- 2 Slow down in Indian economy along with global economic crisis have impacted operations of the Company in the nine months ended 31st December 2014.
- 3 Pursuant to the enactment of the Companies Act,2013 ("The Act"), effective from 1st April 2014, the company has revised the estimated useful lives of its tangible fixed assets as specified in Part C of Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013 except in respect of end-user computers, electrical installation and equipment, plant and machinery and select items of furniture which were reviewed and revised by the management to reflect the periods over which these assets are expected to be used. Consequential impact on account of such change in useful lives of assets, depreciation charge during the quarter and period ended December 31, 2014, is higher by ₹ 213.45 lakhs which is treated as an exceptional item.
- 4 Disclosure of segment wise information is not applicable as hoteliering is the Company's only business.
- 5 In view of the seasonality of the business, the financial results for the third quarter and the nine months period are not indicative of the full year's performance
- 6 Figures of the previous year / period have been regrouped to conform to the current year / period of presentation.
