The 1993 movie A Few Good Men tells the story of two U.S. Marines court-martialled for the death of a fellow Marine, Private Santiago, at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. Following orders, the Marines carried out a code red, an illegal punishment for Santiago's perceived failings. It is later revealed Santiago had heart disease, but the base's toxic, macho culture labelled him a slacker. The superior officer is arrested for ordering an illegal punishment. While the Marines are cleared of murder, they are found guilty of unbecoming conduct. The plot highlights how unchecked social rules and the lack of grievance redressal can be a fatal mix.

I recount this in the context of the tragic death of Anna Perayil, a young chartered accountant who died of heart disease worsened by overwork. Around that time, I spoke to Aarvi, a 26-year-old client who shared her experience at an event management company, where she worked gruelling 17-hour days for 14 months. Constant travel, sleepless nights, and a relentless pace wore her down. She initially enjoyed the adrenalin rush but soon tired of the incessant workload and the toxic work

culture.

When asked why she stayed on for so long despite having no financial pressures, Aarvi revealed that peer pressure and fear of being labelled a quitter and a loser kept her there. She feared other jobs would be equally demanding. She only left after an illness forced her to go home and recuperate, which gave her the necessary time to reflect. Today, she works for a social sector company and enjoys the impact her organisation makes on fellow citizens. Her pay is sufficient to sustain an independent, comfortable lifestyle. The job also leaves her time to

hours. mechanisms mandatory breaks, and earned leave provisions, which exacerbated her helplessness. The fortuitous illness gave her the breathing space to realise she could make a conscious choice.

This is reminiscent of how workplace sexual harassment was once shrouded in silence until the 1997 Supreme Court judgement in the Vishaka case set guidelines for interpreting sexual harassment at the workplace. It enforced a grievance redressal ecosystem that victims could easily access. Social attitudes took time to adjust, but today most organisations, including small and medium enterprises, are sensitised on this issue.

The issue of unreasonable working hours and stress needs to be

highlighted similarly. Employees must know that unreasonable demands on this score are illegal. Companies should provide accessible grievance redressal mechanisms. Laws like the Shops and Establishment Act should be emphasised in employee induction programmes. Initially, larger companies will become sensitised to these issues and it will then spread to smaller organisations gradually. Employees who value worklife balance can seek help if they are mistreated for resisting excessive

workloads One way to encourage transparency is for large companies to report audited HR (Human Resources) metrics,

including employee turnover, satisfaction, and complaints and resolution data on issues related to sexual harassment or workload. This data could guide job seekers toward companies that value worklife balance.

Truth be told, while societal norms often favour conformity, allowing useful changes to emerge—like providing a safe space for handling the grievances of non-conformists—is a must for a robust system to evolve and keep up with changing norms. The loss of young Anna's life is a tragedy. If this tragedy shifts workplace attitudes, it won't have been in vain.

FESTIVAL OFFERS ON HOME LOANS

Avoid teaser rates that reset upwards after a few months

Compare loans from lenders on a comprehensive set of parameters, not just the offers

ast year, Rajesh Arora (name changed on request), a 40year-old Noida-based businessman, took a loan during the festival season because the interest rate being offered appeared attractive. However, what he realised later was that the low interest rate was applicable for only a year, after which the rate moved up.

During the festival season, the demand for home loans typically rises as many families look to acquire a new house.

This year is no different, with the market abuzz with several enticing housing loan offers.

According to a report by Omniscience Capital, a smallcase manager, the Indian housing finance market grew by around 25 per cent annually between FY22 and FY24.

It is further projected to expand at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 15-20 per cent until 2030. Borrowers need to examine home loan offers closely on several param-

eters to avoid Arora's fate. What's being offered?

One of the most common offers during the festival season is a partial or full waiver of processing fees.

"This can lead to savings of ₹10.000-50,000, depending on the loan size," says Adhil Shetty, chief executive officer, BankBazaar.com.

Another popular offer is a special interest rate. "Lenders lower the spread, reducing the loan cost by 5-10 basis points. However, the reduction is usually time-bound, and the lender may reset the spread after that interval," says Shetty.

Abhishek Kumar, a Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi)-registered investment advisor and founder, SahajMoney.com, highlights that apart from zero legal and valuation charges, lenders offer loan-to-value (LTV) ratios as high as

Experts stress the importance of opting for stable and transparent

"Offers with lower spreads over marginal cost of funds-based lending rates (MCLR) or repo-linked loan rates (RLLR) are preferable to teaser loans, where the spread increases after 1-2 years," says Kumar.

Another point Kumar highlights is that many of these special offers may be available only to borrowers with high credit scores, and not to everyone. Shetty adds that many of these offers may be available only to fresh loan applicants, and not those looking to refinance (there can be exceptions to this).

