NOTES

- The total Manufacturing Crop of 22.10 Mn Kgs was marginally lower than previous year levels. Tea prices particularly of Dooars was up by 7% compared to previous year. This was backed by healthy growth in Instant Tea Business and strong order levels in Export segment.
- The figures of the last quarter are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures upto the third quarter of the current financial year.
- The value of consumption of materials does not include the cost of production of green leaf (raw materials consumed by the company for the manufacture of tea) from the company's own estates as it involves integrated process having various stages such as nursery, planting, cultivation etc.and their values at the intermediate stage is not readily ascertainable.
- Valuation of stock of teas as on 31st December, 2014 is done at the lower of actual cost and net realisable value. However, stock of teas as on 30th September, 2014, was valued at the lower of the estimated cost of production (based upon estimated production and estimated expenditure for the September, 2014, was valued at the lower of the estimated cost of production (based upon estimated production and estimated expenditure for the financial year) and the net realisable value. Production of tea not being uniform throughout the year, stock valuation would be unrealistic if it was based on actual expenditure and production upto 30th September, 2014. The aforesaid method of stock valuation as on 30th September, 2014 is consistent with the accounting policy followed by the Company for the purpose of quarterly results in the past.
- The Company is engaged in the business of cultivation, manufacture and sale of tea, which is seasonal in nature and hence, provision for taxation (both current and deferred) has been computed on an annual basis at the year end and given effect to in the results of the last quarter ended 31st December 2014.
 - As regards auditor's qualification on valuation of stock of teas and provision for taxation (both current and deferred) in the previous quarterly results, the matter stands resolved at year end.
 - The Board has recommended a Dividend of Rs 4.50 per share (45%) for the year ended 31st December, 2014.
 - The above results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved at the meeting of the Board of Directors held on 20th February, 2015.
