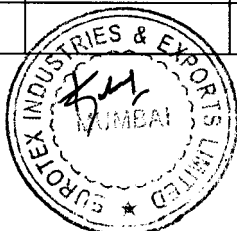

I, Dr. S. K. Jain, Practicing Company Secretary of Mumbai has been appointed as the Scrutinizer by the Board of Directors of **EUROTEX INDUSTRIES AND EXPORTS LIMITED** at its Meeting held on 1st October, 2016 as the Scrutinizer for conducting Postal Ballot / E-voting process and I have given my consent to act as Scrutinizer vide letter dated 1st October, 2016 for passing of the following Special Resolution by Postal Ballot:

SPECIAL RESOLUTION

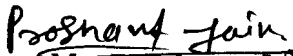
1. Issue of 6% Non-Cumulative Non-Convertible Redeemable Preference Shares of Rs.10/- each for a sum of Rs. 5,00,00,000/- (Rupees Five Crores) to PBM Polytex Ltd. on Private Placement basis.


I hereby submit my Report as under:-

- a. The Company completed dispatch of Postal Ballot Notices along with Postal Ballot Forms and Postage pre-paid self addressed Envelopes by Saturday, 22nd October, 2016.
- b. The Company had issued Public Notice regarding dispatch of Postal Ballot Forms/Notices in Free Press Journal (English Newspaper) and in Nav Shakti (Regional Language Newspaper) on Monday, 24th October, 2016.
- c. The Company has availed the services of CDSL to provide e-voting facilities to the Members of the Company.



- d. The remote e-voting commenced from 9:00 a.m. (IST) on Wednesday, 26th October, 2016 and ended at 5:00 p.m. (IST) on Thursday, 24th November, 2016.
- e. I have monitored the process of electronic voting through the Scrutinizer's secured link provided by CDSL on the designated website www.evotingindia.com
- f. The Postal Ballot Forms received during the voting period were kept under my safe custody and were opened by me as and when received and the same were serially numbered. The e-voting module was unblocked at 5:04 p.m. on 24th November, 2016 in the presence of two witnesses, Mr. Prashant Jain and Ms. Uma Bohra, who are not in the employment of Eurotex Industries and Exports Limited. They have signed below in confirmation of the votes being unblocked in their presence and the e-voting results/list was downloaded from the CDSL website.

- g. All Postal Ballot Forms received and e-votes casted up to 5:00 p.m. on 24th October, 2016 the last date and time fixed by the Company for receipt of the votes/forms were considered for my Scrutiny.
- h. I received total 57 (Fifty Seven) Postal Ballot Forms from the Members of the Company. All the 57 (Fifty Seven) Postal Ballot Forms were scanned and sent to M/s. Datamatics Financial Services Limited for verification of signatures and other details. M/s. Datamatics Financial Services Limited through their e-mail have intimated that out of 57 Postal Ballot Forms, 7 Forms were found invalid due to the following reasons:

- i. Since out of 57 Postal Ballot Forms received by me, 7 Postal Ballot Forms were found invalid due to Signature mismatch on verification by M/s. Datamatics Financial Services Limited Registrar and Share Transfer Agent of the Company, I have considered 50 Postal Ballot Forms which were found valid.
- j. There were 6922 Members of the Company on cut-off date i.e. 14th October, 2016. Out of 6922 Members, 1896 Members had registered their e-mail id with M/s. Datamatics Financial Services Limited (R&T) and accordingly Postal Ballot Notice along with Postal Ballot Form were sent to the Members through e-mail. Out of 1896 emails, 233 e-mails had bounced back. To the remaining 5026 Members, the Postal Ballot Notices along with Postal Ballot Forms were sent through Courier.
- k. I did not find any defaced or mutilated Ballot paper.
- l. The particulars of all the Postal Ballot Forms received from the Members in Physical form and Electronic Voting Report generated from CDSL have been entered in a Register separately maintained for the purpose.
- m. Detailed summary of Result with assent/dissent for the Resolution is attached with this Report as **Annexure - I**.
- n. The Resolution was passed by the requisite majority.
- o. I have handed over the Postal Ballot Forms and other related papers/registers and records for safe custody to the Company Secretary of the Company.
- p. You may accordingly declare the result of the voting through Postal Ballot and E-Voting.

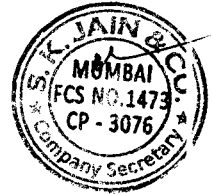

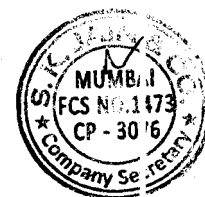