A reduction in interest rate, especially from banks, is a more equated monthly instalment (EMI) meaningful offer than a waiver of on the 10th of the month, the principrocessing fee.

"Bank discounts typically persist for the entire loan tenure, meaning a discount of just 10-50 basis points (bps) can lead to substantial longterm savings," says Aditya Mishra, processing fee;longer tenure

Borrowers should also be aware of hidden or invisible interest costs arising from the way banks calculate interest. Public sector banks typically use the daily reducing method, while private banks favour the monthly reducing method.

'The daily reducing method implies that if a borrower pays an pal portion of the payment is reduced from the balance within 24 hours. Consequently, interest is calculated on the reduced balance from the 11th onward," says Mishra. In contrast, private banks' monthly

reducing method means that even if the EMI is paid on the 10th, the principal is not reduced until the end of the month. This leads to additional interest on the higher principal for an extra 20 days. "Over a loan tenure of 15 to 20 years, the monthly reducing method can lead to significantly higher interest payment,' says Mishra.

Tips for borrowers

Experts advise starting the loan search with lenders that borrowers already have existing relationships with, whether for deposits, loans, or credit cards. "One should also compare loan features across different lenders on financial marketplaces,' says Ratan Chaudhary, head of home loans, Paisabazaar.

When choosing the loan tenure, borrowers should consider how much EMI they can afford and how it aligns with their other financial goals, "Shorter tenures lead to lower interest payments but higher EMIs, and vice versa." says Chaudharv.

Avoid overextending your home purchase budget just because a higher loan amount is available. "Don't let your total EMIs exceed 35 per cent of your take-home income,' savs Kumar.

Carefully review the loan's terms and conditions. Go with a lender that offers greater flexibility on prepayment. "Some lenders set a low threshold for prepayments but limit the number of times you can prepay in a year. Others allow monthly prepayments but have a higher threshold, savs Shetty.

Besides a comfortable EMI, have adequate financial backup. "Missing payments due to job loss or financial emergencies can result in penalties, a lower credit score, and difficulty in securing future loans,' says Chaudhary.

त वर्ष 2025 की जुलाई-सितंबर तिमाही में सबसे बड़ी सुचीबद्ध कंज्यमर इलेक्ट्रिकल सॉल्यशन कंपनियों में शामिल हैवेल्स इंडिया और पॉलिकैब इंडिया का प्रदर्शन लगभग एक जैसा रहा। सितंबर तिमाही में दोनों कंपनियों ने मजबूत राजस्व वृद्धि दर्ज की लेकिन मुनाफे के अनुमानों पर पूरी तरह खरी नहीं उतरीं।

दोनों कंपनियों ने 16 से 30 प्रतिशत के दायरे में वृद्धि दर्ज की। लेकिन मार्जिन एक साल पहले की तुलना में 130 से 290 आधार अंक तक घट गया। हालांकि ब्रोकर इनके दीर्घावधि परिदृश्य को लेकर उत्साहित हैं और उन्होंने राजस्व अनुमान बढ़ा दिए हैं। लेकिन मार्जिन दबाव की वजह से आय अनुमानों में कमी की है। केबल ऐंड वायर (सीऐंडडब्ल्यू) व्यवसाय दोनों कंपनियों के लिए विकास का मुख्य वाहक बना रहा। हैवेल्स ने इस सेगमेंट (कुल राजस्व में करीब 40 प्रतिशत योगदान) में सालाना आधार पर 23 प्रतिशत की वृद्धि दर्ज की।

भारत में 25-26 प्रतिशत भागीदारी के साथ संगठित वायर केबल ऐंड वायर सेगमेंट में बाजार दिग्गज पॉलिकैब ने एक साल पहले की तिमाही के मुकाबले 24 प्रतिशत वृद्धि दर्ज की। केबल ऐंड वायर सेगमेंट का कंपनी के कुल राजस्व में 85 प्रतिशत योगदान है। इस सेगमेंट में वायर ने अच्छा प्रदर्शन किया और इसकी वजह माल कम होने की वजह से डीलरों के पास उसका स्टॉक बढना रहा।

हैवेल्स के प्रबंधन ने संकेत दिया है कि शहरी बाजारों में मांग मजबूत बनी हुई है जबकि ग्रामीण बाजार वित्त वर्ष 2024 की सुस्ती के बाद सुधार दर्ज कर रहे हैं। बाजार की नजर त्योहारी सीजन पर रहेगी। हालांकि पॉलिकैब को वित्त वर्ष 2025 की दूसरी छमाही में वृद्धि की रफ्तार तेज होने की उम्मीद है। उसे सरकारी खर्च, निजी कंपनियों से लगातार निवेश और मजबूत रियल एस्टेट क्षेत्र से मदद मिल सकती है।

