions from farmers, agriculture officials, public representatives, and people from all walks of life to implement policies that reflect their sentiments. The loan waiver alone is expected to benefit farmers to the extent of Rs 31,000 crore and will be implemented according to the old method. The government is also determined to implement Rythu Bheema from this year.

Minister Tummala Nageswara Rao urged agriculture officials to work sincerely for the benefit of the farmers,

aligning with the government's vision. He encouraged officials to instill confidence in farmers by demonstrating that the agriculture department will support them in all ways, addressing stagnation in the cultivation sector. Officials should share their experience and knowledge at the field level and engage with farmers in their hardships.

The Minister stressed the importance of advising farmers on the types of crops suitable for their land, profitable crops based on market demand, and introducing them to new techniques and advanced methods. He emphasized that such efforts would bring revolutionary changes in agriculture and help farmers develop economically.

He advised officials to work in coordination and encourage farmers toward oil palm cultivation. Setting clear goals and working diligently to

achieve them is essential. Soil tests should be conducted for each farmer based on their agricultural field survey numbers, with results provided to farmers. Officials should give necessary advice on cultivating suitable crops according to soil nature.

The Minister directed that measures be taken to prevent the distribution of fake and inferior fertilizers and seeds, ensuring sufficient reserves for farmers' needs. The government will always support officers and staff working in the interests of farmers, providing them with necessary assistance.

Agriculture Secretary Raghunandan Rao, Joint Secretary Uday Kumar, Agriculture Director Gopi, Horticulture Director Yasmin Bashir, Marketing Director Lakshmbai, Nikhila, Chief Executive Officer of TGIRD, Director of Research Raghuram, MD of Markfed Satyanarayana Reddy, and other officials participated in the event.
