## National Science Day: Experts call for change in education system

**DURING** THE National Science Day celebrations in Ahmedabad on Sunday, senior educationists and scientists called for a change in the existing education system, especially in the science stream. The day also saw the inauguration of science exhibition centre at Physical Research Laboratory

(PRL) in the city. "The Indian science system is suffering from a bacteria of favouritism. People are counting research papers to evaluate a researcher rather than reading these. Number has become more important than the quality. Today, we are teaching our students the techniques and facts, but not what is behind these. This is the biggest challenge to our education system," said director Indian Institute of

Technology (IIT)-Gandhinagar, Dr. Sudhir Jain, addressing students and teachers at the PRL. He added, "We need to teach students to create and solve problems than asking them to prove science formulas in laboratories that have already been proved years ago. Knowing about something is not important, but the capacity to know and learn and the ability to synthesise these facts is more important."

Referring to the gender bias and the impact of nuclear families on education systems, director of Space Applications Centre (SAC) in Ahmedabad, Tapan Misra, said, "In our society, boys are sent to private tuition, private coaching centres while girls to government schools and colleges. The result would really help our country develop," said Dr Jain, replying to queries during the interaction session.

# About 100 candidates boycott talati exam, allege malpractice

**ALLEGING** THAT the question paper was leaked, about 100 candidates boycotted the examination for the selection of talati mantris in Veraval town of Gir Somnath district on Sunday. The authorities said that they were inquiring into the matter. The exam was conducted simultaneously in the entire state Sunday for the second time after the previous test in 2014 had to be cancelled by the state government due to alleged malpractices.

About 100 odd candidates left their examination halls on KV Savaniya Education Campus in Veraval after candidates of Block No.15 complained that the seal of envelope containing question papers was broken and it was re-sealed with a plastic
