RESULT OF POSTAL BALLOT

Pusuant to the provisions of Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013("the Act") read with Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, the approval of the shareholders was sought by way of Postal Ballot for the following:

"Special Resolution pursuant to the provisions of Section 180(1)(a) of the Companies Act, 2013 and all other applicable provisions, if any, for authorizing the Board of Directors of the Company to convey, sell, transfer, assign or otherwise dispose of the Company's Chlor Alkali Manufacturing Facilities at Ganjam (Odisha) and Salt Manufacturing Facilities at Pundi Salt Factory at Nagarampalli village, District Srikakulam (Andhra Pradesh) on "as is where is" basis by way of slump sale to ADITYA BIRLA CHEMICALS (INDIA) LIMITED, for a lump-sum consideration of Rs. 212,00,00,000/- (Rupees Two Hundred Twelve Crores only) as a going concern in terms of the Resolution set out in the Notice dated 11th September, 2014 and the Explanatory Statement relating thereto."

The Company had availed the e-voting facility offered by Central Depository Services India Limited (CDSL) for conducting e-voting by the Shareholders of the Company. The Company has also provided voting by physical Postal Ballot form along with a self-addressed postage pre-paid envelope to the Shareholders of the Company whose E-mail IDs are not registered in the records of Depositories/Company. Further, the shareholders holding shares as on the "cut-off" date of 12th September, 2014 were entitled to vote on the proposed resolution as set out in the Postal Ballot Notice dated 11th September, 2014.

Accordingly, the e-voting period remained open from September 20, 2014 at (10.00 A.M.) and ended on 19th October, 2014 at 6.00 P.M. and the E-voting module was disabled by the Central Depository Services India Limited (CDSL) thereafter. Votes cast through physical Postal Ballot forms received upto 19th October, 2014 at 6.00 P.M., were considered.

The Company had appointed Mr. Arun Kumar Jaiswal, Company Secretary in practice holding (ACS 29827, CP No.: 12281), as Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot voting process in a fair and transparent manner and ascertaining the requisite majority for the said voting.

I have downloaded the data of e-voting from CDSL's e-voting website <u>www.evotingindia.com</u> after the E-voting module was disabled by the Central Depository Services India Limited (CDSL) on 19th October, 2014 (6:00 P.M. IST).

The Postal Ballot Forms were kept under my safe custody in sealed and tamper proof ballot boxes before commencing the scrutiny of such Postal Ballot Forms.

The votes cast were unblocked on Tuesday, 21st October, 2014 at 10.30 a.m. in the presence of two witnesses, Mr. Manoj Kumar Panda and Mr. Jaya Sahu both of whom are not in the employment of the Company.

The e-voting data was scrutinized by me for verification of votes cast in favour and against the Resolution.