केबल ऐंड वायर के अलावा तेजी से बढ रहे इलेक्ट्रिकल वस्तु क्षेत्र में पॉलिकैब की बिक्री सालाना आधार पर 18 प्रतिशत तक

बढी. खासकर उसे पंखों के सेगमेंट में मदद मिली जिसका पिछले साल न्यून आधार था। पॉलिकैब को मजबृत ऑनलाइन बिक्री से भी मदद मिली। जहां रियल एस्टेट में मांग की वजह से स्विचगियर सेगमेंट में अच्छी वृद्धि देखी गई वहीं लाइटिंग खंड को मौजूदा कीमत गिरावट से दबाव का सामना करना पड़ा है।

जेफरीज रिसर्च में विश्लेषक सोनाली सालगांवकर का मानना है कि पॉलिकैब का केबल ऐंड वायर राजस्व वित्त वर्ष 2024 से वित्त वर्ष 2027 तक 20 प्रतिशत की दर से बढ़ेगा। कंपनी के इस राजस्व को खासकर अनुमानित पूंजीगत खर्च में सुधार, बुनियादी

ढांचा विकास और भारत में आवासीय क्षेत्र में तेजी का फायदा मिलेगा। ब्रोकरेज ने इस शेयर पर 'खरीदें' रेटिंग बरकरार रखी है। लेकिन उसने मार्जिन दबाव की वजह से अपने आय अनुमान 2 प्रतिशत तक घटा दिए हैं।

हैवेल्स के इलेक्ट्रिकल उपभोक्ता ड्यूरेबल कारोबार में 17 प्रतिशत की वृद्धि हुई। इसे त्योहारी मांग और ब्रांड की बढ़ती स्वीकार्यता के कारण विभिन्न श्रेणियों (फैन, छोटे घरेल उपकरण और वॉटर हीटर) में मजबत बढोतरी से मदद मिली।

लॉयड सेगमेंट में कंपनी ने मौसमी आधार पर कमजोर समझी जाने वाली तिमाही के

दौरान नॉन-रूम एयर कंडीशनर (एसी) पोर्टफोलियो के साथ सालाना आधार पर 19 प्रतिशत की वैल्यू वृद्धि दर्ज की। इस पोर्टफोलियो में रेफ्रिजरेंटर, वाशिंग मशीन और एलईडी पैनल, रूम एसी उपकरण शामिल हैं। कंपनी सेगमेंट स्तर पर नुकसान को वित्त वर्ष 2024 की दसरी तिमाही के 73 करोड़ रुपये से घटाकर 22 करोड़ रुपये पर लाने में सफल रही।

हालांकि एचडीएफसी सिक्योरिटीज ने हैवेल्स इंडिया का ईपीएस अनुमान वित्त वर्ष 2025-27 के लिए 3 प्रतिशत तक कम कर दिया है। लेकिन विश्लेषक पार्थ गाला को उम्मीद है कि वित्त वर्ष 2025 की दसरी छमाही में बाजार की इस अग्रणी कंपनी का परिचालन प्रदर्शन बेहतर होगा। यह अनुमान हैवेल्स के विविध उत्पाद पोर्टफोलियो पर आधारित है, जिसमें 70 प्रतिशत घरेलू विद्युत सॉकेट्स, लॉयड पोर्टफोलियो की बढ़ती लोकप्रियता है।

दोनों कंपनियों के लिए बड़ी निराशा सितंबर तिमाही के दौरान मार्जिन में कमी थी। हैवेल्स का मुनाफा मार्जिन घटकर 8.3 प्रतिशत रह गया जो 130 आधार अंक की गिरावट है। यह गिरावट मुख्य रूप से विज्ञापन खर्च में सालाना आधार पर 54 प्रतिशत की वृद्धि और मानव श्रम लागत में 21 प्रतिशत वृद्धि की वजह से आई।

पॉलिकैब का मार्जिन 295 आधार अंक तक घटकर 11.5 प्रतिशत रह गया। बढ़ते प्रतिस्पर्धी दबाव और केबल और वॉयर सेगमेंट में ज्यादा मार्जिन वाले घरेलू वितरण व्यवसाय से कम योगदान की वजह से मार्जिन में कमजोरी देखने को मिली। इसके अलावा क्रम मार्जिन अन्य/इंजीनियरिंग, खरीद और निर्माण (ईपीसी) व्यवसाय में मजबूत वृद्धि के साथ साथ विज्ञापन और कर्मचारी लागत में बढ़ोतरी की वजह से तेजी से बढ़ रहे इले क्ट्रिकल वस्तु खंड में नुकसान से भी मार्जिन दबाव को बढ़ावा मिला।
