1. Issue of Corporate Guarantee

1. The Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 along with the Rules as may be prescribed therein, in relation to resolution as set out in the Notice is annexed hereto.
2. The Notice is being sent by prescribed mode to all the members of the Company whose name appears on the Register of Members/list of Beneficial Owners as received from National Securities Depository Limited (“NSDL”) / Central Depository Services (India) Limited (“CDSL”) as on 30 September, 2016 (Cut-off date). Each Member's voting rights shall be in proportion to his/her/its share of the paid up share capital of the Company as on Cut-off date, which will only be considered for voting.

Voting Rights: Shareholders holding equity shares shall have one vote per share as shown against their holding and shareholders holding Class B Shares (Series 1) shall have three votes for four shares as shown against their holding. Fraction, if any in the voting right is to be ignored as per provisions of Article 43B and terms of issue of Class B Shares (Series 1). The shareholders holding both type of shares will have combined voting right as shown in total row. The shareholders can vote for their entire voting rights as per their discretion. Investors have to vote electronically for each class of shares separately.
3. The Company offers e-voting option to all the Members. Members have an option to vote either through e-voting or physically through Postal Ballot Form. STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013

Statement pursuant to Section 102 (1) of the Companies Act, 2013 setting out the material facts concerning each item of special business mentioned in the accompanying Postal Ballot Notice dated 29th September, 2016.

Item No. 1

Pursuant to the Composite Scheme of Arrangement between the Company and Future Retail Limited (*formerly known as - Bharti Retail Limited*) ("FRL") and its respective shareholders and creditors ("the Scheme"), all the current assets of Company pertaining to its Retail Business Undertaking were transferred and vested with FRL along with Working Capital limits.

Presently, FRL is availing Working Capital Limits under consortium arrangement with lead bank being Bank of India as per the consortium setup under the Company and transferred pursuant to the Scheme to FRL. The said Working Capital facilities were secured by Pari-passu first charge on current assets of Retail Business Undertaking and pari passu second charge on Credit / Debit card receivables and pari-passu second charge on fixed assets (excluding specific immovable fixed assets) of the Company. The said limits are to be regularized in FRL by sanction of fresh limits and new loan documentations are executed by Banks with FRL to secure the said limits with first charge on current assets of FRL. Further, Term Loan and Non-Convertible Debentures issued in various series in books of Company were inter alia secured by Fixed Assets.

As the Lenders / Bankers / Debentureholders have concern about security dilution for them and as per the terms of issue of NCDs, any reduction in the security cover offered in Company will required to be increased by way of additional security in the manner acceptable to the Lenders / Bankers / Debentureholders. Further, while granting no objection for the Scheme Lenders / Bankers / Debentureholders, have approved the same on the condition that each company viz. Company and FRL, would be guaranteeing the borrowing of the other company to their respective lenders.

Accordingly, it is proposed to issue corporate guarantee or provide security in connection with obligations of FRL in respect of borrowings having in aggregate principle / nominal value of Rs. 4152.50 crore (Rupees Four Thousand One Hundred Fifty Two Crore and Fifty Lakh only). Similarly, with a view to providing sufficient security to the lenders of the Company and to ensure credit rating to the business, FRL would be extending corporate guarantee to the Bankers / Lenders / Debentureholders of the Company.

The provisions of corporate guarantee by the Company as above requires approval of shareholders through Special Resolution pursuant to the provisions of Section 186 and Section 188 (since both FEL and FRL would be related parties within the meaning of Section 188 of the Companies Act, 2013) of the Act. Further, the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 also provides for obtaining approval of the Shareholders by way of passing a resolution for entering into material related party transactions as provided therein.
