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### INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REVIEW REPORT TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF PRESTIGE ESTATES PROJECTS LIMIED

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Standalone Unaudited Financial Results of PRESTIGE ESTATES PROJECTS LIMITED ("the Company") for the Quarter and six months ended 30 September, 2014 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreements with the Stock Exchanges, except for the disclosures in Part II Select Information referred to in 5 below. This Statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.
- 2. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of Company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and, accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
- 3. Based on our review conducted as stated above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the Accounting Standards specified under the Companies Act, 1956 (which are deemed to be applicable as per Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014) and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreements with the Stock Exchanges, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
- 4. a) Trade receivables as at 30 September, 2014 include Rs. 9,683 lakhs (31 March, 2014 Rs. 11,073 lakhs) due from certain parties which have been considered as good and recoverable by the Management, inter alia, based on the continuing business relationships and arrangements that the Company has with these parties.
  - b) We draw attention to Note 3 of the Statement. As explained in the note, the Company is in the process of evaluating the useful life of its tangible fixed assets pursuant to the requirements of Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013 which has come into effect from April 1, 2014. The effect on depreciation consequent to such evaluation will be recorded in the period in which it is determined.

Our report is not qualified in respect of the matters stated in paragraph 4(a) and 4(b) above.



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5. Further, we also report that we have traced the number of shares as well as the percentage of shareholding in respect of the aggregate amount of public shareholding and the number of shares as well as the percentage of shares pledged/encumbered and non-encumbered in respect of the aggregate amount of promoters and promoter group shareholding in terms of Clause 35 of the Listing Agreements with the Stock Exchanges and the particulars relating to investor complaints disclosed in Part II - Select Information for the Quarter and six months ended 30 September, 2014 of the Statement, from the details furnished by the Registrars.

#### NOTES:

- The above unaudited results for the quarter and six months ended 30 September, 2014 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 11 November, 2014.

The company operates within a single business segment which constitutes real estate development and letting out of developed properties. The Company operates only in Segmental information India and hence there is no other geographical segment. Hence the disclosure of segment information as per Accounting Standard-17 is not applicable.

- The Company is evaluating the useful life of its tangible fixed assets, pursuant to the requirements of Schedule II of the Companies Act 2013, which has come into effect from April 1, 2014. The effect on depreciation consequent to such evaluation will be recorded in the period in which they are determined.
- 4 During the quarter ended September 30, 2014, the Company successfully completed Qualified Institutional Placement under Chapter VIII of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2009, as amended, which opened on August 04, 2014 and closed on the August 08, 2014. Pursuant to this 25,000,000 equity shares of Rs. 10 each at a premium of Rs. 235 per share were allotted on August 12, 2014.
- 5 During the quarter ended 31 December, 2013, the Company was subject to search under section 132 of the Income Tax Act, 1961. The Company believes that no inconsistent information was noted by the Income Tax authorities during the search and thereafter. As on date, no demands have been raised on the Company by the Income Tax authorities as an outcome of the matter.
- The statutory auditors have carried out limited review of the above standalone results.
- The figures of the previous period have been regrouped/reclassified, wherever necessary to confirm to the current period classification.
