- Exceptional Item comprises of:

 a) Expense incurred under VouIntary Retirement Scheme for employees Rs. 1241 Lakhs (2008-09 Nil)

 b) The Post Manufacturing Expenses dispute relates to excise duty payable on clearances from the factory between 01-03-1975 to 28-02-1983 in which allowable post manufacturing expenses were denied by the excise department. The company had won the case on merits, after which the excise department had rejected the claim for refund of excess duty paid on principles of unjust enrichment. This issue was held in favour of the Company by the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh and consequently, a refund of Rs. 1260.79 Lakhs (including an interest of Rs. 545.51 lakhs) was received from the excise department during the previous year ended 31st March 2008. Considering various aspects involved, the said refund received was considered in the Profit and Loss Account for the year ended 31st March, 2009.
- During the Quarter, 30 investor complaints were received to which the company had responded. No complaints were pending either at the beginning or at the end of the quarter.
- The Consolidated financial results as shown above in Column no. 5 and 6 relate to "VST Industries Limited" (the parent Company) and "VST Distribution, Storage & Leasing Company Private Limited" which is wholly owned subsidiary of VST Industries Limited.
- The Board of Directors recommend dividend for the year 2009-10 Rs.30 (2008-09 Rs.30) per Equity Share of Rs.10 each.
- To facilitate comparison, figures of the previous period have been re-arranged, where necessary.
- The above mentioned results were reviewed by the Audit Committee on 14th April, 2010 and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 15th April, 2010.
