We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Unaudited Financial Results of INDO COUNT INDUSTRIES LIMITED (the "Company") for the quarter ended 31st December,2014 ("the Statement") being submitted by the Company pursuant to requirement of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreements with the Stock Exchanges, except for the disclosures in Part II-Select Information referred to in paragraph 4 below. The Statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.

We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provide less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Our observations in relation to such review are as under :The company has outstanding foreign currency related forward contracts in the form of options for hedging its business related exposure which are not speculative in nature. The contracts have long dated tenor with multiple contingent / uncertain events. As such ascertainment of fair value of these contracts is not feasible. However, banks estimate the total mark to market (MTM) of all outstanding contracts at approx Rs.922.65 lac as at 31-12-2014 (Previous year Rs.Nil). The management is of the opinion that the determination and crystallization of liability is dependent upon the outcome of uncertain future events or actions, not wholly within the control of the company. As adoption of AS-30 is presently not mandatory, the estimated MTM loss of Rs.922.65 lac for the period ended 31-12-2014 (previous year Rs.Nil) has not been provided.

Based on our review conducted as Stated above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement prepared in accordance with the Accounting Standards specified under Companies Act 1956 (which are deemed to be applicable as per Section 133 of the Companies Act 2013, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014) and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, had not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreement with the Stock Exchanges, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

Further, we also report that we have traced the number of Shares as well as percentage of shareholding in respect of the aggregate amount of public shareholding and the number of shares as well as the percentage of shares pledged/encumbered and non-encumbered in respect of the aggregate amount of promoter and promoter group shareholding in terms of Clause 35 of Listing Agreements with the Stock Exchanges and the particulars relating to investor complaints disclosed in Part II-Select information for the quarter ended 31st December,2014 of the Statement, from details furnished by the Registrars.
