

Statement On MAGGI Noodles Issue- Update

NESTLÉ HOUSE, Gurgaon, 12th June, 2015: The Hon'ble Bombay High Court today heard the petition filed by Nestlé India raising issues of interpretation of the Food Safety and Standards Act and the orders passed by the Commissioner of Food Safety, Maharashtra and the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI).

At the hearing, the company reiterated its press release of 5th June, 2015 and confirmed that it is continuing to remove MAGGI Noodles from the shelf and that the progress reports are being made to the FSSAI. The Hon'ble Court has also directed the FSSAI not to take any action in respect of the notice which required the company to explain itself within 15 days over the product approval already granted for MAGGI Noodles, till the next date of hearing.

The court has asked the Commissioner of Food Safety, Maharashtra and the FSSAI to file their reply affidavits. The court has fixed the hearing for 30th June, 2015.
