- 4. We did not review the interim financial statements of subsidiaries viz., Navam Lanka Limited, Gravita Global Pte. Limited, Gravita Netherlands BV, Gravita Senegal S.A.U., Gravita Nicaragua S.A. and Gravita Trinidad & Tobago Limited and partnership firm M/s Gravita Metals Inc., included in the consolidated financial results, whose interim financial statements reflect total revenues (net of inter-company elimination) of Rs. 2,571.64 lacs and total profit after tax of Rs. 308.83 lacs for the quarter ended June 30, 2015, as considered in the consolidated financial results. These interim financial statements have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our report on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries and partnership firm, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors.

The consolidated financial results includes the interim financial statements of subsidiaries viz., Gravita Infotech Limited, Gravita Ghana Limited, Gravita Mozambique LDA, Noble Build Estate Private Limited and partnership firms viz., M/s Gravita Metal and M/s Gravita Infotech, which have not been reviewed by their auditors, whose interim financial statements reflect total revenues (net of inter-company elimination) of Rs. 153.88 lacs and total loss after tax of Rs. 75.16 lacs for the quarter ended June 30, 2015, as considered in the consolidated financial results. The consolidated financial results also includes the Group's share of loss after tax of Rs. 0.01 lacs for the quarter ended June 30, 2015, as considered in the consolidated financial results, in respect of an associate Pearl Landcon Private Limited, based on its interim financial statements which have not been reviewed by its auditors.
- 6.
